## Defence Current Affairs 20 September 2023

#### 12th Defence Cooperation Committee Meeting

- The 12<sup>th</sup> meeting of Malaysia-India Defence Cooperation Committee was held in New Delhi on September 19, 2023. The meeting was co-chaired by Defence Secretary Giridhar Aramane and Deputy Secretary General (Policy), Malaysia Mr Mohd Yani bin Daud.
- During the meeting, both sides reviewed the outcomes of the two subcommittee meetings namely Sub Committee on Military Cooperation held on July 27, 2023, and Joint Sub Committee on Defence Science Technology and Industry Cooperation held on September 18, 2023.
- The two chairs also articulated steps in the direction of emerging areas of cooperation like cyber security and issues pertaining to global commons. They identified means to enhance existing areas of collaboration, especially in the field of defence industry, maritime security and multilateral cooperation.



#### 2<sup>ND</sup> Edition Of Indian Navy's Seminar (Swavlamban-2023)

- The 2<sup>nd</sup> Edition of the Indian Navy's Naval Innovation and Indigenisation Seminar

   'Swavlamban 2023' is scheduled to be conducted on 04 05 Oct 2023. In the maiden edition of the seminar, held in July 2022, PM launched the 75 challenges for the start-ups/ MSMEs as a part of the 'SPRINT' initiative.
- SPRINT is a collaborative initiative being undertaken in conjunction with the Defence Innovation Organisation and stands for Supporting Pole-Vaulting in R&D through iDEX, NIIO and Technology Development Acceleration Cell. This initiative has received an overwhelming response with 1106 proposals.
- After a detailed examination, 113 winners under the DISC 7 SPRINT category (with grants up to 1.5 cr) and 5 winners in the DISC 7 SPRINT-PRIME category (grants up to 10 cr) were declared, and the development of prototypes is being progressed by all the winners.



#### Coastal security drill 'Operation Sajag'

- 'Operation Sajag', a drill involving all stakeholders of the coastal security construct, was conducted by the Indian Coast Guard along the west coast on September 18, 2023. The drill facilitates revalidation of the coastal security mechanism and bring awareness among the fishermen at sea.
- During the drill, extensive checking and verification of documents and crew passes of all fishing boats, barges and craft at sea was undertaken. A total of 118

- ships including those from Customs, Marine Police, Ports & Indian Navy participated in the drill.
- The day-long drill is conducted every month and the outcomes are further
  progressed for improvement in the coastal security construct. The drill enables
  to verify implementation of various coastal security measures besides bringing
  out important lessons and highlight trends in coastal security.



## 9 Separatist Outfits Supporting Terror Groups Have Bases In Canada

- At least nine separatist organisations supporting terror groups have their bases in Canada and despite multiple deportation requests Ottawa has taken no action against those involved in heinous crimes including the killing of popular Punjabi singer Sidhu Moosewala, officials here said on Tuesday.
- They said that pro-Khalistani outfits such as the World Sikh Organization (WSO), Khalistan Tiger Force, Sikhs for Justice and Babbar Khalsa International working at the behest of Pakistan have been allegedly operating freely form the Canadian soil.
- Canadian Prime Minister Justin Trudeau said his government had "credible allegations" linking Hardeep Singh Nijjar's killing with the "agents of the Government of India."
- India has rejected the allegations as "absurd and motivated".



#### India rejects allegations by Canada

We have seen and reject the statement of the Canadian Prime Minister in their Parliament, as also the statement by their Foreign Minister.

Allegations of Government of India's involvement in any act of violence in Canada are absurd and motivated.

Similar allegations were made by the Canadian Prime Minister to our Prime Minister, and were completely rejected.

We are a democratic polity with a strong commitment to rule of law.

Such unsubstantiated allegations seek to shift the focus from Khalistani terrorists and extremists, who have been provided shelter in Canada and continue to threaten India's sovereignty and territorial integrity. The inaction of the Canadian Government on this matter has been a long-standing and continuing concern.

That Canadian political figures have openly expressed sympathy for such elements remains a matter of deep concern.

The space given in Canada to a range of illegal activities including murders, human trafficking and organised crime is not new.

We reject any attempts to connect Government of India to such developments.

We urge the Government of Canada to take prompt and effective legal action against all anti-India elements operating from their soil.

## Azerbaijan Launches Military Action In Karabakh To Disarm Armenians

- Azerbaijan launched "anti-terrorist activities" in the Nagorno-Karabakh region to restore constitutional order and drive out what it called Armenian military formations there, a move that could foreshadow a new war in the region.
- Azerbaijan's defence ministry spoke in a statement of its intention to "disarm and secure the withdrawal of formations of Armenia's armed forces from our territories, (and) neutralise their military infrastructure."
- Internationally recognised as part of Azerbaijan, Karabakh has an overwhelmingly ethnic Armenian population and broke from Baku's control in the early 1990s after a war.
- Azerbaijan recaptured swathes of land in and around it in a 2020 war, but ethnic Armenian authorities who see the area as their ancestral homeland, remained in control of part of Karabakh, including its capital.
