UNESCO World Heritage List

- Karnataka's Sacred Ensembles Of The **Hoysalas & Shantiniketan** Included In The UNESCO World Heritage List.
- The Hoysala Temples Located In Belur, Halebidu, And Somanathapur In Karnataka Have Become The **42**nd **UNESCO World Heritage** Site In India.
- The Hoysala Temples Were Built During 12th To 13th Centuries, They Are Known For Their Magnificent Architecture And Show The Sculptural As Well As Artistic Achievement Of These Temple Complexes.
- Established In Rural West Bengal In 1901 By The Renowned Poet And Philosopher Rabindranath Tagore, Santiniketan Was A Residential School And Centre For Art Based On Ancient Indian Traditions And A Vision Of The Unity Of Humanity Transcending Religious And Cultural Boundaries.
- A 'World University' Was Established At Santiniketan In 1921, Recognizing The
 Unity Of Humanity Or "Visva Bharati". Distinct From The Prevailing British
 Colonial Architectural Orientations Of The Early 20th Century And Of European
 Modernism, Santiniketan Represents Approaches Toward A Pan-Asian
 Modernity, Drawing On Ancient, Medieval And Folk Traditions From Across The
 Region.


"People's G20"

 Presidency Into A People-Powered Movement.








Samvidhan Sadan

- WFP's Country Director Elisabeth Faure Said, Our Immediate Areas Of Collaboration Will Include A Micro Study To Understand The Effect Of Climate Change On Food Security, Nutrition And Livelihoods Of Vulnerable Households In Select Geography In India.

- Indian Shooter Elavenil Valarivan Has **Won The Gold Medal** In The Women's 10 Metre Air Rifle Event At The ISSF World Cup 2023 In Rio De Janeiro, Brazil.
- Olympian Elavenil Valarivan Shot 252.2 From Her Series Of 24 Shots In The Final And Narrowly Beat France's Oceanne Muller.
- A Total Of Eight Shooters Qualified For The Final.
- This Was Elavenil Valarivan's Second Individual ISSF World Cup Medal.

- Earlier, Elavenil Valarivan Finished 9th In The Qualification Round With 630.5.
- The Rio Meet Is The Last Rifle And Pistol ISSF World Cup Of 2023.
- The Ongoing Event In The Brazilian City Will Be Followed By The Finals In Doha, Qatar, Scheduled From November 18 To 27.
- India Have Sent A 16-Member Squad For The ISSF World Cup.



Mondo Duplantis Breaks Pole Vault World Record

- Mondo Duplantis, The Swedish Pole Vault Sensation And Reigning World And Olympic Champion, Brought The Athletics Season To A Spectacular Close At The 2023 Diamond League Final In Eugene.
- In A Jaw-Dropping Display Of Skill And Athleticism, Duplantis Cleared The Bar At
 6.23 Meters With His First Attempt, Surpassing His Own World Record Of 6.22
 Meters Set In Clermont-Ferrand Back In February.
- This Remarkable Achievement Marked The Seventh Time Duplantis Had Broken The World Record In Pole Vault, And Notably, The Second Time He Accomplished This Feat Outdoors – Both Times In Eugene, Having Previously Cleared 6.21 Meters At The 2022 World Championships.
