• Started in 2017, Ex Ekatha is conducted annually with the aim of joint trg in Diving & Asymmetric Warfare & enhance interoperability.




### **Indian Navy Marine Commandos**


#### **Ex JIMEX 2022**

• The exercise witnessed live weapon firings, complex surface, Anti-Air and Anti-Submarine Warfare drills, and joint manoeuvres including an advanced tactical exercises.





### History of 'Ex Malabar'

 Malabar Exercise started in 1992 as a bilateral naval exercise between the navies of India and the US. Japan joined the Malabar exercise in 2015, making it a trilateral exercise. In 2020, Australia became part of Malabar, making it a quadrilateral naval exercise.



#### **Aim Of The Exercise**

• "Malabar 2022 provides another opportunity for the Indian Navy to enhance interoperability and mutual understanding with the participating navies in keeping with the national vision of security and growth for all in the region," said an Indian Navy spokesperson.



### **Previous Ex Malabar 2021**

• Quad (Quadrilateral Framework) Nations (India, the United States, Japan, and Australia) have participated in the **25**<sup>th</sup> edition of the Malabar Exercise, which began off the coast of **Guam in the Pacific Ocean**.



• A successful training launch of a Short-Range Ballistic Missile, Prithvi-II was carried out in June from the Integrated Test Range, Chandipur, Odisha. The missile is a proven system and is capable of striking targets with a very high degree of precision.



#### **Submarine Launched Ballistic Missile**


• INS Arihant carried out a successful launch of a Submarine Launched Ballistic Missile in October. The missile was tested to a predetermined range and impacted the target area in the Bay of Bengal with very high accuracy. All operational and technological parameters of the weapon system have been

validated.



#### **Submarine Launched Ballistic Missile**

• INS Arihant is India's first homemade nuclear submarine and was launched in 2009. India has since developed two surface-to-surface submarine-launched missiles, one of which has a range of 3,500 km.




## **Naval Anti-Ship Missile**

 DRDO and Indian Navy successfully conducted maiden flight-test of indigenously-developed Naval Anti-Ship Missile launched from a Naval Helicopter from ITR, Chandipur off the coast of Odisha in May. It was the first indigenous air launched anti-ship missile system for the Indian Navy.


## **Commissioning of INS Vikrant**


### LAUNCH OF 'ARNALA', FIRST SHIP OF ASW SWC

#### **New Deal of Brahmos Missile**

 Recently, the Ministry of Defense signed a Rs 1700 crore contract with BrahMos Aerospace Pvt Ltd to buy additional dual-role capable BrahMos missiles for the Indian Navy.



#### **New Deal of Brahmos Missile**

• Dual role capability refers to the use of BrahMos missiles for land as well as anti-ship attacks. They can be launched from land, air and sea, and all three variants are in service in the Indian armed forces.






## What is the Significance of the Deal?

#### President's Colour to INS Valsura




#### President's Colour to INS Valsura

 The President's Colour Award is the highest honor that can be bestowed upon any military unit of India. It is also known as 'Nishaan' which is an emblem that will be worn by all unit officers on the left-hand sleeve of their uniform.





- Indian Naval Air Squadron (INAS) 316, the Indian Navy's second P-8l aircraft squadron, commissioned at INS Hansa in Goa.
- The INAS 316 was commissioned in the presence of Admiral R Hari Kumar, Chief of the Naval Staff.



• INAS 316 will operate the Boeing P-8l, the most sophisticated multi-role Long Range Maritime Reconnaissance LRMR and Anti-Submarine Warfare ASW aircraft in the world today.



• INAS 316 will operate the second batch of four additional aircraft acquired, adding teeth to the armour of the Indian Navy, to deter, detect and destroy any threat to the nation in the IOR.



• The aircraft is powered by twin jet engines and can be equipped with airto-ship missiles and torpedoes. Indian Navy had acquired the first batch of eight P-8I aircraft in 2013 that are stationed at INS Rajali.

- As part of the Golden Jubilee celebrations, a
  documentary encapsulating the growth of the
  Eastern Fleet from its formation in 1971 to its
  present position of eminence, was also screened.
- The events were attended by 14 former Fleet
   Commanders, besides a large number of Flag
   Officers, officers, sailors and their families.



• INS Shivalik was adjudged as the Best Ship of the Eastern Fleet. INS

Kadmatt was adjudged as the Best Corvette, and the Most Spirited Ship

trophy was awarded jointly to INS Satpura and INS Kora.



• The Indian Coast Guard (ICG) on Sunday commissioned a squadron of Advanced Light Helicopter (ALH) MK III, which will strengthen maritime

security.



• ALH MK III choppers are fitted with modern surveillance radar and electrooptical equipment which enables them to undertake the role of long-range

maritime reconnaissance.



These helicopters also feature an array of state-of-the-art sensors, which
add up to the maritime prowess of the Indian Coast Guard at sea. They have
traffic alert and collision avoidance system, advanced communication
systems, a heavy machine gun, a removable Medical Intensive Care Unit and
other facilities.

• Four such helicopters are positioned at Bhubaneswar, covering the entire coast of West Bengal and Orissa.



## **Russian Naval Warship Sinks**

• Powerful explosions were heard in Kyiv on Friday and fighting raged in the east after Ukraine claimed responsibility for the sinking of the Russian navy's Black Sea flagship in what would be one of the heaviest blows of the war.



### **Russian Naval Warship Sinks**

• The explosions appeared to be among the most significant in Ukraine's capital region since Russian troops pulled back from the area earlier this month in preparation for battles in the south and east.



### **Russian Naval Warship Sinks**

• Ukraine said it hit the **Moskva missile cruiser with a Neptune anti-ship missile**. The Soviet-era ship sank on Thursday as it was being towed to port following a fire and explosions, Russia's defense ministry said.



#### LAUNCH OF 6th SCORPENE SUBMARINE 'VAGSHEER'

• The 6<sup>th</sup> and last submarine of the Indian Navy's Kalvari class submarines of Project 75 has been launched at the Kanhoji Angre Wet Basin of MDL. Dr. Ajay Kumar, Defence Secretary was the Chief Guest at the ceremony and the submarine named 'Vagsheer' was launched by Mrs. Veena Ajay Kumar, in keeping with Naval traditions of launch/ naming by a lady.



### LAUNCH OF 6th SCORPENE SUBMARINE 'VAGSHEER'

• The first of the Project - 75 submarines was commissioned into the Navy in December 2017 and presently four submarines of this Project are in commission in the Indian Navy. The 5<sup>TH</sup> submarine is progressing with the Sea Trials and is likely to be delivered this year.



# Indian Navy To Operate Electric-boats, Bengaluru Firm Building Prototype

 As part of the defence electrification programme, the Indian Navy is, for the first time, looking to operate electric-boats. A Bengaluru-based EV platform startup — **Tresa Energy** — has begun a 12-month pilot (prototype-stage) to build a Rigid Inflatable Boat (RIB) called the "EV.7M RIB".



# Indian Navy To Operate Electric-boats, Bengaluru Firm Building Prototype

- The lightweight, high-performance RIB, which can seat 18 people, will be useful for patrolling, interception, search and rescue, and transport by the Navy.
- The EV.7M RIB can do all of these with a higher stealth mode and cannot be detected by heat maps, as it does not generate heat or sound.



### AIR SQUADRON COMMISSIONED IN COAST GUARD

 Indian Coast Guard commissioned its second Air Squadron equipped with the indigenously designed and developed ALH MK III on 04 may at Coast Guard Air Enclave Kochi. 845 Squadron (CG) became the premier ALH MK-III squadron in the Coast Guard's western seaboard.



• The 845 Sqn (CG) is commanded by Commandant Kunal Naik.

### AIR SQUADRON COMMISSIONED IN COAST GUARD

- In a major boost to India's maritime security,
   845 Squadron (CG), has been commissioned by
   Director General VS Pathania.
- The commissioning of this squadron earmarks a tremendous leap towards self-reliance in the field of SAR and Long-Range Maritime
   Surveillance, in line with government's push towards "Aatmanirbhar Bharat".



# Time to Make-for-World, Says Rajnath as Indian Navy Launches Indigenous Warships

 Defence Minister Rajnath Singh expressed India's grit towards indigenous shipbuilding as he presided over the launch of the Indian Navy destroyer warship INS Surat and frigate INS Udaygiri in Mumbai. "We will aim for not just Make-In-India but also for Make-for-World," Singh said.
