# India's AI Supercomputer 'AIRAWAT' Ranked 75th In World

- The Al Supercomputer 'AlRAWAT', Installed At C-DAC, Pune Has Been Ranked 75<sup>th</sup> In The Top 500 Global Supercomputing List.
- The Announcement Was Made During The 61st Edition Of The International Supercomputing Conference (ISC 2023) Held In Germany.
- The Proposed AIRAWAT System Is A 100+ Petaflop AI-Focused Supercomputer.
- There Are Parallels Drawn To Japan's Al Bridging Cloud Interface
   Supercomputer In The NITI Aayog Report.
- This System Is A 130 Petaflop Computer Focused On Providing Compute For AI,
   MI & Big Data Tasks
- What Are Supercomputers
- A Supercomputer Can Perform High-level Processing At A Faster Rate Than A Normal Computer.
- They Work Together To Perform Complex Operations That Are Not Possible With Normal Computing Systems.
- The Performance Of A Supercomputer Is Generally Evaluated In **Petaflops.**





# **Bangladesh Faces Fuel Crisis Due To Dollar Shortages**

- Bangladesh Is Struggling To Pay For Imported Fuel Because Of A Dollar Shortage, Letters Reviewed By Reuters Show, With The State Petroleum Company Owing More Than \$300 Million As It Faces An "Alarming Decrease In Fuel Reserves"
- It Owes More Than \$300 Million To 6 Overseas Companies, Some Of Which
  Have Either Sent Fewer Cargoes Than Scheduled Or Threatened To Halt
  Supplies, According To One Of The 2 Letters From The Bangladesh Petroleum
  Corp (BPC).
- The Country Is Already Grappling With Power Cuts That Have Hurt Its Exportsoriented Garments Industry. Separately, The Body Responsible For Generating Electricity And Distribution Also Warned It Had To Delay Payments Due To The Currency Crunch
- Bangladesh's Dollar Reserves Have Shrunk More Than A 3<sup>rd</sup> Since Russia's
   Invasion Of Ukraine In February Last Year To Stand At A 7-year Low Of \$30.18

   Billion.
- The Country Of Nearly 170 Million People Has Already Had To Secure A Loan Of \$4.7 Billion From The IMF.

   And Rupee Currencies

- Indian Long Jumper Murali Sreeshankar Won Gold While Compatriot Jeswin Aldrin Finished Bagged Silver At The International Jumping Meeting 2023 At Kallithea In Greece.
- Kerala's Murali Sreesankar Won The Gold Medal In The International Jumping Meet With A Jump Of 8.31 Metres
- Sreeshankar, Who Has Played In The Tokyo Olympics, Holds The **National Record Of 8.36 Metres.**
- Sweden's **Tobias Montaller Won The Silver** With A Jump Of **8.27m**, While France's **Jules Pommery Won The Bronze**.
- This Was Murali Sreesankar's Third Competition Of The Year And Also Won The Third Gold Medal




#### **India And Australia Signed A Migration Deal Pact**

- India And Australia Signed A Migration & Mobility Pact To Open Up Opportunities For Students & Businesspeople As They Aim To Strengthen Their Economic Cooperation.
- The Announcement Came After Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi Met His Counterpart Anthony Albanese In Sydney.
- The Deal Aims To "Promote The 2-Way Mobility Of Students, Graduates, Academic Researchers & Businesspeople".
- Australia Already Has A Significant Number Of People Who Have Migrated From India.

- **Hypothyroidism**: When The Thyroid Produces Too Few Hormones, It Causes Symptoms Such As Fatigue, Weight Gain, And Depression.
- **Hyperthyroidism**: Excessive Thyroid Hormone Production Results In Symptoms Such As Weight Loss, Rapid Heartbeat, And Anxiety
