USA Independence Day

- On July 4, 1776, The Second Continental Congress Unanimously Adopted The Declaration Of Independence, Announcing The Colonies' Separation From Great Britain.
- The Founding Father Delegates Of The Second Continental Congress Declared That The Thirteen Colonies Were No Longer Subject (And Subordinate) To The Monarch Of Britain, King George III, And Were Now United, Free, And Independent States.
- The Congress Voted To Approve Independence By Passing The Lee Resolution On July 2 And Adopted The Declaration Of Independence Two Days Later, On July 4.



Constitutional Crisis In Tamil Nadu

- The Ongoing Confrontation Between Tamil Nadu Governor RN Ravi And The DMK Government Led By MK Stalin Intensified With The Governor First Dismissing Arrested DMK Minister V Senthil Balaji From The Council Of Ministers, Only To Back Down Hours Later.
- Later Governor Wrote To Stalin, Conveying That The Decision To Dismiss Balaji "May Be Kept In Abeyance Until Further Communication" Since He Is Approaching The Attorney General For Legal Opinion Following Union Home Minister Amit Shah's Advice.

 The Unprecedented, And More Importantly, Unilateral Decision By A Governor To Sack A Minister Appointed On Aid And Advice Of The Chief Minister, Has Raised Questions On The Legality Of Such A Move By The Figurative Head Of A State, Nominated By The Union Government.



Protests Erupted Again In France

- The Latest Protests Erupted After Nahel, A Boy Of Algerian Descent, Was Shot Dead By The French Police For Allegedly Not Having A Driver's License. French President Emmanuel Macron Has Appealed For Calm Amid Heavy Police Deployment.
- A Few Months After It Witnessed Massive Protests Over Pension Reforms, France Is On The Boil Again. Over The Last Four Days, Protests Have Swept Across France Following The Death Of A Young Man As A Result Of The Excessive Use Of Force By The Police On June 27.



- Cars And Public Buildings Have Been Set On Fire, And Clashes Have Been Reported **Between Police And Protestors**, Who Have Taken To The Streets To Rally Against French Authorities' Excesses.
- As Per The French Interior Ministry, Since The Protests First Erupted, Over 2,800
 People Have Been Arrested, With France Deploying Around 45,000 Police
 Personnel On The Streets.

Dutch King Apologizes For Country's Role In Slavery

- Dutch King Willem-alexander Apologized For His Country's Role In Slavery And Asked For Forgiveness In A Historic Speech Greeted By Cheers And Whoops At An Event To Commemorate The Anniversary Of The Abolition Of Slavery.
- The King's Speech Followed Dutch Prime Minister Mark Rutte's Apology Late Last Year For The Country's Role In The Slave Trade And Slavery. It Is Part Of A Wider Reckoning With Colonial Histories In The West That Have Been Spurred In Recent Years By The Black Lives Matter Movement.
- The King Said He Has Commissioned A Study Into The Exact Role Of The Royal House Of Orange-Nassau In Slavery In The Netherlands.



Israeli Army Launches Massive Military Operation

- The Israeli Army Has Launched A Massive Military Operation On The Jenin Camp In The North Of The Occupied West Bank.
- It Started With Multiple Drone Strikes. The Palestinian Health Ministry Said At Least Three Palestinians Were Killed And More Than 20 Others Wounded In The Ongoing Raid.
- The Israel Defense Forces (IDF) Said They Were Striking Terrorist Infrastructure In The Jenin Area. They Said That We Will Not Standby Idle While Terrorists

Continue To Harm Civilians Using Jenin Camp As A Hideout, Adding That The Camp Was A Terrorist Stronghold.

• Dozens Of Armed, Masked Palestinians Were Deployed In The Alleys Of The Camp.

- The UAE India Economic Summit, Themed "Fostering Synergies Uniting The Falcon And Tiger Economies," Took Place On July 3, 2023, At The ADGM Auditorium In Al Maryah Island, Abu Dhabi.
- The Event, Jointly Hosted By SBI Capital Markets Limited (SBICAPS) And Abu Dhabi Global Market (ADGM), Brought Together Industry Leaders From India And The UAE, And Marked The Official Opening Of SBICAPS ADGM Branch Office.
- The Summit Featured Engaging Panel Discussions On Topics Such As Startups, Sustainability, Green Energy, Capital Markets, And Stressed Asset Resolution.





125th Birth Anniversary Of Alluri Sitarama Raju


- President Droupadi Murmu Will Take Part In The Valedictory Event Of The 125th Birth Anniversary Celebrations Of Alluri Sitarama Raju To Be Held In Hyderabad.
- Alluri Sitarama Raju (4 July 1897 Or 1898 7 May 1924) Was An Indian Revolutionary Who Waged An Armed Campaign Against The British Colonial Rule In India.
- Born In Present-day Andhra Pradesh, He Was Involved In Opposing The British In Response To The 1882 Madras Forest Act That Effectively Restricted The Free Movement Of Adivasis In Their Forest Habitats And Prevented Them From Practicing Their Traditional Form Of Agriculture Called 'Podu', Which Threatened Their Very Way Of Life.
- Rise In Discontent Towards The British Colonial Rule In The Backdrop Of The Non-cooperation Movement (1920-1922) Led To The Rampa Rebellion (1922-1924) In Which Alluri Sitarama Raju Played The Major Role As Its Leader.

- The Startup20 Engagement Group Is Hosting The Two Day Startup20 Shikhar Summit. Speaking On The Occasion, Minister Of State For Commerce And Industry Som Prakash Said, Education And Awareness Play A Vital Role In Nurturing A Culturally Sensitive Startup Ecosystem.
- He Said, India's Recent Climb On The Global Innovation Index Can Be Largely Attributed To The Dynamic Startup Ecosystem.

• Mr Prakash Said, Startup-20 Strives To Create A Conducive Business Environment Across G20 Nations And Assist Such Talents From Diverse Background To Commercialize, Scale Up And Innovation Further.



Parliamentary Standing Committee For UCC

- The Parliamentary Standing Committee On Personnel, Public Grievances, Law And Justice Will Hold A Meeting On The Uniform Civil Code (UCC).
- Committee Head And BJP Rajya Sabha MP Sushil Modi Informed That The Panel Would Seek The Views Of The Stakeholders On The Matter. He Added The Meeting Of The Committee Is Non-political As The Panel Has Members From All Political Parties.
- The UCC Proposes To Formulate And Implement Personal Laws Of Citizens Which Apply To All Citizens Equally Regardless Of Their Religion, Sex, Gender And Sexual Orientation. Currently, The Personal Laws Of Various Communities Are Governed By Their Religious Scriptures.
