Why In News

- In A Bizarre Event That Took Place In Mexico City, **Two Alleged Alien**-Like Corpses Were Unveiled At The Country's Congress.

Recovered From




Features

- The Bodies Exhibited A Humanoid Shape But They Had Distinctive Features Such As A Retractable Neck And Elongated Skulls.
- Described As Having Characteristics More **Reminiscent Of Birds** According To Reports From The Mexican El Pais Newspaper.



- Additionally They Were Noted To Have Strong Yet Lightweight Bones And Lacked Teeth.
- Experts Claimed That One Of These Beings Was **Carrying Eggs** With Embryos Inside And Had Implants Made Of Cadmium And Osmium Metals.



Relation with Earth Species

- These Specimens Are Not Part Of Our Terrestrial Evolution.
- These Are Beings That Were Found After A UFO Wreckage.
- They Were Found In **Diatom Algae Mines** And Were Later Fossilized.
