World PT Day 2023

- Since 1996, The 8th Of September Has Been Designated As World Physiotherapy Day , A Day Set Aside To Honor The Establishment Of The Profession In 1951.
- This Year, On September 8th, World PT Day Focuses On Arthritis, Delving Into Various Forms Of Inflammatory Arthritis, Such As Rheumatoid Arthritis And Axial Spondyloarthritis.
- The Department Of Empowerment Of Persons With Disabilities (Depwd), Under The Ministry Of Social Justice And Empowerment, Government Of India, Serves As The Central Authority Responsible For Advancing The Development Agenda For Persons With Disabilities In The Country.
- In Line With Its Vision To Raise Awareness About The Significance Of Physiotherapy Among The General Population, The Department Will Observe World Physiotherapy Day On September 8, 2023.



World's Tallest Nataraja Statue

- The World's Tallest Nataraja Statue Has Been Installed At Bharat Mandapam, The Venue Of The G20 Summit In Delhi.
- The 28-Foot-Tall Statue Weighing 20 Tonnes Was Made In A Record Time Of Seven Months By Sculptor Radhakrishnan Sthapathy And His Team At Swamimalai In Thanjavur District Of Tamil Nadu.
- The Statue Was Built In Ashtadhatu (8 Metals) Using The Traditional Casting Method.

- The Statue Was Transported To The National Capital In Four Days And A Special Green Corridor Was Created For Its Transportation.
- The Statue Will Stand As A Testament To India's Age-Old Artistry And Traditions.



One Week One Lab Programme

- The One Week One Lab Programme Of Council Of Scientific And Industrial Research, CSIR Will Be Organised From The 11th To The 16th Of September.
- During The Programme, Each Of The 37 CSIR Laboratories, Spread Across The Country, Will Showcase Their Research Outcomes And Achievements.

- The Official Indian Delegation To TIFF Will Led By Joint Secretary (Films), Ministry Of Information And Broadcasting, Prithul Kumar.



Govt. Approves Scheme For Viability Gap Funding

- The Government Approved The Scheme For Viability Gap Funding (VGF) For The Development Of Battery Energy Storage Systems (BESS).
- The Scheme Envisages The Development Of 4000MW Hour Of BESS Projects By 2030-31, With The Financial Support Of Up To 40 Percent Of The Capital Cost As Budgetary Support.
- The VGF Shall Be Disbursed In Five Tranches Linked With The Various Stages Of Implementation Of BESS Projects.
- Benefits Of The Scheme Reach The Consumers, A Minimum Of 85 Percent Of The BESS Project Capacity Will Be Made Available To Distribution Companies (Discoms).
- Government Remains Committed To Promoting Clean And Green Energy Solutions, And The BESS Scheme Is A Significant Step Towards Achieving This Vision.
- It Will Not Only Enhance The Integration Of Renewable Energy Into The Electricity Grid But Also Minimise Wastage While Optimising The Utilisation Of Transmission Networks.





Asian Table Tennis Championships

- In Table Tennis, Indian Men's Team Finished With A Bronze Medal At The Asian Table Tennis Championships 2023 Following A Semi-Final Defeat To Chinese Taipei In Pyeongchang, The Republic Of Korea.
- The Indian Men's Table Tennis Team Comprising Sharath Kamal, Harmeet Desai And Sathiyan Gnanasekaran Lost 0-3 In Their Final Four Match.
- The Two Losing Semi-Finalists Are Awarded Bronze Medals At The Competition. The Asian Table Tennis Championships 2023 Was Also A Qualifier For The Paris 2024 Olympics.

- The First-Ever Street Child Cricket World Cup Was Held In London In 2019 Where Indian Children Won The Tournament.
- Eight Indian Teams, Namely, India Tigers From Chennai, Team India From India Lions, India Cats, India Wolves From Delhi, India Panthers From Kolkata, India King Cobras From Mumbai, And India Crocodiles From Odisha Will Participate In The World Cup.
- The Members Of The India Tigers Team Comprise Children That Include Orphans And Those Who Are Homeless Due To Difficult Life Conditions.
