DRDO Successfully Flight Tests MRSAM

- DRDO conducted two successful flight tests of the Indian Army version of Medium Range Surface to Air Missile (MRSAM) at Integrated Test Range, Chandipur off the coast of Odisha on March 27, 2022. The flight tests were carried out as part of the live firing trials against high-speed aerial targets.
- The missiles intercepted the aerial targets and destroyed them completely, registering direct hits at both ranges. The first launch was to intercept a medium-altitude long-range target and the second launch was for proving the capability of a low altitude short-range target.
- This MRSAM version is a Surface-to-Air Missile developed jointly by DRDO and Israel Aerospace Industries (IAI), Israel for use by the Indian Army. The MRSAM Army weapon system comprises multi-function radar, mobile launcher system, and other vehicles.



LRMR Air Squadron INAS 316 To Be Commissioned At INS Hansa

- Indian Navy's new long-range maritime reconnaissance (LRMR) air squadron INAS 316 is to be commissioned at INS Hansa, Goa on 29Mar 22.
- Nicknamed 'The Condors', INAS 316 will operate the potent LRMR P-8I aircraft
- A sneak peak into the historic moment that will unfold.
- "With the commissioning of INAS 316, we will be inducting four new P-8Is, delivered under the option clause with Boeing," Kumar said. "These aircraft, with advanced maritime patrol radars, state-of-the-art acoustic suites, air-toship missiles and torpedoes are substantial capability enhancers."



BRO Opens Manali- Sarchu Road A Month Ahead of Schedule

- In another breakthrough of opening up of passes in the North-Western border areas, the Border Road Organisation (BRO) opened up the 210 km long Manali-Sarchu road on NH 1D in Himachal Pradesh.
- During the Winter season, the road normally remains closed for over 160-180 days in a year, but this time **Project Deepak** of BRO has opened the road in 117 days, as the last convoy had moved on November 29, 2021.
- Opening the Manali-Sarchu Road was premised on the successful conduct of snow clearance operations over one of the highest passes of the Zanskar Range, the formidable Baralacha La Pass (16,043 feet). The BRO adopted a two-prong approach, with the simultaneous deployment of snow clearance teams from

two sides, one from Patsio to Baralacha La and the second from Sarchu to Baralacha La.

BILATERAL MARITIME EXERCISE SLINEX 2022

- The Ninth Edition of India Sri Lanka Bilateral Maritime Exercise SLINEX (Sri Lanka—India Naval Exercise) is scheduled at Visakhapatnam from 07 Mar to 10 Mar 2022. The exercise is being conducted in two phases; the Harbour Phase at Visakhapatnam on 07-08 Mar 22 followed by the Sea Phase on 09-10 Mar 22 in the Bay of Bengal.
- Sri Lanka Navy will be represented by SLNS Sayurala, an advanced offshore
 patrol vessel and the Indian Navy by INS Kirch, a guided missile corvette. Other
 participants from the Indian Navy include INS Jyoti, a Fleet support tanker,
 Advanced Light Helicopter (ALH), Seaking and Chetak Helicopters and Dornier
 Maritime Patrol Aircraft. The previous edition of SLINEX was conducted off
 Trincomalee in October 2020.
- SLINEX aims to enhance inter-operability, improve mutual understanding and exchange best practices and procedures for multi-faceted maritime operations between both navies. The Harbour Phase would include professional, cultural, sporting and social exchanges. Exercises during Sea Phase will include surface and anti-air weapon firing exercises, seamanship evolutions, aviation operations including cross deck flying, advanced tactical manoeuvres and special forces operations at sea. These will further enhance the high degree of interoperability already existing between the two navies.
- SLINEX exemplifies the deep maritime engagement between India and Sri Lanka and has grown in scope over the years to strengthen mutual cooperation, in consonance with India's policy of 'Neighbourhood First' and Hon'ble PMs vision of 'Security and Growth for All in the Region (SAGAR)'.



Iran Puts Second Military Satellite into Orbit

- Iran's Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps (IRGC) has successfully put a second military satellite, the Noor 2, into orbit.
- The announcement came as talks held in Vienna to revive an agreement restraining Iran's nuclear program have reached a critical stage.

- On 09 March 2022, the Australian Army Chief laid a wreath at the National War Memorial and received a ceremonial Guard of Honour at the South Block. Lt Gen Richard Burr called on the Chief of Army Staff, Chief of Naval Staff, Chief of Air Staff and other senior military officers.

Interaction between both the Chiefs of the Army Staff was warm and cordial.
 Both Chiefs exchanged views on the current global situation and the situation in Indo-Pacific in addition to discussing measures for enhancing defence cooperation between both armies.

- A Civil Nuclear Cooperation Agreement between the two countries was signed in September 2014.





Macgregor Memorial Medals Presented By COSC

 General MM Naravane, officiating Chairman Chiefs of Staff Committee (COSC) and Chief of Army Staff presented the prestigious USI MacGregor Memorial Medal to four awardees.

- Two from the Indian Army and one each from the Indian Navy and Indian Airforce, for their outstanding achievements in operational reconnaissance and extreme adventure sports.
- Sanjay Kumar, Chief EA (P), of the Indian Navy, during 2018 2019. He participated in La Ultra 111 Kms, the toughest race including crossing of Khardungla Pass on Aug 18. He secured 1st position in Navy Team in Solanq Sky Ultra (60 Kms) in Sept 18 and secured runners up in 12 hours Stadium Run (110Kms) on Dec 18. He also won High 5 Format of Hell Race (211 Kms) on June 19 and set the new India Book of Records in Mumbai Goa Ultra Relay (563 Kms) on Aug 19.
- Hav (Apr) (now Naib Subedar) Sanjeev Kumar of Army Adventure Nodal Centre (Hang Gliding), School of Artillery, Deolali created a new world record in powered harness hang glider on 12 Dec 2018 by staying aloft for 8 hours & 43 minutes, from Suratgarh to Barmer, Rajsthan, over a distance of 465.33 km. His achievement has been recognised by Limca Book of Records, India Book of Records and Asia Book of Records, breaking the previous record of 313.13 km.
- MWO Anshu Kumar Tiwari of Directorate of Adventure, Indian Airforce was tasked to check the feasibility of parachute landing at Khardungla pass (17982 feet), to demonstrate the airborne capability of the Indian Armed Forces. In that, he undertook the jump successfully from 24000 ft on 8th Oct 2020, thereby establishing the operational validity of this critical parachute system first time in international history.
- Maj Ajay Kumar Singh of a Para Special Forces Battalion, planned, trained and successfully led a 1660 km long ARMEX 21 (ski expedition) from the Karakoram in Ladakh to Uttarakhand, across 26 rugged passes above 18000 feet in "the great Himalayas" for 119 days during winters. The exploration has led to a better understanding and capabilities for military operations in super highaltitude terrain.



Exercise Dharma Guardian-2022 Culminates

- Ex DHARMA GUARDIAN-2022, an annual exercise between Indian Army and Japanese Ground Self Defence Force which commenced on 27 February 2022 at Foreign Training Node, Belgaum successfully culminated on 10 March 2022.
- Twelve days of intense joint military training, providing a unique opportunity of achieving synergy between the Armed Forces of both Nations which is focused on strengthening the timeless bonds of India - Japan friendship.
- The exercise also provided a platform for professional and cultural learning as well as social interactions which in turn broadened their horizon towards knowledge and cooperation aiming towards co-existence as one in the Indo-Pacific Region.



HAL Begins Manufacturing Of AMCA

- India's state-owned aerospace & defence firm Hindustan Aeronautics Limited (HAL) has started manufacturing India's Advanced Medium Combat Aircraft (AMCA) in association with DRDO's Aeronautical Development Agency.
- The AMCA programme entered a crucial phase with the starting of manufacturing activities. It is noteworthy that, the plan envisages equipping the Indian Air Force (IAF) and Indian Navy with a 5.5 Generation twin-engine stealth fighter.
- Notably, the first two squadrons in AMCA Mark 1 configuration will be powered by an imported engine, another five squadrons with advanced features (Mark 2) will use made-in-India 125-kilonewton engines along with 6th Generation technologies.
- AMCA can clock a maximum speed of over 2,600 kilometres per hour (Mach 2.15), along with the combat range of 1,620 km. The fighter will be equipped with 23 mm cannon and will have 14 hardpoints in non-stealth version to carry armaments weighing 6,500 kilogrammes.
- The Critical Design Review (CDR) is expected later this year with the rollout planned in 2024 and first flight planned in 2025."



Naval Air Ops School Kochi Celebrated Its Diamond Jubilee

- The event saw the participation of serving officers & veterans including Gallantry award winners.
- A Seminar themed "Shaping Maritime Air Operations Evolution and Opportunities" was conducted on the occasion
- The inaugural address for the seminar was delivered by VAdm MA Hampiholi, CinC, HQSNC.
- The Naval Air Operations School trains the fledglings of the Indian Navy and Coast Guard into combat worthy men and women who are the cornerstone for mission accomplishment in Maritime Surveillance, Reconnaissance and targeting.
- These 'Airborne Tacticians' enable ordnance on target which is the ultimate purpose of any force in combat.



INS Chennai and INS Teg Visit Colombo

- Ships of the Indian Navy's Western Fleet, INS Chennai, and INS Teg, made a port call at Colombo, Sri Lanka, on 10 March 22 for a two-day visit. They were received by the Officer of the Guard (OOG) and the Sri Lanka Navy band.
- Upon arrival, Rear Admiral Sameer Saxena, NM, Flag Officer Commanding
 Western Fleet visited the IPKF memorial to pay homage to the soldiers that
 sacrificed their lives for peace in the region. The memorial is also testimony to
 the inextricable ties between the people of India and Sri Lanka.
- Many working level interactions are scheduled between naval personnel of the two countries, followed by familiarisation tour of Galle and Kandy for IN personnel, visits of Sri Lanka Navy personnel, school children & local visitors on board Indian warships.



 In addition, an interaction between operational teams of the two navies is also scheduled to finalise the schedule of the Maritime Partnership Exercise on 12 Mar 22.

Pakistan Air Force Inducts New Batch of Chinese Fighter Jets

- Pakistan's air force officially inducted its first batch of Chinese-built J-10C fighter jets on Friday, holding a ceremony with officials from both sides in Islamabad.
- Several of the jets flew overhead as PM Imran Khan welcomed the purchase, made for an undisclosed amount. Pakistan hasn't said how many aircraft were bought in the deal, though authorities had earlier spoken of up to 25 jets. China is a longtime ally of Pakistan and has sold its military aircraft before.



ARMY CHIEF COMPLIMENTS RIMC ON Founder's Day

- The Rashtriya Indian Military College Dehradun is celebrating its centennial Founder's Day on 13 March 2022.
- In a message to the institution, Gen MM Naravane, Chief of Army Staff complimented and acknowledged the stellar contribution of the RIMC and the Alumni in the service of the Nation for the last one hundred years.
- He also complimented the College staff for keeping the institution fully open and functional during the COVID pandemic.

- The COAS urged Cadets to prepare for future leadership roles and challenges which will be shaped by rapid changes in technology.
- Expressing confidence on the preparations made by the College to welcome and integrate girl cadets into the folds of the prestigious institution, the COAS remarked that "Girls joining the College would be its Centennial moment"



New Air-launched Version of Brahmos Would Be Able To Targets At 800 Km

- India is developing a new air-launched version of the BrahMos supersonic cruise missile which would be able to strike at enemy targets at more than 800 km.
- The missile earlier had the capability of hitting targets at around 300 kilometers after being released from a Su-30MKI combat aircraft.
- "The range of the BrahMos missile has been increased already and with the advantage of being airborne at high altitudes, the missile can travel a longer distance and can hit targets at 800 km and beyond."
- The BrahMos missile was recently in the limelight after one of it was misfired due to a technical malfunction from an Indian Air Force unit during a Command Air Staff Inspection (CASI) there.
- The Indian Air Force has equipped around 40 of its Su-30 combat aircraft with the BrahMos cruise missiles which can cause heavy destruction in enemy camps.



GOVERNMENT PLANS ON AMCA

- Process for obtaining Cabinet Committee on Security's (CCS) approval for design and prototype development of Advanced Medium Combat Aircraft (AMCA) has been initiated.
- 5th Generation fighter aircraft, due to very special features, are costlier than 4th Generation fighter aircraft. Since AMCA is an indigenous 5th Generation aircraft, it is less costly than similar aircraft available outside.
- This information was given by Raksha Rajya Mantri Shri Ajay Bhatt in a written reply to Smt Shanta Chhetri in Rajya Sabha on March 14, 2022.



HAL, Safran to set up Helicopter Engines MRO facility in Goa

- The ground-breaking ceremony for a new facility of Helicopter Engines MRO Pvt Limited (HE-MRO), a joint venture of Hindustan Aeronautics Limited and Safran, was held on Monday at Sattari, 40 km from Panaji, in Goa.
- The facility will be operational by the end of 2023 with a capacity to repair 50 engines a year and a full-capacity goal of 150 engines in the coming years, HAL said.
- "The 1,000 sqm training and office facility and a 3,800 sqm international class shop facility will provide Maintenance, Repair and Overhaul (MRO) services for Safran TM333 and HAL Shakti engines installed on HAL-built helicopters to increase the operational readiness of the Indian Armed Forces."
- Shakti is installed on HAL's ALH/Dhruv variants including 'Rudra' and has also been selected to power the HAL-designed Light Combat Helicopter (LCH). The Ardiden 1U variant powers the new Light Utility Helicopter (LUH), a three-ton single-engine aircraft. The engine was certified by DGCA (India) on July 26, 2021, for civil applications.

ISRO Successfully Carried Out Testing of Booster SSLV

- ISRO successfully carried out the ground testing of the newly developed solid booster stage (SS1) for its new launch vehicle Small Satellite Launch Vehicle (SSLV) at Satish Dhawan Space Centre, Sriharikota, at 1205 hrs.
- The Indian Space & Research Organisation on Monday successfully conducted the ground testing of the newly developed solid booster stage (SS1) for its new Small Satellite Launch Vehicle (SSLV). The test was conducted at the Satish Dhawan Space Centre in Sriharikota.
- The test was conducted at 12:05 pm when the booster was fired up. ISRO said that the successful testing has given it sufficient confidence to proceed with the first developmental flight of SSLV (SSLV-D1).
- The remaining stages of SSLV (SS2 & SS3) have successfully undergone necessary ground tests and are ready for integration.

ICG Ship 'Saksham' Dedicated to Nation

- Indian Coast Guard Ship 'Saksham', the fifth in the series of 105 M-Class offshore patrol vessel, has been commissioned on Wednesday in Goa.
- Defence Secretary Ajay Kumar commissioned offshore patrol vessel Indian Coast Guard Ship Saksham into service in Goa.
- The 5th and the last Offshore Patrol Vessel designed and built by Goa Shipyard Limited (GSL) for the Indian Coast Guard was launched in December 2020. The

vessel christened 'Saksham' is a part of the indigenous project launched by Prime Minister Narendra Modi in November 2016.



The 2nd India-Indonesia Security Dialogue

- The second India-Indonesia Security Dialogue (IISD) was held in Jakarta yesterday.
- It was co-chaired by National Security Adviser Ajit Doval and Coordinating Minister for Political, Legal, and Security Affairs of Indonesia, Mohammad Mahfud.
- The IISD is a forum that brings the coordinating minister for Political, Legal, and Security Affairs of Indonesia and National Security Adviser of India together to discuss and enhance cooperation between the two countries on political and security issues.
- They discussed current global and security issues, countering terrorism and violent extremism, and enhancing maritime, defence, and cyber security cooperation.

India-Indonesia:

- Both of them have agreed to work together for peace, security, and prosperity in order to achieve their shared vision on maritime cooperation in the Indo-Pacific region.
- The Strait of Malacca waterway connecting the Andaman Sea (Indian Ocean) and the South China Sea (Pacific Ocean) runs between the Indonesian island of

Sumatra to the West and peninsular (west) Malaysia and extreme southern Thailand to the east.

- Trade and Commerce: Bilateral trade has increased from USD 4.3 billion in 2005-06 to USD 21 billion in 2018-19.
- Indonesia has emerged as the second largest trading partner of India in the ASEAN region.
- India is the second largest buyer of coal and crude palm oil from Indonesia and imports minerals, rubber, pulp and paper, and hydrocarbons reserves.
- Both countries are members of **G20**, the **Non-Aligned Movement** (NAM), **East Asia Summit**, and the **United Nations**.
- Bilateral Exercises:
- Exercise Samudra Shakti the bilateral maritime exercise.
- Garuda Shakti is a joint military exercise between India and Indonesia.





Rajnath Singh Assures Parliament Over Inadvertent Missile Firing Incident

• Defence Minister Rajnath Singh said that a high-level probe has been ordered into the inadvertent firing of a missile that landed in Pakistan on March 9 saying that "if any lapses are found, action will be taken accordingly".

- Addressing Rajya Sabha, the minister informed that standard operating procedures (SOPs) for "operations, maintenance, and inspection" of such systems were being reviewed in the wake of the incident.
- "I'd like to tell this House about an incident that occurred on 9th March 2022. It's related to an accidental missile release during the inspection. During routine maintenance and inspection of the missile unit, around 7 pm, one missile got accidentally released. While this incident is regretted, we are relieved that nobody was hurt due to the accident," the Defence Minister told Rajya Sabha.
- Singh sought to assure Parliament that the "Indian missile system is very reliable and safe" and that the "safety procedures and protocols are of the highest order".


- XII Corps is a corps of the Indian Army and one of the two corps in the Punebased Southern Command.

Rescue Mission Launched for Indian Ship

- The Indian Coast Guard on Saturday launched a rescue operation for a distressed Indian cargo ship, MSV Devi Krupa, near the Iranian coast with 12 Indian crew members on board.
- The operation was launched by the Maritime Rescue Coordination Centre,
 Mumbai, in coordination with their Iranian counterpart.
- The distressed vessel is in an area 408 miles far from the Indian coast and nearly 90 miles away from the Iranian coast. MSV Devi Krupa was transiting from Porbandar to Kuwait with cargo onboard. It was supposed to reach Kuwait but developed technical problems and couldn't reach its destination, informed sources added.


- ICG was established in August 1978 by the Coast Guard Act, of 1978 as an independent Armed force of India.
- As the fourth largest Coast Guard in the world, it has played a significant role in securing the Indian coasts and enforcing regulations in the maritime zones of India.
- It is an Armed Force, Search and Rescue, and Maritime Law Enforcement agency under the Ministry of Defence.

- It is headquartered in New Delhi.
- The concept of forming ICG came into being after the 1971 war.
- The blueprint for a multidimensional Coast Guard was conceived by the visionary Rustamji Committee.



BRO Achieves Rare Feat; Zoji La Pass Opened For Traffic

- Border Roads Organisation (BRO) opened the gateway between Union Territories of Ladakh and Jammu & Kashmir - the Zoji La Pass - for traffic on Srinagar-Kargil-Leh road at 11,650 feet on March 19, 2022, setting up an all-time record of the pass being opened after just 73 days of its closure this year.
- This is the first time BRO has been able to achieve the feat, after it had kept the pass open till January 05, 2022, through relentless snow clearance operations amidst tough weather conditions.
- Border Roads Organisation
- BRO was conceived and raised in 1960 by Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru for coordinating the speedy development of a network of roads in the North and the North-Eastern border regions of the country.
- It works under the administrative control of the Ministry of Defence.
- It has diversified into a large spectrum of construction and development works comprising airfields, building projects, defence works, and tunneling and has endeared itself to the people.

- The First Chief of Defence Staff, General Bipin Rawat was posthumously awarded Padma Vibhushan for his exceptional & distinguished service.
- Daughters of General Bipin Rawat received the award on his behalf from the President of India at the ceremonial function in New Delhi.
- General Bipin Rawat, the first Chief of Defence Staff (CDS) died in an IAF helicopter crash in December last year.



President's Colour to INS Valsura

- On 25Mar 2022, Shri Ram Nath Kovind, the Hon'ble President of India & Supreme Commander of Indian Armed Forces, will award the President's Colour to INS Valsura at Jamnagar.
- INS Valsura is a "stone frigate" (shore establishment) of the Indian Navy in Jamnagar, Gujarat. A premier technological training institution, it is the Electrical school of the Indian Navy.
- The President's Colour Award is the highest honor that can be bestowed upon any military unit of India. It is also known as 'Nishaan' which is an emblem that will be worn by all unit officers on the left-hand sleeve of their uniform.
- It was the Indian Navy that was the first branch of the Armed Forces to receive the President's Colour in **May 1951.**

- The show will have exhibition, discussions, demonstration, exhibition and flying display by the Sarang team of the Indian Air Force, roundtable/panel discussion on helicopter industry, business aviation, Krishi UDAN, golden age of drones, India-US Roundtable with AMCHAM, drone demonstrations, Global CEOs Forum, and the Wings India awards 2022 ceremony.

EXERCISE PRASTHAN 2022

- An offshore security exercise, 'Prasthan' was conducted in the Offshore
 Development Area (ODA) off Mumbai on 23 March 2022, under the aegis of
 Headquarters, Western Naval Command. Conducted every six months, this
 exercise is an important element of ensuring offshore security and aims to
 integrate efforts of all maritime stakeholders involved in offshore defence.
- Led by the Navy, the exercise saw participation from the Indian Air Force, Coast Guard, ONGC, Mumbai Port Trust, Jawahar Lal Nehru Port Trust, Customs, state fisheries department, Mercantile Marine Department and the Marine Police.
 The day-long exercise resulted in refining standard operating procedures (SOPs) and response-actions to a number of contingencies in the Offshore Defence Area off Mumbai.

- The exercise was conducted on the B-193 platform of ONGC located about 38 nm west of Mumbai.
- Contingencies such as terrorist intrusion, bomb explosion, casualty evacuation, search and rescue, man overboard, major fire, oil spill and mass evacuation were exercised. Earlier, on 17 March 22, loss of control of an OSV that necessitated towing by an Emergency Towing Vessel was also exercised.
- The exercise provided all stakeholders a realistic experience to assess their readiness to respond and combat contingencies in the Western ODA, as also to operate together in a coordinated and synergised manner.



LRMR Air Squadron INAS 316 To Be Commissioned At INS Hansa

- Indian Navy's new long-range maritime reconnaissance (LRMR) air squadron INAS 316 to be commissioned at INS Hansa, Goa on 29Mar 22.
- Nicknamed 'The Condors', INAS 316 will operate the potent LRMR P-8I aircraft
- A sneak peak into the historic moment that will unfold.
- INS Hansa is an Indian naval air station located near Dabolim in Goa, India.[1] It is India's biggest naval airbase. The military airbase has a civil enclave, that operates as Dabolim Airport.

 INS Hansa was commissioned on 5 September 1961 at Sulur near Coimbatore, Tamil Nadu. It was initially co-located with the Sulur Air Force Station of the Indian Air Force.



BRO Opens Manali- Sarchu Road A Month Ahead of Schedule

- In another breakthrough of opening up of passes in the North-Western border areas, the Border Road Organisation (BRO) opened up the 210 km long Manali-Sarchu road on NH 1D in Himachal Pradesh.
- During the Winter season, the road normally remains closed for over 160-180 days in a year, but this time Project Deepak of BRO has opened the road in 117 days, as the last convoy had moved on November 29, 2021.
- Opening the Manali-Sarchu Road was premised on the successful conduct of snow clearance operations over one of the highest passes of the Zanskar Range, the formidable Baralacha La Pass (16,043 feet). The BRO adopted a two-prong approach, with the simultaneous deployment of snow clearance teams from two sides, one from Patsio to Baralacha La and the second from Sarchu to Baralacha La.



Neeraj Chopra, Pramod Bhagat received Padma Shri

- Olympic champion Neeraj Chopra on Monday received the Padma Shri, the country's fourth highest civilian award. The 24-year-old javelin thrower received the prestigious award from President Ram Nath Kovind at the Rashtrapati Bhavan during a ceremony.
- Chopra made history at the Tokyo Olympics by becoming the first Indian to win a gold medal in a track and field event in the Games' history.
- He also became only the second Indian to win an individual Olympic gold after shooter Abhinav Bindra.



"EX DUSTLIK" CONCLUDES IN UZBEKISTAN

- The 3rd edition of Indo-Uzbekistan Joint Field Training Exercise "EX DUSTLIK" concluded at Yangiarik, Uzbekistan on 29 March 2022. The joint exercise provided an opportunity for both the contingents to train in Counter Terrorism operations in a semi-urban environment.
- "Exercise DUSTLIK" will enhance the level of defence cooperation between both the Armies and will act as a catalyst for many such joint programs in future to further consolidate the traditional bond of friendship between India and Uzbekistan.



Assam, Meghalaya Sign Border Pact

- Chief Ministers of Assam and Meghalaya on Tuesday signed a historic agreement for the settlement of inter-state border dispute in presence of Union Home Minister Amit Shah.
- The Home Minister said it is "a historic day" for a dispute-free northeast and noted that in a short span of time, 6 out of 12 issues have been settled between Assam and Meghalaya and about 70 per cent of the border between the two states has become dispute-free.
- According to the proposed recommendations for the 36.79 square km of land, Assam will keep 18.51 square km and give the remaining 18.28 square km to Meghalaya.
- He said during the last three years, the union government has signed several agreements for ending extremism and for lasting peace in the northeastern states.

- The Home Minister said PM Modi has made several efforts for the peace process, development, prosperity, and promotion of the cultural heritage of the northeast, which "we all have witnessed, since 2014, when he became the Prime Minister".
- Looking at the journey from 2019 to 2022, there have seen many big achievements in establishing peace in the Northeast - NLFT agreement in August 2019, the Bru-Reang agreement on January 16, 2020, the Bodo agreement on January 27, 2020, the Karbi-Anglong agreement on September 4, 2021, and today's Assam-Meghalaya border agreement.
- The long-standing land dispute was sparked in 1972 when Meghalaya was carved out of Assam. The border issues came as a result of different readings of the demarcation of boundaries in the initial agreement for the new state's creation.
