- Swiss Firm IQAir Report Has Released Its 'World Air Quality Report', India Has Moved Up To The 8th Position In The List Of World's Most Polluted Countries In 2022.
- Previous Year: 5th Position.
- Chad, Iraq, Pakistan, Bahrain, Bangladesh, Burkina Faso, Kuwait, India, Egypt and Tajikistan Are Most Polluted.
- 39 Of The World's 50 Most Polluted Cities Are In India.
- According To It, The Transport Sector Is Responsible For 20-35% Of PM 2.5
 Pollution In India.
- India Has Been Placed At The 8th Position In The Latest Report With PM2.5 Level At 53.3
- Lahore In Pakistan & Hotan In China Are The 2 Most Polluted Cities In The World, Followed By Bhiwadi In Rajasthan At The 3rd Place And Delhi At The Fourth Place.
- According to this report, India And Pakistan Have The Worst Air Quality In The Central And South Asian Region

US Recognizes Mcmahon Line As International Border

- The USA Has Recognized The Mcmahon Line As The International Boundary Between Arunachal Pradesh And China In A Recently Passed Bipartisan Resolution, Calling It An "Integral Part Of India".
- The Resolution Rejected Beijing's Claim That The Arunachal Pradesh Falls Under Chinese Territory
- The 'Reaffirmation Of Arunachal Pradesh As Indian Territory And Condemnation Of China's Provocative Activities In South Asia', Resolution Came After A Major Clash Between The Indian And Chinese Forces In Arunachal's Tawang.
- About McMahon Line
- India And China Share A 3,500 Km Long Border Which Is Disputed Although China Considers The Mcmahon Line Illegal.
- The Mcmahon Line Was Drawn During The Simla Convention Of 1914, Officially Described As A Convention Between Great Britain, China And Tibet.

- India Observes National Immunization Day Every Year On 16 March To Raise Awareness About Polio Eradication Worldwide.
- India Has Set A Target Of Vaccinating More Than 324 Million Children Through MR Vaccination Campaigns To Eliminate Measles And Rubella.
- This Day Was 1st Observed In 1995 When The Pulse Polio Immunization Program Was Launched To Eradicate Polio From India.
- The Last Polio Case In India Was Reported In 2011 In Howrah, West Bengal, And India Was Declared Polio-free On March 27, 2014.





Green National Highway Corridor Project

- India & The World Bank Have Signed A Loan Agreement For The Construction Of The Green National Highway Corridors Project In 4 States (Himachal Pradesh, Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh And Andhra Pradesh).
- Construction Of 781 Kilometer GNHC In These States With A Line Of Credit Of \$500 Million.
- It Will Integrate Safe And Green Technology Designs Such As Local And Marginal Materials Such As Lime, Fly Ash, Waste Plastic, Industrial Byproducts And Other Bioengineering Solutions Like Hydroseeding, Coco/Jute Fibre, Etc.
- It Will Also Support The Bharatmala Pariyojana Programme.








Earthquake Strikes New Zealand's Kermadec Island
