Ajit Agarkar As Chairman Cricket Selection Committee

- Ajit Agarkar Has Been Appointed As Chairman Of The Senior Men's Cricket Selection Committee. The Selection Committee Now Consists Of Ajit Agarkar, Shiv Sundar Das, Subroto Banerjee, Salil Ankola, And Sridharan Sharath.
- The Former India All Rounder Represented The Country In 26 Tests, 191 Odis, And Four T20is, In Addition To Playing 110 First-class, 270 List A, And 62 T20 Matches. As A Former Fast Bowler, He Was Part Of India's Victorious Squad In The Inaugural T20 World Cup Held In South Africa In 2007.
- He Still Holds The Record For The Fastest Half-century By An Indian Batter In ODI, Achieved With A 21-ball Fifty Against Zimbabwe In 2000.



India Lifts SAFF Championships Trophy For 9th Time

- In Football, India Have Lifted The SAFF Championships Trophy For The Ninth Time, Beating Kuwait 5-4 In The Penalty Shoot-out In The Final After A 1-1 Stalemate At The End Of Regulation Time At Sree Kanteerava Stadium In Bengaluru Last Night.
- A Thrilling Penalty Shootout Saw The Game Go Down The Wire After Udanta Singh Missed His Kick.
- Goalkeeper Gurpreet Singh Again Turned Out As The Hero For The Indian Side, Saving The Final Kick From The Kuwaiti Captain.



Japan Plans For Release Of Nuclear Wastewater

- A UN Nuclear Watchdog Has Approved Plans By Japan To Release Wastewater From The Tsunami-wrecked Fukushima Nuclear Plant Into The Sea.
- The International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) Said, The Release Complies With International Standards And Will Have A Negligible Impact On The Environment.
- The Fukushima Facility Is Running Out Of Storage Space For Water, Which Was Used To Cool Nuclear Reactors.
- Japan's Plan Has Been Opposed By China And South Korea. IAEA Chief Rafael Grossi Released The Findings Of A Two-year Safety Review Today, Describing It As Impartial And Scientific. He Also Vowed To Continue Engaging With Japan After The Water Is Discharged.



July 3 World's Hottest Day Ever Due To Climate Change

• According To Data From The U.S. National Centers For Environmental Prediction, July 3rd Was The Hottest Day Recorded Globally.

- The Average Global Temperature Reached 17.01 Degrees Celsius. This New Record Temperature Surpassed The August 2016 Record Of 16.92 Degrees Celsius, As Heatwaves Sizzled Around The World. This Has Been Attributed To The El Nino Weather Pattern.
- The Us Has Been Suffering Under An Intense Heat Dome In Recent Weeks Amid Extreme Weather.
- In Parts Of China, An Enduring Heatwave Continued, With Temperatures Above 35 Degrees Celsius.
- North Africa Has Seen Temperatures Near 50 Degrees Celsius, With, In The Middle East, Thousands Suffering From The Unusually Scorching Heat During The Hajj Religious Pilgrimage In Saudi Arabia.



UNSC To Hold First Ever Meeting On Threats Of AI

- The U.N. Security Council Will Hold A First-ever Meeting On The Threats Of Artificial Intelligence (AI) On July 18th.
- The Meeting Organized By The United Kingdom, Will See Global Leaders Discussing The Potential Threats Of Artificial Intelligence (Ai) To International Peace And Security. It Has Been Presented As A Centerpiece Of The UK's Presidency Of The Council.
- This Was Announced By The UK's Ambassador To The Un, Dame Barbara Woodward. She Said That Since Becoming Prime Minister, Rishi Sunak Has Been Pushing For A Leadership Position In The Global Effort To Regulate AI Tools.
- Mr. Sunak Had Earlier Claimed That The UK Was The Natural Place To Lead The Conversation On AI. He Had Also Announced That Britain Will Host The First Major Global Summit On AI Safety Later This Year.



37th Hyderabad Sailing & Laser National Championship

- The Prestigious 37th Hyderabad Sailing Week And Laser National Championship Has Taken Off Under The Aegis Of EME Sailing Association (EMESA), Laser Class Association Of India, And Secunderabad Sailing Club At Hussain Sagar Lake In Hyderabad.
- The Annual National Regatta, Hyderabad Sailing Week, Is Conducted Every Year At The Hussain Sagar Lake And The National Laser Championship Serves As A Trial Event For The Asian Games.
- Organisers Informed That 89 Individuals, Representing 11 Clubs, Registered Themselves Yesterday. These Include 11 Women And 17 From Telangana. Murali Kanuri (72) Is The Oldest Participant This Year. The Week-long Event Will Conclude On The 9th Of This Month.



New Delhi Declaration Adopted In SCO 23rd Summit

- Shanghai Cooperation Organisation (SCO) Have Reaffirmed Their Commitment To Fight Terrorism, Separatism And Extremism. They Emphasized On Taking Measures To Disrupt The Terror Financing Channels, Stop The Radicalization Of Youth And Eliminate Sleeper Cells And Places Used As Terrorist Safe Havens, And Cross-border Movement Of Terrorists.
- Leaders Of The Sco Adopted New Delhi Declaration After A Virtual Meeting Of The Council Of Heads Of State Of SCO.
- According To The New Delhi Declaration, The Member States Will Seek To Develop Common Principles And Approaches To Form A Unified List Of Terrorist, Separatist And Extremist Organizations Whose Activities Are Prohibited On The Territories Of The SCO Member States. They Opposed The Militarization Of Information And Communication Technologies.



UGC Makes PhD Optional For Assistant Professor

- University Grants Commission (UGC) Has Set NET, SET Or SLET As The Minimum Criteria For The Direct Recruitment To The Post Of Assistant Professor For All Higher Education Institutions.
- In A Notification, The UGC Also Stated That Ph.D. Qualification For Appointment To The Same Post Would Be Optional From This Month Onwards.
- Earlier In 2021, The Commission Announced That Ph.D. Was Not Mandatory For Direct Recruitment Of Assistant Professors Till July This Year.

DGCA Signs MoU With EU Aviation Safety Agency

- The Directorate General Of Civil Aviation (DGCA) Has Signed A Memorandum Of Understanding With The European Union Aviation Safety Agency (EASA) For Cooperation In Unmanned Aircraft Systems And Innovative Air Mobility.
- This MoU Will Facilitate Collaboration On Unmanned Aircraft And Innovative Air Mobility Between The Two Civil Aviation Authorities.
- According To The Civil Aviation Ministry, The MoU Will Also Focus On Regular Information Sharing Between The Two Authorities On Technological Developments And Research.
- The Ministry Said The Signing Of This MoU Will Accelerate The Growth Of Indian Unmanned Aviation Sector.
