

World Liver Day



47 Years Of Aryabhata: India's Journey Into Space

- Aryabhata Was India's First Satellite, Named After The Famous Indian Astronomer.
- It Was Launched On 19 April 1975 From Kapustin Yar, A Soviet Rocket Launch And Development Site In Astrakhan Oblast Using A Kosmos-3m Launch Vehicle.
- It Was Built By The ISRO And Launched By The Soviet Union As A Part Of The Soviet Interkosmos Programme Which Provided Access To Space For Friendly States.

- The 12th edition of the AIMA Managing India Awards is being organized physically, coinciding with the 7th National Leadership Conclave.


