 Strategic Vision To Solve The Problems Faced By One Of Italy's Most Picturesque
 Cities.
- A Spokesperson For The Venice Municipality Said They Will Discuss The Report With The Italian Government.
- The Report Comes As A Blow To Authorities, Who Are Accused Of Failing To Protect The Historic City And Surrounding Lagoon.

- In 2021, Sinha's Exceptional Performance And Leadership Qualities Were Recognized Once Again When She Was Chosen To Serve As The Executive Special Assistant To The FBI Director In Washington.

 48 Hours.
- The Application Status Can Be Viewed In The E-care Portal Through The Registration Number.



Gukesh Overtakes Viswanathan In FIDE Rankings

- Gukesh D, A Protege Of Five-time World Chess Champion Viswanathan Anand, Will Become The Top-ranked Indian In The International Chess Federation (FIDE) Monthly Rating List For Classical Chess, Surpassing Anand After 36 Years. He Will Also Break Into The Top 10 Rankings For The First Time, Making Him The Third Indian To Achieve This Feat.
- He Became The Youngest Player To Defeat World No. 1 Chess Player, Magnus Carlsen.
- Fide Is The Governing Body Of The Sport Of Chess, And It Regulates All International Chess Competitions. It's Constituted As A Non-governmental Institution.
- Viswanathan Anand Is The Most Successful Indian Chess Player, Who Won The Fide World Chess Championship In 2000, 2007, 2008, 2010 And 2012.



Aditi Swami Shines @ World Archery Championships

- Aditi Swami Created History By Becoming The First-Ever Indian To Clinch The Individual World Title At The World Archery Championships Final In Berlin.
- Less Than Two Months After Clinching The Junior World Title, She Defeated Andrea Becerra Of Mexico, 149-147 In The Summit Class.





Quit India Movement Day

- The **Quit India Movement**, Also Known As The August Movement, Was A Significant Civil Disobedience Movement Launched By Mahatma Gandhi And The Indian National Congress On **August 8**, **1942**.
- It Was Launched **At Gowalia Tank Maidan Also Known As August Kranti**Maidan In Bombay With The Aim To End British Colonial Rule In India.
 - The Year 2023 Marks The 81st Anniversary Of The Quit India Movement.



Tesla Appoints Vaibhav Taneja As Its CFO

- Tesla Has Appointed Indian-Origin Vaibhav Taneja As Its Chief Financial Officer (CFO), As The Organization Plans To Make India Its Next Key Source Of A New Supplier Ecosystem.
- Mr. Taneja Will Assume The CFO Position In Addition To His Present Duties As The Chief Accounting Officer.
- However, The Development Comes At A Time When Tesla Has Reportedly Held Discussions With Indian Government Officials To Bring Its Auto Parts And Electronics Chain To The Country In The Near Future.



International Day Of The World's Indigenous Peoples

- The International Day Of The World's Indigenous Peoples Is Observed On 9
 August Each Year To Raise Awareness And Protect The Rights Of The World's Indigenous Population.
- This Event Also Recognizes The Achievements And Contributions That Indigenous People Make To Improve World Issues Such As Environmental Protection.



- It Was First Pronounced By The United Nations General Assembly In December 1994, Marking The Day Of The First Meeting Of The UN Working Group On Indigenous Populations Of The Sub-commission On The Promotion And Protection Of Human Rights In 1982.
- The 2023 Theme For World Tribal Day Revolves Around "Indigenous Youth As Agents Of Change For Self-determination."

Indian Web Browser Development Challenge

- The Ministry Of Electronics And Information Technology Launched An Indian Web Browser Development Challenge In New Delhi.
- The Purpose Of The Challenge Is To Develop An Indigenous Web Browser For The World, With A Built In Controller Of Certifying Authorities (CCA) India Root Certificate.
- The Govt Has Announced A Cash Prize Of 3.4 Crores Rupees For Developers Who Will Create An Indigenous Browser.
- India Is The World's Fastest-Growing Economy The Time Has Come To Quit The International Browser And Reduce The Dependency On The Foreign Technologies.



World Lion Day 2023

- World Lion Day is observed every year on August 10 to raise awareness about the conservation of lions. The lion is an endangered species on the IUCN Red List.
- To arrest the rapid decrease of Lion population, a group of non-profits and tourism companies created World Lion Day to celebrate the animals and redirect the world's attention towards them. Organizations such as Panthera and National Geographic Society's Big Cats Initiative Support World Lion Day.
- While the population of wild lions saw a catastrophic decline across the world, except for **Africa**, the mighty beasts have found a natural home in India.
- Their population has increased steadily in India, especially in **Gir forest** the only wild population of lions outside Africa.
- Asiatic lion population has increased steadily in Gujarat's Gir forest, and the larger Saurashtra protected region. Their population has gone up from 523 in 2015 to 674 in 2020.



World Biofuel Day 2023

- World Biofuel Day is celebrated annually on 10 August.
- The day is set aside to raise awareness about unconventional fuel sources that can serve as an alternative to the more traditional fossil fuels. The emphasis is on the usage of non-fossil fuels or biofuels that enable cleaner consumption patterns.
- Ministry of New and Renewable Energy (MNRE) Deals With awareness and discuss policy issues related to Biofuels.
- Examples of biofuels include ethanol (often made from corn in the United States and sugarcane in Brazil), biodiesel (sourced from vegetable oils and liquid animal fats), green diesel (derived from algae and other plant sources), and biogas (methane derived from animal manure and other digested organic material).

- Director General Of Who Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus Said The Summit Will Help To Unlock The Potential Of The Ancient Traditional Medicine And Advance Their Use In Today's Time. He Urges All Countries To Commit To Integrate Traditional Medicines In Their National Health Systems.



World's Highest Motorable Road In Eastern Ladakh

- The New Highest Motorable Pass Will Set A New World Record Of Being The Motorable Road At An Altitude Of 19,400 Feet. Presently, The Umlingla Pass At The Height Of 19,024 Feet, Is The World's Highest Motorable Pass, Constructed By BRO In The Year 2021.
- Umlingla Pass Is A 52 Km Long Road That Connects Chishumle To Demchok,
 Which Is Right On The LAC, and A Friction Point Between India And China.
- The Proposed Road Between Likaru-migla-fukche Will Provide An Axis
 Connecting Hanle To CDFD Road At Fukche. The Strategically Important Road
 Will Pass Through Migla, Which Is At 19400 Feet. A Budget Of Approximately Rs

 520 Crore Has Been Slated For The Ambitious Project.

- The Cabinet Committee On Economic Affairs Chaired By Prime Minister Narendra Modi Approved The Scheme For A Period Of Five Years.



- The Satellite Will Take Around 109 Earth Days After Launch To Reach The Halo Orbit Called L1, Covering Over 1.5 Million Kilometres.
- The Aditya L1 Spacecraft, Which Was Assembled And Integrated At The U.R. Rao Satellite Centre (URSC), Bengaluru, Has Arrived At The Satish Dhawan Space Centre In Sriharikota.

India's First 3D Printed Post Office



Russia's Moon Mission Luna-25 Fails


Russia's Moon Mission Luna 25 By Roscosmos Ended In Failure After Its
