



DRDO Celebrates Its 65th Foundation Day

• Floral tributes paid at the bust of former President Dr APJ Abdul Kalam at DRDO Hq in New Delhi to mark the 65th Foundation Day of the Organisation, which is celebrated on **1st January** every year.



Formation

• It was formed in **1958** from the amalgamation of the Technical Development Establishment (TDEs) of the Indian Army and the Directorate of Technical Development & Production (DTDP) with the Defence Science Organisation (DSO).



Formation

• DRDO is a network of more than 50 laboratories which are deeply engaged in developing defence technologies covering various disciplines, like aeronautics, armaments, electronics, combat vehicles, engineering systems etc.

• Captain Shiva Chauhan from the Corps of Engineers has been posted at a frontline post in Siachen Glacier, in first such operational deployment of an woman Army officer at the world's highest battlefield.

• The officer was posted at the Kumar post, located at an altitude of around 15,600 feet in Siachen, for a three-month stint after she underwent rigorous training. The training included endurance training, ice wall climbing, avalanche and crevasse rescue and survival drills.

• The Siachen glacier lies in the Karakoram Range. It is 75 km (47 miles) long, which makes it the second longest nonpolar glacier in the world, after Fedchenko Glacier in Tajikistan.



New Ballistic-Helmet For Sikh Soldiers

 Indian Army troops belonging to the Sikh community will now soon be receiving ballistic helmets, designed especially for them to wear on their turbans. Army officials are describing this procurement as the first such order for the Sikh soldiers.

• The Indian Army is planning to purchase as many as **12,730** ballistic helmets under emergency procurement using the fast-track mode.


Sizes of Helmets

 A successful training launch of a Short-Range Ballistic Missile, Prithvi-II was carried out on January 10, 2023, from the Integrated Test Range, Chandipur off the coast of Odisha. A well-established system, Prithvi-II missile, has been an integral part of India's nuclear deterrence.

DAC Approves AON For Three Capital Acquisition Proposals

 A meeting of DAC, held on January 10, 2023, under the chairmanship of Raksha Mantri
 Rajnath Singh, accorded Acceptance of Necessity for three capital acquisition proposals, amounting to Rs 4,276 crore. All three proposals

The DAC accorded AoN for procurement of HELINA Anti-Tank Guided
Missiles, launchers, and associated support equipment which will be
integrated into the ALH. This missile is an essential part of weaponization of
ALH for countering enemy threats. Its induction will strengthen the offensive
capability of the Indian Army.



DAC Approves AON For Three Capital Acquisition Proposals

• The DAC also accorded AoN for procurement of VSHORAD (IR Homing) missile system under design and development by DRDO. In view of the recent developments along the Northern borders there is a need to focus on effective Air Defence (AD) weapon systems which are man portable and can be deployed quickly in rugged terrain and maritime domain.

ICGS Kamala Devi Commissioned By ICG VS Pathania

Notably, Kamala Devi is 48.9 meters long and 7.5 meters wide with a
displacement of 308 tons. The ship is capable of achieving a maximum speed
of 34 knots, powered with the MTU 4000 series Engine and propelled by
three 71S type three Kamewa waterjet of Rolls Royce.

 This ship is capable of undertaking multiple tasks including surveillance, interdiction, search and rescue operations, and medical evacuation. The ship is also equipped with a 30 mm 2A42 Medak Gun and a 12.7mm SRCG (Stabilized Remote Controlled Gun).





India Remains In Fourth Place In The Annual Global Firepower Ranking

• India is ranked 4th out of 145 countries considered for the annual GFP review in 2023. The country has a PwrIndx* score of 0.1025 (a score of 0.0000 is regarded as 'perfect'). The Global Firepower Index is based on fifty distinct factors ranging from geography to logistical capability. Manpower, land forces, airpower, natural resources, naval forces, logistics, and finances are also included.


India Remains In Fourth Plasser Firepower Ranking

 China, India's main rival in the region, remains in third place, while Pakistan, which was in ninth place in 2022 after falling to 15th in 2021, remains in seventh place.




NDRF Celebrated 18th Raising Day

 Living up to its motto of 'Saving Lives and Beyond' during any natural disaster in the country, National Disaster Response Force (NDRF) is celebrating its 18th raising day, January 19. The Force, since its formation, has played a crucial role in disaster management and dealing with its threats.

 The NDRF was formed in 2006 under the Disaster Management Act. The Force was constituted for the purpose of specialized response to natural and man-made disasters. Calamities like the Orissa Super Cyclone in 1999, the Gujarat Earthquake of 2001 and the Indian Ocean Tsunami in 2004 brought to light the need for a comprehensive disaster management plan.



Exercise AMPHEX 2023

The largest biennial Tri-Services amphibious exercise – AMPHEX 2023 – involving the Indian Army, IAF, and the Indian Navy, was conducted near Kakinada in Andhra Pradesh from January 17 to January 22.

• Six Scorpene Class submarines are being built in India by the MDL Mumbai, under collaboration with **M/s Naval Group, France**.





- Vagir was launched on 12 Nov 20, under Project 75 (P75) and was delivered to Indian Navy on 20 Dec 22 post completion of sea trials.




Subhash Chandra Bose Aapda Prabandhan Puraskar-2023


PM Names 21 Largest Islands In Andaman And Nicobar After 21 Indian Heroes








Awards Related To Republic Day 2023



 Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman on Wednesday increased allocation to defence Budget to Rs 5.94 lakh crore for 2023-24 from last year's (2022-23) allocation of Rs
 5.25 lakh crore.



• A total of **Rs 1.62 lakh crore** has been set aside for **capital expenditure** that includes purchasing new weapons, aircraft, warships and other military hardware, stated the Budget report.



 The Armed Forces have to be battle ready to meet any eventuality. Towards that end, Non-Salary revenue outlay has been enhanced significantly from Rs 62,431 crore in Budget Estimates (BE) 2022-23 to **Rs 90,000 crore** in BE 2023-24, representing a **44%** jump.



 This expenditure is expected to close critical gaps in the combat capabilities and equip the Forces in terms of ammunition, sustenance of weapons & assets, military reserves etc. This Budget has also sustained the thrust on Modernisation and Infrastructure Development of the Defence Services, by continuing an upward trend in Capital Outlay.



According to 2023-24 budget documents, an allocation of ₹ 2,70,120 crore
has been made for revenue expenditure that includes expenses on payment

Rajya Sabha Passes ISO (Command, Control & Discipline) Bill – 2023

The Rajya Sabha, on August 08, 2023, passed the Inter-Services Organisation (Command, Control & Discipline) Bill - 2023. It was passed by the Lok Sabha on August 04, 2023.



Rajya Sabha Passes ISO (Command, Control & Discipline) Bill – 2023

The bill seeks to empower Commander-in-Chief and Officer-in Command of ISOs with all disciplinary and administrative powers in respect of the personnel serving in or attached to such organisations.



The 'ISO Bill - 2023' shall be applicable to all personnel of regular Army, Navy, and Air force, and to persons of other forces as notified by the Central Government, who are serving in or attached to an Inter-Services Organisation.





Bill empowers the Commander-in-Chief, Officer-in-Command or any other officer specially empowered in this behalf by the Central Government with all the disciplinary and administrative powers in respect of personnel serving in or attached to their ISO for the maintenance of discipline and proper discharge of their duties, irrespective of the service.





The Commander-in-Chief or the Officer-in-Command means **General Officer/Flag Officer/Air Officer** who has been appointed as **Commander-in-Chief of Officer-in-Command** an Inter-Services Organisation.



To maintain Command and Control in absence of the Commander-in-Chief or the Officer-in-Command, the officiating incumbent or the officer on whom the command develops in absence of a C-in-C or Oi/C, will also be empowered to initiate all disciplinary or administrative actions overs the service personnel, appointed, deputed, posted or attached to an Inter-Services organisation.





The Bill also empowers the Commanding Officer of an Inter-Services organisation to initiate all disciplinary or administrative actions over the personnel appointed, deputed, posted or attached to that Inter-Services Organisation. For the purpose of this Act, Commanding Officer means the officer in actual command of the unit, ship or establishment.







"The launch is a symbol of self reliance in ship building," the President said adding that projects like this reflects India's "commitment to self reliance and technological advancement".



The state-of-the-art wind tunnel is set to refine the Combat Freefall (CFF) skills of armed forces personnel.

Functioning as a freefall simulator, the VWT creates a column of air at specific velocities, orchestrating different CFF conditions.



The system simulates varied freefall scenarios which is crucial in assessing individual reactions to numerous situations in an airborne operating environment. It reduces potential instability in the air and during parachute deployment thereby assisting trainees to get used to free-fall conditions.



Military Satellites

The IAF envisions India having over 100 military satellites, both large and small, within the next seven to eight years, with active participation from the private sector. Additionally, the **Defence Space Agency**, established in 2019, is set to evolve into a fully-fledged **Space Command**.

IAF chief ACM V R Chaudhari in recent months has also repeatedly stressed the need for India to develop both defensive and offensive capabilities in the space domain by building on the success of 'Mission Shakti' in **March 2019.**

If China has the **People's Liberation Army Strategic Support Force** for the space domain, the US created a full-fledged Space Force (**USSF**) as a distinct branch of its armed forces in 2019. Several other countries like the **UK, Japan, France and Russia** also have space commands or wings in their air forces.







In a major boost for the Indian Army, the Defence Ministry has approved a Rs 2,800 crore proposal for buying around 6,400 rockets for Pinaka multi-barrel



rocket launcher systems.





The Defence Ministry's Defence Acquisition Council's recent meeting had cleared the proposal for the acquisition of two types of these rockets, known as **Area Denial Munition Type 2 and Type-3.**





The rockets would be procured by the Indian Army from indigenous sources only and two main contenders include the **Economic Explosives Limited of Solar Industries and the Munitions India Limited**— one of the ammunition-producing companies created by the corporatization of the erstwhile Ordnance Factories.





The Indian-made Pinaka weapon system, named after the bow of **Hindu God Shiva**, has been developed by the **DRDO**.





- The weapon system is one of the first few Indian military terms to have been exported to foreign countries, including **Armenia**.
- Private sector companies involved in the project include Larsen & Toubro, Tata
 Defence and Economic Explosives Limited.



Defence Ministry Inks Over Rs 5,300 Cr Deal With Bharat Electronics Ltd

The MoD sealed an over Rs 5,300 crore deal with state-run BEL for procurement of electronic fuzes for the Indian Army for a period of 10 years. An electronic fuze is an integral component of medium to heavy calibre artillery guns which provide sustained artillery firepower for military operations.




Explaining the trials, the officials said that during the exercise, four targets were coming from same direction in a close formation and were split to attack their own defence assets from multiple directions simultaneously.



Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita Act Widens Definition Of Terrorism

The redrafted criminal law bill **set to replace the Indian Penal Code, 1860**, has widened the definition of "terrorism" and left it to an officer, not below the rank of Superintendent of Police, to invoke section 113 of Bharatiya Nyaya (2nd) Sanhita Bill (BNSB), 2023, or the Unlawful Activities (Prevention Act), 1967.

In the redrafted Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita Act, the definition of terrorism now includes the word "economic security", amongst other changes.



Key changes in the bills

- Definition of terrorist acts expanded to include threats to "monetary stability" and "economic security" among other things
- Clear definition clause for "cruelty" against women in a marital relationship
- Penalises publication of court proceedings that may disclose identity of rape victims

OMISSIONS

- Panel's recommendation on adultery and non-consensual gay sex not accepted
- A key provision that proposed 7 yrs in jail for mob lynching was deleted

Debate on the bills will take place on Thursday and Union home minister Amit Shah will give his reply on Friday. "The bills had had been examined by the standing committee and instead of coming with official amendments, it was decided to bring the bills again."

As per the bill, the terrorism offence would include "any act with the intent to threaten or likely to threaten the unity, integrity, sovereignty, security, or economic security of India of with intent to strike terror or likely to strike terror in the people or any section of the people in India or in any foreign country".

Damage to the monetary stability of India by way of "production or smuggling or circulation of counterfeit Indian paper currency, coin" would also be considered "terrorist acts", as per the bill.
