Biggest Manipur Festival Sangai 2022


- The Biggest Tourism Festival Of Manipur Sangai Festival On 21 November

- Theme Of The Sangai Festival 2022: Festival Of Oneness'.




World Heritage Week 2022

- The World Heritage Week Is Celebrated By The Archaeological Survey Of India & It Is Also Celebrated By UNESCO And Other International Organisations.

- India Follows Various Approaches On World Heritage Day (18 April) And World Heritage Week (19-25 November) To Celebrate The Spirit Of The World Heritage Convention.
- Providing Free Admission At Ticketed Monuments, Involving Youth And Children Through Painting Competitions, Publishing Books On World Heritage, Among Others Are Some Of These Initiatives.
- The Member States Of UNESCO Adopted The World Heritage Convention In 1972.
- Uttar Pradesh Has The Highest Numbers Of Monuments (Total: 3,691 Monuments).
- 40 Are Listed Under The UNESCO World Heritage Sites.
- India Has The 6th Largest Number Of Heritage Sites In The World.

Australian Parliament Approves FTA With India

- Australian PM Anthony Albanese Announced Country's Free Trade Agreement With India Has Been Passed By The Australian Parliament.
- The India- Australia Economic Cooperation And Trade Agreement ("Indaus ECTA") Was Signed Virtually In The Presence Of Narendra Modi And Scott Morison.
- 12,000 Indian Goods (More Than 90%) Will Get Duty-free Access To The Australian Market.
- In The Next 5 Years, It Will Cover 100% Of Indian Goods.
- About 70% Of Australian Products Will Get Duty-free And Concessional Access To The Indian Market (Will Increase To 85 % In 10 Years).
- Dairy Sector Is Out Of The Trade Deal.
- Indian Exporters In Labour-intensive Ones Like Agriculture, Textiles & Garments And Pharmaceuticals Will Get Duty-free Access To The Australian Market.
- The Deal Also Agrees Freer Mobility Of Skilled Professionals From India.
- India Majorly Exports Petroleum Products, Gems And Jewellery, Textiles And Apparels, Engineering Goods, Leather, Chemicals To Australia.
- Australia Is The 17th Largest Trading Partner Of India And India Is Australia's 9th Largest Partner.



India Will Chair Global Partnership On AI - 2022-23

- In Tokyo, The Ministry Of Electronics And IT Said That India Will Take Over The Chairmanship Of The Global Partnership On Artificial Intelligence (2022-23)
 From France.
- It Is An International Initiative To Support Responsible And Human-Centric Development And The Use Of AI.
- GPAI Includes 25 Member Countries, Like US, UK, European Union, Australia, Canada, France, Germany, Italy, Japan, Mexico, New Zealand, South Korea, And Singapore.
- India Joined The GPAI In 2020 As A Founding Member.
- By 2035, Artificial Intelligence Is Expected To Add 967 Billion US Dollars To The Indian Economy.
- It Is Also Predicted To Add **450 To 500 Billion US Dollars** To **India's GDP By 2025**.



Russia - The Biggest Supplier Of Fertilizers To India

- Russia Becomes The Biggest Supplier Of Fertilizers To India In The 1st Half Of The 2022-23 Financial Year Replacing China.
- The Russians Offered Its Fertilizers To India At A High Discount After The Global Fertilizer Prices Jumped During The Russia-Ukraine War.
- Russia's Share In Indian Imports Was Around 6% In The 2021/22 Financial Year While China Was Around 24%.

- India's Fertilizer Imports From Russia Increased By 371% To A Record 2.15 Million Tonnes In The 1st 6 Months Of The Year (April- September 2022).
- India, Which Is A Major Importer Of Urea, Aims To Become Selfsufficient By 2024.
- Russia And Belarus Were A Major Exporter Of Fertilizers In The World.

- World Fisheries Day Is Celebrated Annually On 21st November & Its Aims To Highlighting The Critical Importance Of Healthy Ocean Ecosystems And To Ensure Sustainable Stocks Of Fisheries In The World.
- Fisheries Sector Play A Vital Role In The Socio-economic Development Of Fisherfolk.
- This Sector Has Been Recognized As A Powerful Income And Employment Generator As It Creates Growth Of A Number Of Adjacent Industries & Is A Source Of Cheap And Nutritious Food.
- It Is The Source Of Livelihood For A Large Section Of Economically Backward Population Of Our World.
- It Is Very Important To **Find Solutions Of Challenges** Faced By This **Industry For The Development Of Our World** And **To Address These Problems.**
- The First World Fisheries Day Was Celebrated On November 21, 2015.
- WFF (World Fisheries Forum) Was Established Around 1997.



OECD Cuts India Growth Rate To 6.6 %In 2022

- The Organisation For Economic Co-operation And Development (OECD) Has Recently Cut The Expected Growth Rate Of The Economy Of India In 2022
 To 6.6% From Its Earlier Forecast Of 6.9% But It Has Retained Its Earlier Prediction Of 5.7% In 2023.
- OECD Expects The World Economy To Grow By 3.1% Down From 5.9% Growth In 2021.
- It Expects The Growth To Be 2.2 % In 2023 And 2.7% In 2024.
- Europe Has Been Hit Hardest Due To The Russia -Ukraine War And The High Energy Prices.
- **Germany Is** Expected To Contract By **-0.3% In 2022.**
- U.S. Is Expected To Grow By 1.8% This Year, 0.5% In 2023 And 1.0% In 2024.
- China Growth Was Seen Rising From 3.3% This Year To 4.6% In 2023 And 4.1% In 2024.
- Organisation Of Economic Cooperation & Development:
- It Was Established On **16 December 1960** By **18 European Countries** And The **United States, Canada.**
- It Is A Think Tank Which Encourages The Free Market Economy.
