# **RBI Launches Digital Rupee**

- The RBI Launches Digital Rupee As A Pilot Project From November 1 & It Has Identified 9 Banks For Participation In The Pilot Launch.
- They Are The State Bank Of India, Bank Of Baroda, Union Bank Of India, HDFC Bank, ICICI Bank, Kotak Mahindra Bank, Yes Bank, IDFC First Bank, And HSBC.
- A Central Bank Digital Currency (CBDC) Or Digital Rupee Is A Digital Form Of Currency Notes Issued By A Central Bank.
- Digital Rupee Is An Electronic Form Of Money, That Can Be Used In Contactless Transactions.
- Wholesale (CBDC-W) Is Designed For Restricted Access To Select Financial Institutions Like Banks, Non-banking Financial Companies, Etc.
- Retail (CBDC-R): It Would Be Available For All The Users Regarding Transactions.



# **Mangarh Dham As National Monument**

- PM On November 1, 2022, Declared Mangarh Dham As A National Monument In The Banswara District Of Rajasthan.
- PM Said That Mangarh Dham Is A Symbol Of The Tenacity And Sacrifices Of The Tribals And Added Is The Common Heritage Of Rajasthan, Gujarat, Maharashtra, And MP.
- Mangarh Dham History: During The Freedom Struggle Where Bhils And Other Tribes Engaged In A Long Stand-off With Britishers, More Than 1.5 Lakh Bhils Rallied At Mangarh Hill On November 17, 1913, Under The Leadership Of Shri Govind Guru.
- Britishers Opened Fire At, Leading To Mangarh Massacre (1500 Tribals Were Martyred)



# India Celebrates Foundation Day – 1<sup>st</sup> November

- On 1<sup>st</sup> November 2000, Chhattisgarh Was Separated From MP & Becomes The New State Of India.
- Madhya Pradesh Celebrated Its 67<sup>th</sup> Foundation Day On 1 November 2022.

- On 1 November 1956, MP, Karnataka, Kerala & Andhra Pradesh Were Founded.
