

- National Teachers' Day In India Is Celebrated On September 5th Every Year. It Is A Day To Honor And Celebrate The Contributions Of Teachers To Society.
- The Day Is Also Observed As A Tribute To The Memory Of **Dr. Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan**, The Second President Of India From 1962 To 1967. Dr. Radhakrishnan Was A Scholar, Philosopher, And Teacher.
- In **1962,** When His Students Asked Him To Celebrate His Birthday, He Requested That They Instead Observe September 5th As Teachers' Day.
- World Teachers Day Is Observed On October 5. It Is An Initiative Led By Organisations Such As UNESCO, UNICEF And ILO.

- It Will Review The Progress Of India-ASEAN Relations And Chart The Future Direction Of Cooperation.

The East Asia Summit Will Provide An Opportunity For Leaders Of ASEAN
 Countries And Its Eight Dialogue Partners, Including India, To Exchange Views On Issues Of Regional And Global Significance.

Shanmugaratnam Win Presidential Election Singapore

- Indian-Origin Economist And Former Senior Minister Tharman Shanmugaratnam Has Registered A Landslide Victory In Singapore's Presidential Election.
- The Minister Won Over 70 Percent Of Votes In The Country's First Contested Presidential Polls Since 2011.
- Sixty-Six-Year-Old Tharman Shanmugaratnam Had Served As Singapore's Deputy Prime Minister From 2011 To 2019.

- He Joined Politics In 2001. He Has Also Worked In The Public Sector And Held Ministerial Positions.
- Tharman Will Be Singapore's Third Indian-Origin President After Sellapan Ramanathan And Chengara Veetil Devan Nair. Earlier, The Polls Ended With Over 2.7 Million Voters Casting Their Ballots. Singaporeans Voted In Large Numbers On Friday In The Country's First Contested Presidential Election In More Than A Decade.




Sherpa Meeting Begins In Haryana's Mewat

- Notably, This Is The Last And Final G20 Sherpa Meeting, Which Will Take A Final Call On The Outcome Of The G20 Summit.
- The 18th G20 Heads Of State And Government Summit In New Delhi Will Be A Culmination Of All The G20 Processes And Meetings Held Throughout The Year Among Ministers, Senior Officials, And Civil Societies.
- A G20 Leaders' Declaration Will Be Adopted At The Conclusion Of The New Delhi Summit, Stating Leaders' Commitment Towards The Priorities Discussed And Agreed Upon During The Respective Ministerial And Working Group Meetings.
