National Automotive Test Tracks (NATRAX) Inaugurated

- High-Speed Track in in Pithampur, Indore (Madhya Pradesh).
- **High Speed Track** is used for measuring the maximum speed capability of highend cars like BMW, Mercedes etc. which cannot be measured on any of the Indian test tracks.
- it is a world class **11.3 km** High Speed Track. **The track is the longest in Asia and the fifth largest in the world**.



Age-old Darbar Tradition Ends in J&K

- J&K has two capitals i.e., Srinagar (summer capital) for the state and Jammu (Winter Capital).
- Started by Jahangir, this tradition had been continuing by British and Dogra Rulers.
- Both the Jammu and Srinagar secretariats can now function work from either Jammu or Kashmir throughout the year. This will save the government Rs 200 crore per year, which will be used for the welfare of the deprived sections.

Global Cybersecurity Index: ITU

- India has ranked **tenth (10th)** in **Global Cybersecurity Index (GCI)** 2020 by ITU (International Telecommunication Union) by moving up 37 places.
- The affirmation came just ahead of the **sixth anniversary of Digital India** on 1st July.
- India scored a total of 97.5 points from a possible maximum of 100 points, to make it to the tenth position worldwide in the GCI 2020.

Freight Smart Cities Plans for India

- Commerce Ministry's Logistics Division unveils plans for 'Freight Smart Cities'.
- This is more relevant as the demand for urban freight is expected to grow by 140 per cent over the next 10 years.
- **Facilities** such as night-time deliveries, developing truck routes, using Intelligent Transportation Systems & modern technologies, Promoting electrification of urban freight, Parcel delivery terminals etc.

First Movable Freshwater Tunnel Aquarium

- Bengaluru City Railway Station has become the first railway station in India with a movable freshwater tunnel aquarium.
- This has been built at a cost of Rs **1.2 crore** with the aim of enhancing the passenger experience at the station. It is also aimed at improving revenue earning for IR.

USA Celebrates 245th Independence Day on 4th July

- Throughout the **1760s and early 1770s**, the American colonies found themselves at odds with **British imperial policies regarding taxation and frontier policy**.
- Finally, the United States was founded on an ideal of democracy on the **4th of July 1776** by adopting the **Declaration of Independence** from the **13 colonies**.

"NIPUN Bharat" Launched

- National Initiative for Proficiency in Reading with Understanding and Numeracy (NIPUN) Initiative Launched.
- To Create an enabling environment to ensure universal acquisition of foundational literacy and numeracy, so that every child achieves the desired learning competencies in reading, writing and numeracy by the end of Grade 3, by 2026-27.

Project BOLD launched by KVIC

- Khadi and Village Industries Commission (KVIC) launched a project named
 Bamboo Oasis on Lands in Drought (BOLD) from the village NichlaMandwa in
 Udaipur, Rajasthan.
- Under the project **5000 saplings** of special bamboo species from Assam have been planted over **16 acres** of vacant arid Gram Panchayat land of village.

"Harit Dhara" Developed by ICAR

- ICAR developed an anti-methanogenic feed supplement 'Harit Dhara' (HD), which can cut down cattle methane emissions by 17-20% and can also result in higher milk production.
- Belching cattle, buffaloes, sheep, and goats in India emit an estimated 9.25 million tones (mt) to 14.2 mt of methane annually, out of a global total of 90 mt-plus from livestock.

Pakistan Added to Child Soldier Recruiter List

- US has added Pakistan and 14 other countries to a **Child Soldier Recruiter List.**
- **Child Soldier** refers to any person below **18 years (15 years under CRC)** of age who has been, recruited or used by an armed force or armed group in any capacity.
- Recruiting Child Soldiers is also considered a war crime under the **Rome Statute** of the **ICC and** prohibited by the **UN Convention on the Rights of the Child** (CRC).

Ministry of Co-operation For 'Sahkar se Samriddhi'

- To give a new push to the cooperative movement across country a separate 'Ministry of Co-operation' has been created by the Central Government for realizing the vision of 'Sahkar se Samriddhi' (Prosperity through Cooperation).
- The 97th Amendment Act, 2011 added a new Part IXB, the word "Cooperatives" was added after "unions and associations" in Article 19(1)(c) under Part III, A new Article 43B was added in the DPSP (Part IV) regarding the "promotion of cooperative societies".

China Declared as "Malaria-Free"

- The World Health Organization (WHO) has declared China as "malaria-free".
- WHO grants the certification when a country has demonstrated with rigorous, credible evidence that the chain of indigenous malaria transmission by Anopheles mosquitoes has been interrupted nationwide for at least the past three consecutive years.
- India represents **3% of the global malaria burden** and has a vision of a **malaria free country by 2027 and elimination by 2030**.

Exports of GI certified Products from India

- GI certified **Bhalia variety of wheat** was exported today to Kenya and Sri Lanka from Gujarat.
- GI certified Madurai Malli Exported to Dubai & USA.
- The GI tagged chilli from Nagaland **'Raja Mircha'** (king chilli) also referred as **Bhoot Jolokia** and **Ghost pepper** was exported to London.
- A geographical indication (GI) is a sign used on products that have a specific geographical origin and possess qualities or a reputation that are due to that origin.

- Article 74 Council of Ministers to aid The President.
- Article 75(1) PM shall be appointed by the President and the other Ministers on the advice of PM.
- Article 75 (1A) Council of Ministers Shall not cross 15% of total number of members of the House of the People. (91st CAA 2003)

"Matsya Setu" App for Fish Farmers

- Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying has launched the Online Course Mobile App "Matsya Setu" for fish farmers.
- The app was developed by the ICAR- Research-Central Institute of Freshwater Aquaculture (CIFA) and National Fisheries Development Board (NFDB).
- It aims to disseminate the latest freshwater aquaculture technologies to the aqua farmers of the country, thus increasing the productivity and income.

Assa<mark>ssination o</mark>f President Jovenel Moïse

- A 28-member hit squad made up of Americans and Colombians assassinated President Jovenel Moise.
- He took office on February 7th of 2017 but has presided over a **deteriorating political and security situation** with gangs running rampant and constant political tensions.

Country's First Private LNG Plant in Nagpur

- Nitin Gadkari inaugurated the **country's First Private LNG** (Liquefied Natural Gas) plant set up by Baidyanath Ayurvedic Group in **Nagpur**.
- LNG is a clean and cost-effective fuel which can decrease the logistics cost and has also potential of creating ample job opportunities.

KVIC Secures Khadi Trademark Registrations Abroad

 In a major achievement towards protecting the identity of Brand "Khadi" globally - KVIC recently secured trademark registrations in - Bhutan, UAE, and Mexico.



• KVIC's trademark applications are pending in **40 countries** across the world which include the USA, Qatar, Sri Lanka, Japan, Italy, Australia, New Zealand, Singapore, Brazil, among others.

CPWD to Celebrates 167th Year Of its Establishment

- **Central Public Works Department (CPWD)** under Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs (MoHUA), will celebrate 167th year of its glorious service to the nation on July 12, 2021.
- **CPWD** came into existence in July 1854 as a central agency for execution of public works.

National Fish Farmers Day Celebrated

- The National Fisheries Development Board celebrated the National Fish Farmers Day on 10th July.
- To commemorate the **First successful induced breeding** of major carps on 10th July,1957 in Odisha for the first time in the country.
- The day was also celebrated as NFDB Foundation Day i.e., on 10th July 2006.

Virgin Galactic's Spaceship Unity-22 to Edge of Space

- **Virgin Galactic** the business Richard Branson started in 2004 aims to fly private citizens to the edge of space.
- An Indian Aeronautical engineer **Sirisha Bandla** joined British billionaire Richard Branson and four others on to make a journey to the edge of space from the **US state of New Mexico.**
- They reached an altitude of about **88 kilometers** over the New Mexico desert enough to see the **curvature of the Earth.**





NTPC Commissions Various Solar Power Project

- National Thermal Power Corporation's (NTPC) Simhadri Super Thermal Power Plant, Visakhapatnam has commissioned a 10 MW floating solar plant, which is part of the 25 MW plant.
- Another **100MW floating solar project** till date is being developed in **Telangana's Ramagundam** and is likely to be commissioned this year.
- NTPC Renewable Energy Ltd aims to set up 4750 MW renewable energy park at Rann of Kutch in Khavada, Gujarat. (To be India's largest solar park)
- NTPC strides towards building 60 GW Renewable Energy capacity by 2032.

India's First Cryptogamic Garden Inaugurated

- India's first **cryptogamic garden** was inaugurated in the Chakrata town of Dehradun, Uttarakhand.
- The garden will be housing nearly **50 species** of lichens, ferns, and fungi (collectively known as Cryptogamae).



Rudraksh: Varanasi Conventional Centre Inaugurated

- Rudraksh Convention Center is a symbol of friendship between Japan and India.
- The **Convention Centre** is a well-equipped, comprising of the main hall with a full flying tower, a seating capacity of 1,200, a gallery, meeting rooms, and parking for 120 cars.
- **Rudraksh** will exhibit a glimpse of the wonderful and ancient city of Kashi. In fact, the roof of this convention is shaped like Shiva Linga. The convention center has been installed with 108 Rudraksh and the entire building will glow with LED lights at night.



Long Duration Hot Test of Vikas Engine Conducted

- **Gaganyaan** is an Indian Human Spaceflight Programme by ISRO. The spacecraft is being designed to carry three people in 2023.
- ISRO has successfully conducted the third long duration hot test of the liquid propellant Vikas Engine for the core L110 liquid stage of the human rated GSLV
 MkIII vehicle, as part of the engine qualification requirements for the Gaganyaan Programme.
- The engine was fired for a duration of **240 seconds** the performance of the engine met the test objectives.

93rd Foundation Day of ICAR Celebrated

- Est on 16th July 1929, **Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR)** is an autonomous body responsible for coordinating agricultural education and research in India.
- To facilitate farmers to get 'right information at right time' in their desired language, a digital platform namely 'KisanSarathi' was launched.
- The farmers can interact and avail personalized advisories on agriculture and allied areas directly from the respective scientists of **KrishiVigyan Kendra** (KVKs).

World Day for International Justice Observed

• **17**th July every year is celebrated, to mark an emerging modern system of justice against international criminal acts.

- It reminds states as well as civil society of the need for their commitment to the international justice system.
- The International Criminal Court (ICC) was formally established on July 17, following the adoption of the Rome Statute.

Spyware Pegasus Used to Snoop on High Profile People

- The reason this highly advanced **'Pegasus'** is a spyware is malicious is that it gathers data without the consent of the person.
- However, NSO Group had claimed that their motive was to 'develop best-inclass technology to help government agencies detect and prevent terrorism and crime'.



Jeff Bezos launches to space aboard New Shepard rocket ship

- Billionaire Jeff Bezos blasted into space, in the first crewed flight of his rocket ship, New Shepard. He was accompanied by Mark Bezos, his brother, Wally Funk, an 82-year-old pioneer of the space race, and an 18-year-old student.
- They travelled in a capsule with the biggest windows flown in space, offering stunning views of the Earth. **New Shepard**, built by Bezos' company **Blue Origin**, is designed to serve the market for **space tourism**.

NASA's New Spacecraft: NEA Scout

- National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) has announced that its new spacecraft, named Near-Earth Asteroid Scout or NEA Scout, has completed all required tests and has been safely tucked inside the Space Launch System (SLS) rocket.
- Also known as a **CubeSat**, its main mission is to fly by and collect data from a near-Earth asteroid.
- It will take about two years to cruise to the asteroid and will be about 93 million miles away from Earth during the asteroid encounter.





"SMILE - Support for Marginalized Individuals for Livelihood and Enterprise".

- Recently, the **Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment** has formulated this scheme which includes a sub scheme 'Central Sector Scheme for Comprehensive Rehabilitation of persons engaged in Begging'.
- The focus of the scheme is extensively on rehabilitation, medical facilities, counselling, education, skill development etc. It is estimated that an approximate **60,000 poorest persons** would be benefited under this scheme for leading a **life of dignity**.

Liverpool Stripped of World Heritage status

- Liverpool has been stripped of its World Heritage status after a UN committee found developments threatened the value of the **city's waterfront**.
- UNESCO had previously warned that the developments, including the new Everton FC stadium, had resulted in a "serious deterioration" of the historic site.



Mirabai Chanu Bags Silver Medal at Tokyo Olympics

- Weightlifter Mirabai Chanu won the silver medal in the women's 49 Kg weightlifting event today, winning India's first medal at the Tokyo Olympics.
- She had total lifts of 202kg, including 87kg in Snatch and 115kg in Clean & Jerk.



• The **26-year-old from Manipur**, nurtured carefully after a back injury in 2018, became the toast of the nation.

India gets its 39th World Heritage Site: Ramappa Temple

• United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime (UNODC), Said that the lockdown restrictions during Covid-19 have accelerated drug trafficking using the Internet.

World Drug Report 2021, Released

- Rudreswara Temple (Ramappa Temple) at Palampet, Warangal, Telangana inscribed on UNESCO's World Heritage List.
- The decision was taken at the **44th session** of the World Heritage Committee of UNESCO today.
- The Rudreswara temple was constructed in **1213 AD** during the reign of the Kakatiya Empire (1163-1323 AD) by Recharla Rudra, a general of Kakatiya king **Ganapati Deva**.



Dholavira Declared a World Heritage site (40th Site)

- **Dholavira**, a Harappan-era metropolis, in Gujarat has been inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage List.
- It is one of the largest excavated Harappan site in India. Dholavira is unique because it records continuous settlement at one given place for over **1700 years** from Pre-Harappan to Late Harappan period.

Chandrayaan-3 to be Launched by End of 2022

- In a written reply to a question in the Lok Sabha, Dr. Jitendra Singh said that Chandrayaan-3 is likely to be launched during third quarter of 2022 assuming normal workflow henceforth.
- Chandrayaan-1 (2008-09), Chandrayaan- (2019), Chandrayaan-3 (2022) are Indian lunar probe missions under the Chandrayaan program by ISRO.
- Chandrayaan-3 would be sent through GSLV Mark III, which would land on 'Lunar south pole', the estimated cost is approx. ₹ 615 Crores.



World Economic Outlook: IMF

- The latest edition of the International Monetary Fund's (IMF) World Economic Outlook (published twice a year in the months of April and October) has cut its 2021 growth forecast for India to 9.5% from 12.5% estimated earlier in April 2021.
- Indian economy is expected to grow by 9.5% in 2021 and 8.5% in 2022, which has witnessed an estimated contraction of 8% in 2020.
- **Global growth** forecast at 6% for the year 2021, and it is expected to grow at 4.9% for the year 2022. In 2020, the global economy contracted by 3.3%

International Tiger Day Celebrated

- India is home to **51 tiger reserves** spread across **18 states**.
- The last **tiger census of 2018** showed a rise in the tiger population. 1411 in 2006 to 2967 in 2019.
- The theme for this year International Tiger Day is- "Their Survival is in our hands".

First Anniversary of National Education Policy 2020

- This is the first education policy of the 21st century and replaces the thirty-fouryear-old National Policy on Education (NPE), 1986.
- PM Modi launched multiple key initiatives in the anniversary event.
- PM Modi launched multiple key initiatives in the anniversary event. National Digital Education Architecture (NDEAR) and National Education Technology Forum (NETF), which are among the ambitious programs of the NEP 2020, would be launched.
- A website dedicated to Artificial Intelligence was launched in the event.
- Among other initiatives is Academic Bank of Credit that will provide multiple entry and exit options for students in Higher education, 1st Year Engineering Programmes in Regional Languages and Guidelines for Internationalization of Higher Education.
- Vidya Pravesh, a three month play based school preparation module for Grade 1 students will be released along with SAFAL (Structured Assessment for Analysing Learning Levels), a competency-based assessment framework for Grades 3, 5 and 8 in CBSE schools.

Earth Overshoot Day, 2021

- The day marks the date when **humanity's demand** for ecological resources (fish and forests, for instance) and services each year exceeds what the Earth can regenerate in that year.
- According to the **Worldwide Fund for Nature (WWF)**, humanity has again used up all biological resources that our planet regenerates during the entire year by 29th July 2021.
- Humanity currently uses **74%** more than what the planet's ecosystems can regenerate or **1.7 Earths.**

10 Crore Families Have Been Covered Under Ayushman Bharat Scheme

- Minister of Health and Family Welfare Mansukh Mandaviya informed the Lok Sabha that now **50 crore people** are eligible for free treatment of up to an amount of **Five lakh rupees** under the scheme.
- The Minister said the Ayushman Bharat scheme is **Five times bigger** than much hyped **Obama Care health cover** of the USA.





Australia to Return 14 Artworks to India

- Australia will return 14 artworks to India, including at least six believed to have been stolen or illegally exported, the **National Gallery announced**.
- The **Canberra gallery** identified the works, which include sculptures, photographs, and a scroll, as either stolen, looted or of unknown origin.
- The collection is composed largely of religious and cultural artefacts worth a total of about **2.2 million US Dollars**, including some dating back to the 12th century.

Loans Worth Rs 2,243 Crore Disbursed Under PM SVANidhi Scheme

- 22.7 lakh loans worth Rs 2,243 crore have been disbursed to street vendors under the Pradhan Mantri Street Vendors Atmanirbhar Nidhi (PM-SVANidhi) scheme.
- Launched in June 2020 amid the pandemic, it is a micro-credit facility that provides street vendors with a collateral-free loan of **Rs 10,000** at a low-interest rate for a period of **one year**.
- On prepayment or repayment, vendors are eligible for working capital loans up to **Rs 20,000 and Rs 50,000** in **Phase II and III** respectively.
