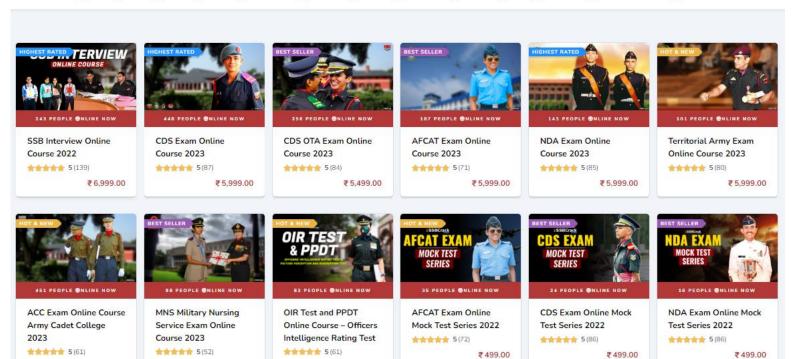

Delhi Services Bill Tabled In Lok Sabha Govt Of NCT Of Delhi (Amendment) Act, 2023

Why In The News?

- The Centre Introduced The Government Of National Capital Territory Of Delhi (Amendment) Bill, 2023, In Lok Sabha. The Bill Seeks To Replace The National Capital Territory Of Delhi (Amendment) Ordinance, 2023, On The Control Of Services In Delhi.
- While The Opposition Tore Into The Government, Alleging That The Bill Aims To Take Away Delhi Assembly's Powers, Union Home Minister Amit Shah, Who Was Present In The House, Said, "All Objections Raised Are Political, Which Do Not Have Any Constitutional Basis."





Why Was There A Need For Such Bill?

• The Centre Had Promulgated The **Ordinance On May 19, 2023** - Eight Days After The Constitution Bench Of Supreme Court Pronounced Its Judgment In The **Government Of NCT Of Delhi V. Union Of India Case**, Granting More Powers To The Delhi Government Over Services In The National Capital.

- Opposition Parties Said The Bill Is "A Clear Violation Of The Constitution", As
 Article 239 Provides Powers To The Delhi Assembly To Make Laws On Subjects
 Mentioned In The State List And Concurrent List. The Bill Gives More Powers
 To The Lieutenant Governor Of Delhi.
- This Raises Serious Questions About The Centre's View Of Ignoring The Supreme Court And The Constitution. This Bill Aims At Undermining The Independence And Rights Of Delhi Government, Which Was Established By The Supreme Court Judgment.



What The Bill Intends To Do?

- The Ordinance, Promulgated By President Murmu On May 19, Sought To Amend
 The Government Of NCT Of Delhi Act, 1991 Effectively Negating The May 11 SC
 Judgement That Gave AAP Govt The Power To Make Laws And Wield Control
 Over Bureaucrats Deputed To The Delhi Government.
- Firstly, The Bill, Mandates The Creation Of An Authority For Transfers And Postings Of Senior Officers In The Delhi Government. Secondly It Also Empowers The L-G To Appoint The Heads Of Boards Or Commissions That Are Enacted By Delhi Legislative Assembly.


National Capital Civil Service Authority (NCCSA)

 The National Capital Civil Service Authority (NCCSA) Shall Have The Responsibility To Recommend The Transfers And Postings Of All Group 'A' Officers (IAS) And Officers Of DANICS Serving In The Delhi Government.

NCCSA Shall Consist Of:

- Chief Minister Of Delhi, Who Shall Be The Ex-officio Chairperson Of The Authority.
- o The Chief Secretary Of Delhi, Who Will Function As Member And The
- o **Principal Home Secretary, Delhi,** Who Shall Be The Member-Secretary.
- All Matters Required To Be Decided By The Authority Shall Be Decided By Majority Of Votes Of The Members Present And Voting.

The Government of NCT-Delhi (Amendment) Ordinance, 2023 pitches a new body (NCCSA) for matters relating to Group-A civil services officers. How will it function?



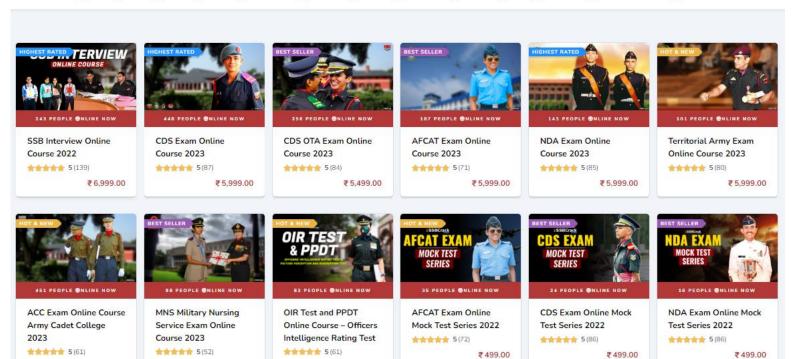
Rationale Behind Such Move?

- Several Important National And International Institutions And Authorities Like
 The President, The Parliament, The Supreme Court, Various Constitutional
 Functionaries, Foreign Diplomatic Missions, International Agencies, Etc., Are in
 Delhi And High Dignitaries From Other Nations Pay Official Visits To Delhi.
- Centre Says This Would Balance The Interest Of The Nation With The Interest
 Of The Union Territory Of Delhi In The Administration Of The Capital. The
 Highest Possible Standards Are Required To Be Maintained In The
 Administration And Governance Of The NCT Of Delhi.
