- World Rivers Day, Observed **On The Fourth Sunday** In September Each Year, Is A Global Celebration That Underscores The Immense Value Of Our Rivers.

- This Annual Event Also Advocates For The Conservation And Sustainable Management Of These Vital Natural Resources.
- **History Of World Rivers Day** : The Inception Of World Rivers Day In **2005** Can Be Traced Back To The **United Nations'** Launch Of The Water For Life Decade, Spearheaded By Canadian River Advocate Mark Angelo.
- This Day's Roots Are Deeply Embedded In Bc Rivers Day, An Event Initiated By Angelo In British Columbia, Canada, In 1980. While BC Rivers Day Consistently Occurs On The Fourth Sunday Of September, It Serves As The Inspiration For The Global Celebration, Making The Date For World Rivers Day Adaptable But Consistently In September.

- Rowing Fetched India Further Medals, With The Men's Eight Team Adding Another Silver While Babu Lal Yadav And Lekh Ram Secured Bronze In The Men's Pair. In The Women's 10m Air Rifle Final, India's Ramita Won A Bronze Medal, Taking The Overall Tally Up To 5.
