

- Services to clock 8.2% growth in 2021-22 after a contraction of 8.4% last year

- Foreign exchange reserves stood at \$ 634 billion as on 31st Dec 2021, higher than country's external debt



**National Clean Air Programme



- India's **Economic Growth** is estimated at **9.2** %, the highest among all large economies.
- Outlay for Capital expenditure in Union Budget hiked by 35.4 %.
- Emergency Credit Line Guarantee Scheme (ECLGS) extended up to March 2023. The guaranteed cover will be expanded by 50,000 crore rupees.
- Additional credit of 2 lakh crore rupees for **MSME** to be provided under Credit Guarantee Trust for Micro and Small Enterprises.





- PLI in 14 sectors for achieving the vision of Atmanirbhar
 Bharat will be strengthened.
- The procurement of wheat and rice from 163 lakh farmers in rabi and Kharif seasons 2021-22 has ensured rupees 2.37 lakh crore direct payment of MSP value to their accounts.
- Use of 'Kisan Drones' to be promoted for crop assessment, digitization of land records, spraying of insecticides and nutrients.





- Implementation of the **Ken-Betwa Link Project** at an estimated cost of 44,605 crore rupees to be taken up.
- Four hundred new-generation **Vande Bharat Trains** to be developed over the next three years.



- Revised Fiscal Deficit during the current year is estimated at 6.9 percent.
- Additional 19,500 crore rupees allotted under PLI scheme to give a fillip to domestic manufacturing in Solar Power.
- New provision introduced for taxpayers to file an Updated
 Return on payment of additional tax.
- Alternate Minimum Tax for cooperative societies reduced from 18.5 to 15 percent.





- Last date for a Tax incentive for Startups
 extended by one year from 31st March 2023.
- **Customs duty** on cut and polished diamonds and gemstones is being reduced to 5 percent.
- Customs duty exemption given to **steel scrap** last year is being extended for another year.






- Outlay for the 'Scheme for Financial Assistance to States for Capital Investment' is being enhanced from 10,000 crores in the Budget Estimates to 15,000 crore rupees.
- Virtual digital assets to be taxed at the rate of 30 percent.
- Surcharge on **long-term capital gains** arising on transfer of any type of assets to be capped at **15 percent**.






Neglected Tropical Disease Day

- They are caused by a variety of pathogens such as viruses, bacteria, protozoa, and parasitic worms.









Neglected Tropical Disease Day

- NTDs are especially common in tropical areas where people do not have access to clean water or safe ways to dispose of human waste.
- **Eg:** snakebite envenomation, scabies, yaws, trachoma, Leishmaniasis and Chagas disease, etc.







- Union Ministry of Culture has nominated Sacred Ensembles of the Hoysalas temples for consideration as a World Heritage site for the year 2022-2023.
- The sacred ensembles of the Hoysalas, built in the 12th-13th centuries and represented by the three components of Belur, Halebid, and Somnathapura in Karnataka.





- Chennakeshava Temple, Belur:
- Constructed around 1117 AD and took 103 years to complete.
- The temple is dedicated to Lord
 Vishnu known as Chennakesava,
 which means beautiful (chenna)
 Vishnu (Keshava).





- Hoysaleshwara Temple, Halebidu:
- Built around 1121 AD during the reign of the Hoysala King, Vishnuvardhana Hoysaleshwara.
- The temple, dedicated to Shiva, was sponsored and built by wealthy citizens and merchants of Dorasamudra.






- Keshava Temple, Somnathapura:
- It is a Vaishnava Hindu temple on the banks of River Kaveri at Somnathapura, Karnataka, India.
- The temple was consecrated in 1258 AD by Somanatha Dandanayaka, a general of the Hoysala King Narasimha III.

- MoEFCC celebrated World Wetlands Day at Sultanpur National Park (Haryana).



World Games Athlete of the Year 2021 Award

- Veteran Indian Hockey goalkeeper P R Sreejesh has won the prestigious World Games Athlete of the Year for his 2021 performances, becoming only the second Indian to receive the accolade.
- In 2020, Indian Women's hockey captain **Rani Rampal** became the first Indian to win the honor for her 2019 show.
- In the International Hockey Federation (FIH) Stars Awards in October, Sreejesh was named the goalkeeper of the year for 2021.





Chandrayaan-3 Is Scheduled For Launch In August

- Dr. Jitendra Singh informed Lok Sabha that **Chandrayaan-3** is scheduled for launch in August this year.
- The Minister informed that the number of missions planned during 2022 is 19.
- They include eight Launch Vehicle Missions, seven Spacecraft Missions, and four Technology Demonstrator Missions.
- Chandrayaan-3 will be a mission repeat of Chandrayaan-2 but will only include a lander and rover like that of Chandrayaan-2. It will not have an orbiter.

Statue of Equality

• The 216-feet tall Statue of Equality commemorates the 11th-century Bhakti Saint **Sri Ramanujacharya**, who promoted the idea of equality in all aspects of living including faith, caste, and creed. It is made of 'panchaloha', a combination of five metals (gold, silver, copper, brass, and zinc).





Statue of Equality

Mounted on a 54-feet high base building, named 'Bhadra Vedi'. It has floors
devoted to a Vedic digital library and research center, ancient Indian texts, a
theatre, an educational gallery detailing many works of Sri Ramanujacharya.

100 Years Of Chauri Chaura Incident

• Chauri Chaura is a town in the Gorakhpur district of Uttar Pradesh. On 4th February 1922, this town witnessed a violent incident - a large crowd of peasants set fire to a police station that killed 22 policemen. Due to this incident, Mahatma Gandhi called off the Non-Cooperation Movement.



Today, we mark a hundred years of the Chauri Chaura incident. Sharing my speech from last year, when the centenary celebrations of the incident began. I spoke about a wide range of subjects including remembering the heroes of our freedom struggle.

- Defeating **England** by 4 wickets in the final to be crowned winners of the 2022 Under-19 Cricket World Cup in Antigua.
- India has crowned world champions, emerging supreme in their 9th final across 14 editions.

• Melody Queen Lata Mangeshkar passed away on 6th Feb aged 92. GOI has announced **2-day national mourning** in her memory. As a mark of respect, the **national flag** will fly at half-mast for two days. A state funeral was accorded to the legendary singer, who received the **Bharat Ratna**, in 2001.







National Air Sports Policy 2022

 The policy will cover most of the air sports like aerobatics, aeromodelling, amateur-built, and experimental aircraft, ballooning, drones gliding, hang gliding, paragliding micro-lighting, Para-motoring skydiving, and vintage aircraft.





National Air Sports Policy 2022

- In line with the **Atmanirbhar Bharat Abhiyan**, domestic design, development, and manufacturing of air sports equipment will be promoted.
- Government will endeavor to enhance the participation of Indians in **global** air sports events.





National Air Sports Policy 2022

• Schools, colleges, and universities will be encouraged to have air sports included in their curriculum. For the year 2021-22, a sum of Rs. 1 crore has been allocated to promote air sports in the country. Once NASP 2022 is finalized, the Air Sports Federation of India (ASFI) shall be Formed.





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

Parvatmala Scheme

Union Budget for 2022-23 announced National Ropeways Development
 Programme - "Parvatmala" to improve connectivity in hilly areas. The scheme will be taken up on the PPP (Public-Private Partnership) model, which will be a preferred ecologically sustainable alternative in place of conventional roads in difficult hilly areas.







Parvatmala Scheme

- The idea is to **improve connectivity** and **convenience** for commuters, besides promoting tourism.
- The scheme is being presently started in regions like Uttarakhand, Himachal Pradesh, Manipur, Jammu & Kashmir, and the other North-Eastern states.







Parvatmala Scheme

- The Finance Minister announced that contracts for 8 ropeway projects for a length of 60 km would be awarded in 2022-23.
- The Ministry of Road Transport and Highways (MORTH) will have responsibility for this Scheme.








My Vote Is My Future- Power Of One Vote

World Pulses Day

• February 10 is observed as World Pulses Day every year and is being celebrated by the United Nations since 2009. Beans, peas, and lentils are the most common and most consumed types of pulses.

World Pulses Day

• The UN learned the importance of crops in 2013. In 2016, the UN declared it as the "International Year of pulses". The UN also hopes to double the cultivation of pulses by the year 2050. The theme for 2022 - 'Pulses to empower youth in achieving sustainable agri-food systems.'





Unitary Digital Identity Framework

- India has agreed to provide a grant to Sri Lanka to implement a 'Unitary Digital Identity framework', apparently modeled on the Aadhaar card.
- This Decision was taken after bilateral talks between President Rajapaksa and PM Modi in 2019.





Democracy Index 2021

• 165 countries were assessed, and the report is based on five findings:

electoral process and pluralism, functioning of the government, political

participation, political culture, and civil liberties. The report has been

further bifurcated into a full democracy, flawed democracy, hybrid regime,

and authoritarian.

Democracy Index 2021

- Norway, New Zealand, Finland, Sweden, and Iceland are the top 5 nations
 while the Central African Republic, Democratic Republic of Congo, North
 Korea, Myanmar, and Afghanistan are the bottom 5 nations.
- China (148), Bangladesh (75), Bhutan (81), Nepal (101), Pakistan (104) is placed in the Flawed Democracy category.


Democracy Index 2021

India ranked 46th in the flawed democracy category with an overall score of 6.91. It has the lowest score of 5 on political culture and the highest score of 8.67 on electoral process and pluralism. The country scores 6.18 on civil liberties, 7.22 on political participation, and 7.50 on the functioning of government.

- The Plan is to create a 'future ready' Railway system by 2030.
- Strategies based on both **operational capacities** and **commercial policy** initiatives to increase the modal share of the Railways in freight to **45**%.






• **Objective:** Create capacity ahead of demand, which in turn would also cater to future growth in demand right up to **2050** and increase the modal share of Railways to 45% in freight traffic and to continue to sustain it.


- Identify new High-Speed Rail Corridors.

- On World Radio Day 2022, **UNESCO** calls on radio stations worldwide to celebrate this event's 11th edition and more than a century of radio.





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

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ISRO Successfully Launches EOS-04

• ISRO successfully launches earth observation satellite **EOS-04** along with two other satellites through **PSLV-C52** from Satish Dhawan Space Centre, Sriharikota. This was the **54th flight of PSLV**; and the 23rd flight of PSLV in XL configuration with six strap-on motors.





ISRO Successfully Launches EOS-04

• It is a **Radar Imaging Satellite** designed to provide high-quality images under all weather conditions for applications such as Agriculture, Forestry & Plantations, Soil Moisture & Hydrology, and Flood mapping. Weighing about 1710 kg, it generates 2280 W power and has a mission life of 10 years.





Cabinet Approves India's G20 Presidency

• India Will be the Host for G20 Summit in 2023. The Union Cabinet approved the setting up of a G20 Secretariat and its reporting structures, which will be responsible for the implementation of overall policy decisions and arrangements needed for steering India's forthcoming G20 Presidency.






