- Japan Maritime Self-Defence Force (JMSDF) ships that include the helicopter carrier **Izumo** and guided-missile destroyer **Takanami**.

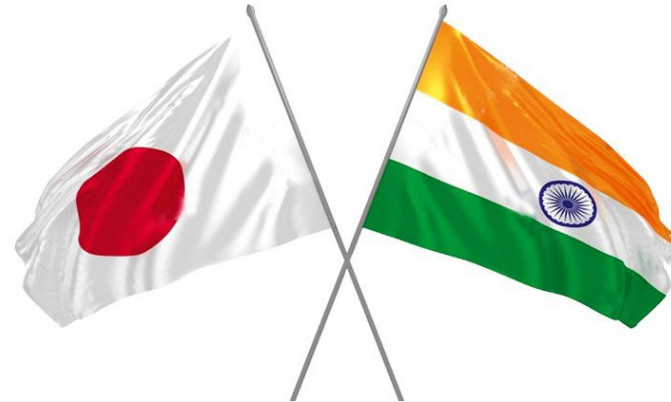

Malabar Exercise 2022

- The Opening Ceremony of MALABAR 2022 hosted by Vice Admiral Yuasa Hideki, SDF Fleet Commander was held onboard JS Hyuga at **Yokosuka, Japan** on 08 November 2022. This edition of the exercise held from 08 to 15 November 2022.



30th Anniversary of MALABAR Exercise

- It marks 30th anniversary of the multi-national maritime exercise MALABAR which began in **1992** as a bilateral exercise between India and the US.



Participating Nations

- The ceremony was attended by crew and planning staff of participating ships, aircraft and Special Forces from **Australia, India, Japan and United States.**



Indian Navy At Ex Malabar 2022

- The Indian delegation comprising Commanding Officers and crew of **INS Shivalik, INS Kamorta, P8I and Marine Commandos** was led by Rear Admiral Sanjay Bhalla, FOCEF.



Exercises Conducted At Ex Malabar 2022

- The exercise witnessed live weapon firings, complex surface, Anti-Air and Anti-Submarine Warfare drills, and joint manoeuvres including an advanced tactical exercises.



History of 'Ex Malabar'

- Malabar Exercise started in **1992** as a bilateral naval exercise between the navies of India and the US. Japan joined the Malabar exercise in 2015, making it a trilateral exercise. In 2020, Australia became part of Malabar, making it a quadrilateral naval exercise.



Aim Of The Exercise

- "Malabar 2022 provides another opportunity for the Indian Navy to enhance interoperability and mutual understanding with the participating navies in keeping with the national vision of security and growth for all in the region," said an Indian Navy spokesperson.



Previous Ex Malabar 2021

- Quad (Quadrilateral Framework) Nations (India, the United States, Japan, and Australia) have participated in the **25th** edition of the Malabar Exercise, which began off the coast of **Guam in the Pacific Ocean**.

Exercise SEA VIGIL- 2022

- The third edition of the 'Pan-India' Coastal Defence Exercise 'Sea Vigil-22' conducted on 15-16 Nov 22. This National Level Coastal Defence Exercise was conceptualised in 2018 to validate various measures that have been instituted towards enhancing maritime security since '26/11'.



Exercise SEA VIGIL- 2022

- The exercise will be undertaken along the entire 7516 km coastline and Exclusive Economic Zone of India and will involve all the Coastal States and Union territories along with other maritime stakeholders, including the fishing and coastal communities.



Exercise SEA VIGIL- 2022

- The exercise is being conducted by the Indian Navy in coordination with the Coast Guard and other ministries entrusted with the task of maritime activities.



Pan India Level Exercise

- The scale and conceptual expanse of the exercise is unprecedented in terms of the geographical extent, the number of stakeholders involved, the number of units participating and in terms of the objectives to be met.



Exercise SEA VIGIL & TROPEX- 2022

- The exercise is a build up towards the major Theatre Level Readiness Operational Exercise (TROPEX), which the Indian Navy conducts every two years.



Aim Of The Exercise

- Sea Vigil and TROPEX together covered the entire spectrum Maritime Security challenges. Assets of the Indian Navy, Coast Guard, Customs and other maritime agencies will participate in Ex Sea Vigil.



Aim Of The Exercise

- It provides opportunity, at the apex level, to assess our preparedness in the domain of Maritime Security and Coastal Defence. Exercise Sea Vigil-22 provide realistic assessment of our strengths and weaknesses and thus helps in further strengthening Maritime and National Security.



Exercise Sangam 2022

- The 7th edition of Exercise Sangam, a joint Naval Special Forces exercise between Indian Navy MARCOs and US Navy SEALs commenced from 01 Dec 22 at Goa.



Exercise Sangam 2022

- Exercise Sangam was first conducted in 1994 and is an important military and diplomatic initiative between the two nations, reflective of the trust and friendship between them.

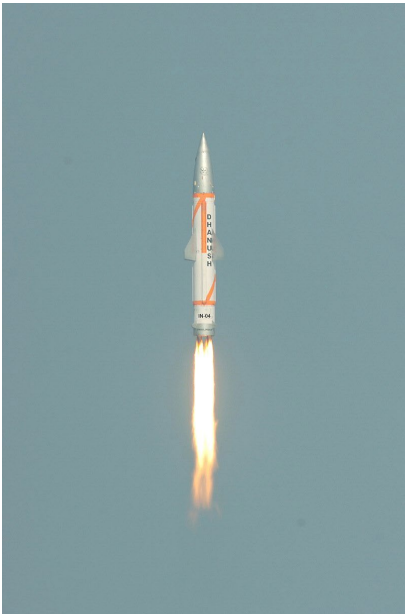


Major Successful Missile Tests



Prithvi-II

- A successful training launch of a Short-Range Ballistic Missile, Prithvi-II was carried out in June from the Integrated Test Range, Chandipur, Odisha. The missile is a proven system and is capable of striking targets with a very high degree of precision.



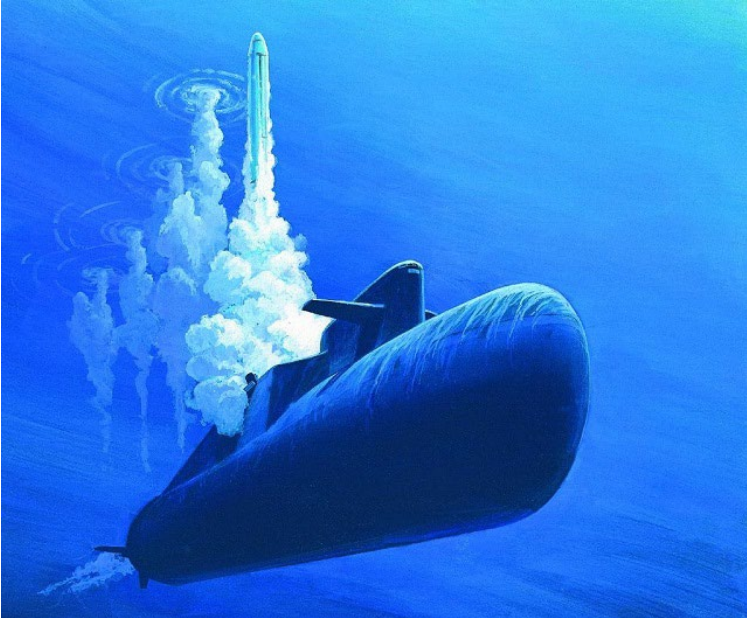
Submarine Launched Ballistic Missile

- INS Arihant carried out a successful launch of a Submarine Launched Ballistic Missile in October. The missile was tested to a predetermined range and impacted the target area in the Bay of Bengal with very high accuracy. All operational and technological parameters of the weapon system have been validated.



Submarine Launched Ballistic Missile

- INS Arihant is India's first homemade nuclear submarine and was launched in 2009. India has since developed two surface-to-surface submarine-launched missiles, one of which has a range of 3,500 km.

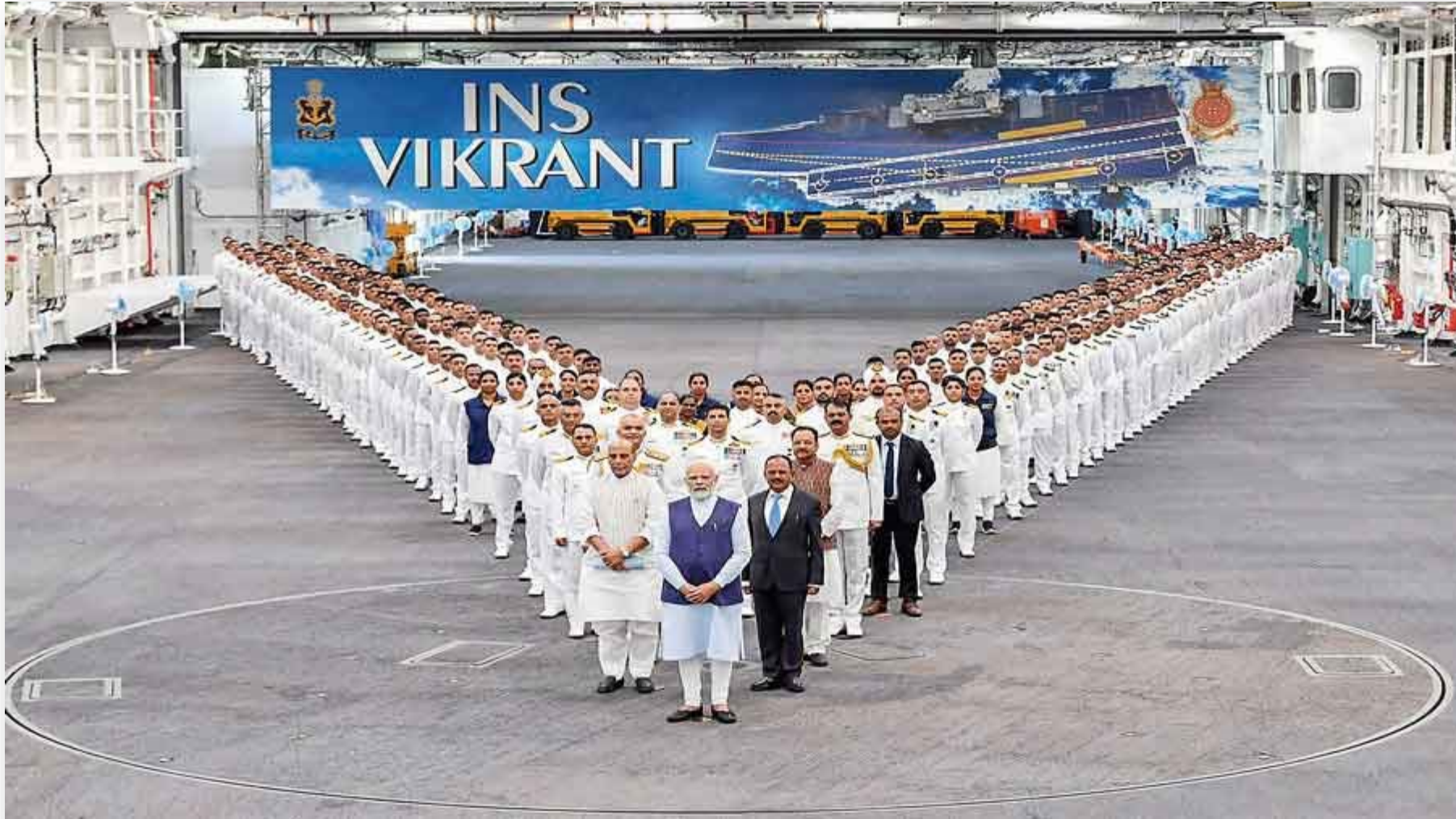


Naval Anti-Ship Missile

- DRDO and Indian Navy successfully conducted maiden flight-test of indigenously-developed Naval Anti-Ship Missile launched from a Naval Helicopter from ITR, Chandipur off the coast of Odisha in May. It was the first indigenous air launched anti-ship missile system for the Indian Navy.




Commissioning of INS Vikrant

- Showcasing the country's growing prowess of indigenous manufacturing and a major milestone in the path towards 'Aatmanirbhar Bharat', PM Narendra Modi commissioned the country's first indigenous aircraft carrier INS Vikrant at Cochin Shipyard Limited (CSL) on September 02, 2022.

- During the event, the Prime Minister also unveiled the **new Naval Ensign (Nishaan)**, doing away with the colonial past and befitting the rich Indian maritime heritage. He dedicated the new ensign to Chhatrapati Shivaji.



President's Fleet Review – 22

- The President's Fleet Review was conducted at Visakhapatnam on February 21, 2022. The event witnessed participation of 60 ships (54 IN, 03 CG, 02 SCI and 01 NIOT), three submarines, 55 IN and four CG aircraft. The review was also witnessed by the Raksha Mantri, Raksha Rajya Mantri and other Central and State Government dignitaries.



President's Fleet Review – 22

- The theme of the President's Fleet Review-2022 was '**Indian Navy ' 75 years in Service of the Nation'**, commemorating the Azaadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav.



INS Mormugao, 2nd Warship Of P15B Class, Commissioned By Raksha Mantri

- The event marked the formal induction of the second of the four 'Visakhapatnam' class destroyers, indigenously designed by the Indian Navy's in-house organisation Warship Design Bureau and constructed by Mazagon Dock Shipbuilders Limited (MDL), Mumbai.



INS Mormugao, 2nd Warship Of P15B Class, Commissioned By Raksha Mantri

- Measuring 163m in length and 17m in breadth with a displacement of 7,400 tonnes, INS Mormugao is packed with sophisticated state-of-the-art weapons and sensors such as Surface-to-Surface Missile and Surface-to-Air Missiles.



LAUNCH OF 'ARNALA', FIRST SHIP OF ASW SWC

- 'Arnala', the first of 08 x ASW SWC Project, being built by GRSE for Indian Navy was launched on 20 Dec 22 at M/s L&T, Kattupalli, Chennai. She made her first contact with water of Bay of Bengal at 1040 hrs at the Launch Ceremony graced by Smt Rasika Chaube, Financial Adviser (Defence Services), MOD.



LAUNCH OF 'ARNALA', FIRST SHIP OF ASW SWC

- The ship has been named Arnala to signify the strategic maritime importance accorded to the island of Arnala (located about 13 Km north of Vasai, Maharashtra) by the great Maratha warrior, Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj.



LAUNCH OF 'ARNALA', FIRST SHIP OF ASW SWC

- The 77.6m ASW SWC ships have a displacement of 900 tons with a maximum speed of 25 knots and endurance of 1800 NM.

- Recently, the Ministry of Defense signed a **Rs 1700 crore** contract with **BrahMos Aerospace Pvt Ltd** to buy additional dual-role capable BrahMos missiles for the Indian Navy.

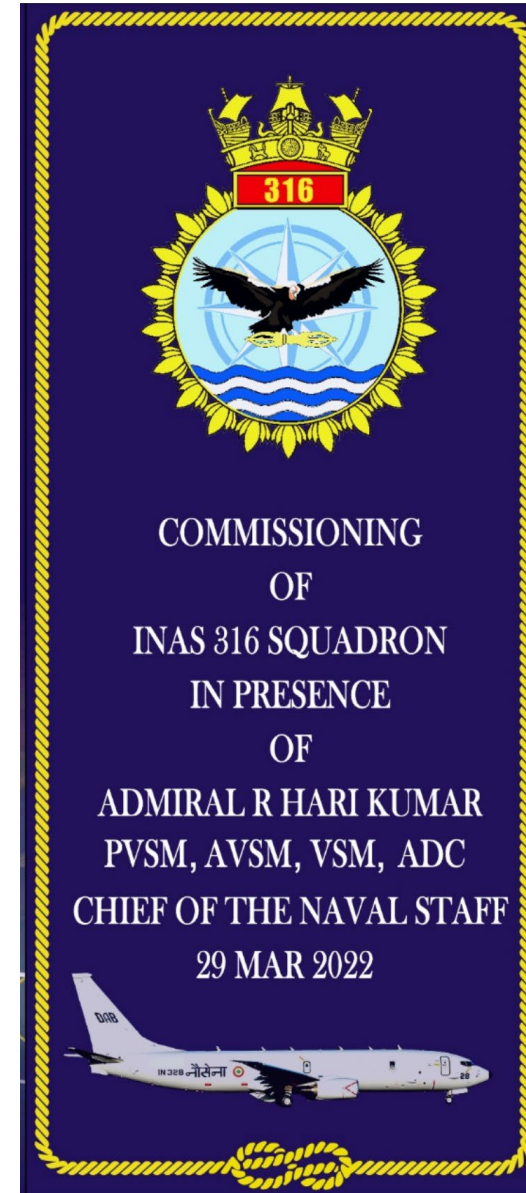
President's Colour to INS Valsura

- The President's Colour Award is the highest honor that can be bestowed upon any military unit of India. It is also known as '**Nishaan**' which is an emblem that will be worn by all unit officers on the left-hand sleeve of their uniform.
- It was the Indian Navy that was the first branch of the Armed Forces to receive the President's Colour in **May 1951**.



INAS 316 Commissioned At INS Hansa

- Indian Naval Air Squadron (INAS) 316, the Indian Navy's second P-8I aircraft squadron, commissioned at INS Hansa in Goa.
- The INAS 316 was commissioned in the presence of Admiral R Hari Kumar, Chief of the Naval Staff.



INAS 316 Commissioned At INS Hansa

- INAS 316 will operate the Boeing P-8I, the most sophisticated multi-role Long Range Maritime Reconnaissance LRMR and Anti-Submarine Warfare ASW aircraft in the world today.



INAS 316 Commissioned At INS Hansa

- INAS 316 will operate the second batch of four additional aircraft acquired, adding teeth to the armour of the Indian Navy, to deter, detect and destroy any threat to the nation in the IOR.



INAS 316 Commissioned At INS Hansa

- The aircraft is powered by twin jet engines and can be equipped with air-to-ship missiles and torpedoes. Indian Navy had acquired the first batch of eight P-8I aircraft in 2013 that are stationed at INS Rajali.

- Vice Admiral Sanjay Mahindru, AVSM, NM assumed charge as Deputy Chief of the Naval Staff on 31 Mar 22.

- ALH MK III choppers are fitted with modern surveillance radar and electro-optical equipment which enables them to undertake the role of long-range maritime reconnaissance.

- These helicopters also feature an array of state-of-the-art sensors, which add up to the maritime prowess of the Indian Coast Guard at sea. They have traffic alert and collision avoidance system, advanced communication systems, a heavy machine gun, a removable Medical Intensive Care Unit and other facilities.

- Four such helicopters are positioned at Bhubaneswar, covering the entire coast of West Bengal and Orissa.



Russian Naval Warship Sinks

- Powerful explosions were heard in Kyiv on Friday and fighting raged in the east after Ukraine claimed responsibility for the sinking of the Russian navy's Black Sea flagship in what would be one of the heaviest blows of the war.



Russian Naval Warship Sinks

- The explosions appeared to be among the most significant in Ukraine's capital region since Russian troops pulled back from the area earlier this month in preparation for battles in the south and east.



Russian Naval Warship Sinks

- Ukraine said it hit the **Moskva missile cruiser with a Neptune anti-ship missile**. The Soviet-era ship sank on Thursday as it was being towed to port following a fire and explosions, Russia's defense ministry said.

- The 6th and last submarine of the Indian Navy's Kalvari class submarines of Project 75 has been launched at the Kanhoji Angre Wet Basin of MDL. Dr. Ajay Kumar, Defence Secretary was the Chief Guest at the ceremony and the submarine named 'Vagsheer' was launched by Mrs. Veena Ajay Kumar, in keeping with Naval traditions of launch/ naming by a lady.

- The first of the Project - 75 submarines was commissioned into the Navy in December 2017 and presently four submarines of this Project are in commission in the Indian Navy. The 5TH submarine is progressing with the Sea Trials and is likely to be delivered this year.



Indian Navy To Operate Electric-boats, Bengaluru Firm Building Prototype

- As part of the defence electrification programme, the Indian Navy is, for the first time, looking to operate electric-boats. A Bengaluru-based EV platform startup — **Tresa Energy** — has begun a 12-month pilot (prototype-stage) to build a Rigid Inflatable Boat (RIB) called the “EV.7M RIB”.



Indian Navy To Operate Electric-boats, Bengaluru Firm Building Prototype

- The lightweight, high-performance RIB, which can seat 18 people, will be useful for patrolling, interception, search and rescue, and transport by the Navy.
- The EV.7M RIB can do all of these with a higher stealth mode and cannot be detected by heat maps, as it does not generate heat or sound.

- Indian Coast Guard commissioned its second Air Squadron equipped with the indigenously designed and developed ALH MK III on 04 May at Coast Guard Air Enclave Kochi. 845 Squadron (CG) became the premier ALH MK-III squadron in the Coast Guard's western seaboard.
- The 845 Sqn (CG) is commanded by Commandant Kunal Naik.
