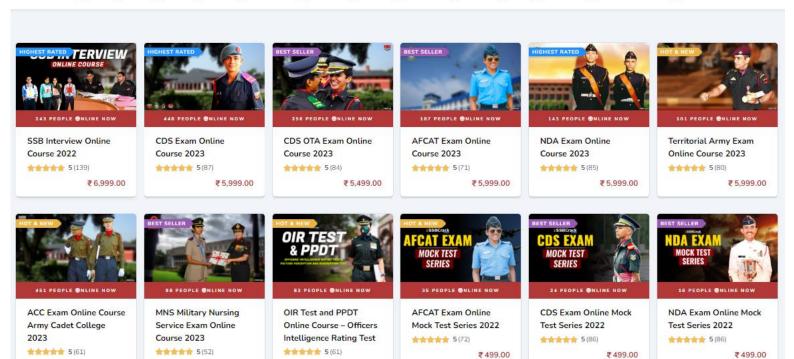



- He Stressed That Mission Life Makes The Fight Against Climate Change

- Mission Life Believes That By Making Changes To Our Lifestyle, We Can Protect The Environment.

"In Our Lifetime" Campaign Launched In COP27



What is Mission Life?


- Mission LiFE Aims To Follow A 3-Pronged Strategy To Shift Our Collective Approach To Sustainability.
- 1st: Encouraging People To Practice Simple But Effective Actions That Favor The Environment In Their Daily Lives (Demand)
- 2^{nd:} Allow Industries & Markets To Respond Quickly To Changing Demand (Supply)
- 3rd: To Influence Government And Industry Policy To Support Both Sustainable Consumption And Production (Policy)






'Reduce, Reuse And Recycle' Concept

- India Has The 4th Largest Renewable Energy Capacity In The World & Rank 4th
 In Wind Energy And 5th In Solar Energy.
- India's Renewable Energy Capacity Has Increased By 290 % In The Last 7-8
 Years.
- The Goal Of Reaching 40 % Of Electrical Capacity From Non-fossil Fuel Sources 9
 Years Ahead Of The Deadline. We Had Also Achieved A Goal Of 10 % Ethanol
 Blending In Gasoline, And That Too 5 Months Before The Deadline



Achieve Goal Of Net Zero

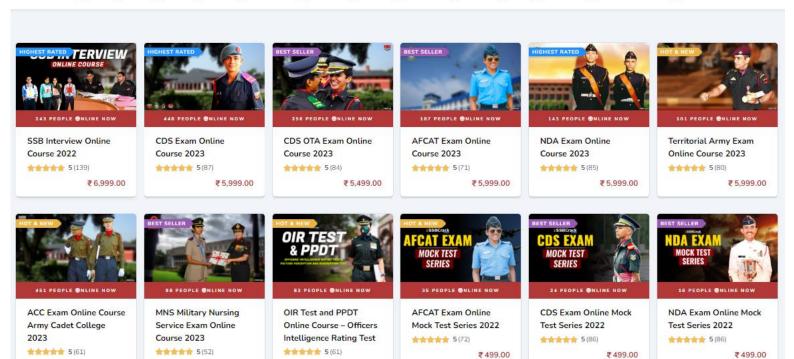
- Through The National Hydrogen Mission, India Has Moved Towards An Environmentally Friendly Source Of Energy.
