Conference & B2B Session On Indigenization Requirements Of Indian Navy

- An 'Interactive Conference & B2B Session on Indigenisation Requirements of Indian Navy: Opportunities for Industries' was conducted by the Indian Navy in association with Federation of Indian Chambers of Commerce & Industry on 26 Jun 23 at Hari Shankar Singhania Commission Auditorium of FICCI.
- The conference provided a unique opportunity for industry / MSME / Startups to interact with Indian Navy personnel and provided a platform for all stake holders to collectively discuss the indigenisation plans / end requirements of the Indian Navy towards achieving of self-reliance in the defence sector.
- The conference promoted indigenisation in congruence with the 'Make in India' vision of the Government of India.

Putin And Wagner Made Fool To USA

- Russia sought to restore calm after an aborted mutiny by Wagner Group mercenaries over the weekend, while Western allies assessed how President Vladimir Putin might reassert authority and what it could mean for the war in Ukraine.
- Ending their short-lived mutiny, Wagner fighters halted their rapid advance on Moscow, withdrew from the southern Russian city of Rostov and headed back to their bases late on Saturday under a deal that guaranteed their safety. Their commander, Yevgeny Prigozhin, would move to Belarus under the deal mediated by Belarusian President Alexander Lukashenko.
- In his own speech earlier in the day, Prigozhin said Wagner forces marched on Moscow to protest the failures of Russian military leadership in Ukraine and push back against the planned dissolution of the Wagner Group.
- Prigozhin said the Wagner Group did not attack any Russian soldiers "on the ground" but acknowledged that they fired back on military forces that had allegedly attacked Wagner fighters from the air.

Indian Army Adjudged Best Organisation In Ministry Of Defence For Procurement

- The Indian Army has been adjudged as the best organisation in the MoD for procurement on Government e-Marketplace for the financial year 2022-23 in pursuance of the PMO's overarching objective to enhance transparency, efficiency and speed in public procurement.
- Approximately 16000 buyers of the Indian Army are registered on the GeM. On an average 60- 80000 transactions per month took place with up to a maximum of two lakh tons in a month in Mar 2023 in FY 2022-23, added the release.
- Since the inception of GeM (Government e-Marketplace), Indian Army has been earnestly working towards 100 per cent procurement of all goods & services. In FY 2016-17, the Indian Army procurement of Rs 21 Cr, and since then, Army has progressively enhanced its procurement potential by proactively engaging GeM SPV, various budget holders, and CFAs down to the unit level.



"Women Activists In Manipur Are Deliberately Blocking Routes And Interfering In Op.": Army

 Noting several incidents in past of women-led mob interfering in operations of security forces in Manipur, the Indian Army has said that "blocking" movement of security personnel is not only unlawful but also detrimental to their efforts towards restoring law and order.

- A recent such instance happened last week when security forces had to "release" 12 cadres of the proscribed extremist outfit, including self-styled Lt Col Moirangthem Tamba, who is the mastermind of the 6 Dogra ambush case of 2015, which had killed 18 army personnel.
- On June 24 operation, 12 cadres of the Kanglei Yawol Kanna Lup (KYKL) were apprehended along with arms, ammunition and War like stores.
- The army said that the officer on the ground made a considerate decision to hand over all 12 cadres to the local leader, after a mob of approximately 1200-1500, led by women and the local leader immediately surrounded the target area and prevented Security Forces from continuing with the operation, which was launched in Village Itham (06 km East of Andro) in Imphal East district.



Visit by NSA Doval Reflects Strong Bilateral Relationship Between India, Oman

- The visit by National Security Advisor (NSA) Ajit Doval reflected the strong bilateral relationship between India and Oman, the Ministry of External Affairs said.
- "The discussions enabled a high-level review of the multifaceted bilateral relations between India and the Sultanate of Oman with a focus on strengthening mutually beneficial cooperation in key areas for economic and technological development, mutual security and regional stability," it added.
