#### **International Day Of Sign Languages**

- The UN General Assembly Has Proclaimed 23 September As The International Day Of Sign Languages In Order To Raise Awareness Of The Importance Of Sign Language In The Full Realization Of The Human Rights Of People Who Are Deaf.
- The International Day Of Sign Languages Was First Celebrated In 2018.
- The **Theme For 2023** International Day Of Sign Languages Is "A World Where Deaf People Everywhere Can Sign Anywhere!".
- Proposal For The Day Came From The World Federation Of The Deaf (WFD), A
  Federation Of 135 National Associations Of Deaf People, Representing
  Approximately 70 Million Deaf People's Human Rights Worldwide.



#### **Antim Panghal Wins Bronze Medal**

- Young Indian Wrestler **Antim Panghal Secured A Bronze Medal** In The Women's 53 Kg Category At The Ongoing **World Championships In Belgrade, Serbia**.
- Also Secured Paris Olympics 2024 Quota For India.
- 19-Year-Old Antim Beat Two-Time European Champion Emma Jonna Denise Malmgren In The Bronze Medal Bout By 16-6.

- This Is India's First Medal At The Ongoing Edition Of The Tournament. Antim Has Captured India's 23rd Medal In The World Championships Till Date, Which Includes One Gold, Five Silver And 17 Bronze Medals.
- Earlier, Antim Panghal Had Upset 2022 World Champion Dominique Olivia Parrish Of The USA 3-2 In The Opening Round.

- The NMC Is India's Premier Regulatory Body For Overseeing Medical Education And Practice In India.

- Similarly, The WFME Is A Global Organization Whose Primary Objective Is To Enhance The Quality Of Medical Education Worldwide, With The Promotion Of The Highest Scientific And Ethical Standards In Medical Education.



#### Parliament Passes Women's Reservation Bill

- Parliament Has Passed The Constitution (One Hundred And Twenty-Eighth Amendment) Bill, 2023 Which Seeks To Reserve One-Third Of The Total Number Of Seats For Women In Lok Sabha, State Legislative Assemblies And Delhi Assembly.
- The Women's Reservation Bill Which Is Called As Nari Shakti Vandan Adhiniyam
  Was Approved By The Rajya Sabha After A Division Of Vote In Which 214
  Members Voted In Favour Of The Bill While None Voted Against It.



- The Lok Sabha Has Already Given Its Nod To The Bill.
- Reserve 33% Of Seats For Women Provide One-Third Reservation Of Seats In The Lok Sabha And Legislative Assemblies To Women For 15 Years.
- **Reservation For SC And ST Women** Bill Mandates A Quota For Women From Scheduled Castes And Scheduled Tribes.
- Enactment There's A Provision In The Bill That States Its Enactment Depends
   Upon A New Census And Delimitation Exercise.
