

Chandrayaan-3 Lander Has Successfully Underwent EMI Test

- The 'Chandrayaan-3' Lander Has "Successfully" Passed The Electro-Magnetic Interference/Electro-Magnetic Compatibility (EMI/EMC) Test At The U R Rao Satellite Centre In Bengaluru.
- The Purpose Of This Test Is To Ensure Functionality Of The Satellite Subsystems In Space.
- Number Of Tests Including Launch Capability, Polarisation Of Antenna For Radio Frequency Systems And Compatibility Of Lander And Rover Were Done.
- To Ensure Satellite's Systems Work Properly In Conjunction With The Expected Electromagnetic Levels In Space

Arunachal Pradesh Statehood Day – 20 February

- Through The 55th Amendment Of The Indian Constitution In 1986, Arunachal Pradesh Became The 24th State Of The India On February 20, 1987.
- Every Year 20 February Is Celebrated As The Foundation Day Of Arunachal Pradesh & People Celebrated State's 37th Statehood Day
- To The Center And The States On Important Issues Relating To GST.
- It Became A UT On 20 January, 1972 And Was Named Arunachal Pradesh.
- During British Rule, Until 1972, The State Was Known As The North-east Frontier Agency (NEFA).
- It Was Given Full Statehood By The Arunachal Pradesh State Act, 1986 & Was Formed In The Year 1987 By Separating From Assam.



Mizoram Statehood Day – 20 February


- The State Of Mizoram Was Formed On 20 February 1987 Following The 53rd Amendment To The Constitution Of India, 1986.
- The Mizo Hills Region Became The Lushai Hills District Within Assam After Independence.
- In 1954 It Was Renamed Mizo Hills District Of Assam.
- Mizoram Was Granted Union Territory Status In 1972 Following The Signing Of An Important Accord With The Moderates Of The Mizo National Front (MNF).
- Became The 23rd Full State Of India On 20 February 1987.
- It Shares Nternational Border With Myanmar And Bangladesh.



Antarctica Sea Ice Cover Reaches To A Record Low Level

- According To The National Snow And Ice Data Center In The United States, Antarctica's Sea Ice Extent Was Recorded At 2.2 Million Square Kms Down From 2.27 Million Square Kms As Of February 24, 2022 (Previous Record)
- According To Scientists, Due To The Hot Winds, The Snow Is Melting Rapidly, This Year The Temperature Of The Hot Winds Has Been 1.5 Degrees Above The Average.
- This Is The Lowest Since Records Began In 1979.
- This Is The 2nd Consecutive Year When Snow Has Melted Up To 20 Lakh Square Km In A Day
- Antarctica
- It Is The Southernmost Continent And The 5th Largest Continent On Earth.
- About 40 Permanent Stations Set Up By Many Countries Including India For Scientific Research.
- India Has 2 Research Centres On The Antarctic Continent Maitri And Bharati.








EU Bans Gas, Diesel Car Sales From 2035
