- The Government Has Instituted A New Set Of **National Awards** In The Field Of Science, Technology And Innovation Known As **'Rashtriya Vigyan Puraskar'**.
- This Award Is Meant To Recognize The Notable And Inspiring Contribution Made By Scientists, Technologists, And Innovators In Various Fields Of Science, Technology And Technology-Led Innovation.



- The Award Is In Four Categories, Which Include Vigyan Ratna, Vigyan Shri, Vigyan Yuva-Shanti Swarup Bhatnagar, And Vigyan Team.
- The Nominations For These Awards Will Be Invited Every Year On 14th January Till 28th February The **National Science Day**.
- These Awards Will Be Announced On 11th May On The National Technology Day, And The Award Ceremony Will Be Held On 23rd August On The National Space Day Every Year.
- The Rashtriya Vigyan Puraskars Shall Be Given In The **13 Domains**, Namely Physics, Chemistry, Biological Sciences, Mathematics & Computer Science, Earth Science, Medicine, Engineering Sciences, Agricultural Science, Environmental Science, Technology & Innovation, Atomic Energy, Space Science And Technology, And Others.

International Congress On Chemistry Of Cement

- India will host the International Congress on the Chemistry of Cement (ICCC) in the year **2027 in New Delhi**.
- The Commerce and Industry Ministry announced that the country won the bid to hold this event on a presentation from **the National Council for Cement and Building Materials along with IIT Delhi**.



- It was presented at the ongoing **16th ICCC in Bangkok, Thailand**.
- India defeated Switzerland and the United Arab Emirates to win the bid.
- The ICCC is regarded as the largest and the most prestigious event in the area of Cement and Concrete.



ICMR Approval for Truenat Test

- The Indian Council For Medical Research (ICMR) Has Granted Approval For The Use Of The Truenat Test To Diagnose Nipah Virus In Kerala.
- This Development Is Significant As Hospitals Equipped With Biosafety Level 2 (BSL 2) Laboratories Can Now Conduct The Test.
- Truenat Is A Chip-Based, Point-Of-Care, Rapid Molecular Test For Diagnosis Of Infectious Diseases.
- Truenat Was Originally Developed To Detect Tuberculosis (TB) In One Hour.



India Temporarily Suspends Visa Services In Canada

- India Temporarily Suspends Visa Services In Canada Including E-Visa Due To Incitement Of Violence
- Canadian Citizens In A Third Country Will Not Be Able To Apply For An Indian Visa. However, The Spokesperson Informed That Anyone With A Valid Visa Or Other Documents Can Travel To India.
- Briefing On The Hardeep Nijjar Row, The Spokesperson Said That So Far Canada Has Not Provided Any Specific Information On The Matter Whereas India Has Shared Specific Evidence With Canada About Criminal Activities By Individuals Based On Canadian Soil But Has Not Been Acted Upon.



Liptako Gourma Charter

- Military Leaders From Mali, Burkina Faso, And Niger Signed A Significant Mutual Defense Pact Known As The Liptako-Gourma Charter, Marking A Crucial Step In Addressing The Security Challenges Plaguing The Sahel Region.
- The Liptako-Gourma Charter Establishes The Alliance Of Sahel States (AES). Its Aim Is To "Establish An Architecture Of Collective Defence And Mutual Assistance For The Benefit Of The Population.
- This Alliance Will Be A Combination Of Military And Economic Efforts Between The Three Countries.
- The Charter Binds The Signatories To Assist One Another, Including Militarily In The Event Of An Attack On Any One Of Them.
- It Also Binds The Three Countries To Work To Prevent Or Settle Armed Rebellions.
