

Ayodhya Ram Mandir

- The consecration ceremony of Ayodhya's Ram temple will be held on **January 22**. **Chandrakant B Sompura**, 81, and his son Ashish, 51, designed the temple complex in Nagara style architecture.
- Sompura, the principal architect of the Ayodhya Ram Mandir, was first approached to design and build the temple in 1989 by Ashok Singhal, President of VHP (Vishva Hindu Parishad).





- He was sent to Ayodhya to observe the site and take measurements of the space. Owing to heavy security, he had to measure the space with his feet and crafted three designs based on these dimensions.
- Decades later, his two sons, Nikhil and Ashish Sompura, have assisted him in the creation of the Ram Mandir. The temple, constructed in the Nagara style, stands on a solid stone foundation.
- Approximately two lakh bricks inscribed with Lord Ram's name in various languages, collected over 30 years, are integrated into the temple structure.
- The temple stands on a 12-foot jagati and an upper plinth known as the mahapeeth. The stepped shikharas rise high over the five mandapas and the one over the garba griha is the tallest at 161 feet. The kuda mandapa is three stories high. There will be 300 pillars across the mandapas and 44 teak doors.

Alliance For Global Good, Gender Equity & Equality

- India announced a **new alliance for Global Good, Gender Equity and Equality, at the World Economic Forum** (WEF) Annual Meeting in Davos, Switzerland.
- The **primary and stated objective** of this new Alliance is to bring together global best practices, knowledge sharing and investments in the identified areas of women's health, education, and enterprise.



- The Alliance will be taking forward the commitments of the G20 leaders for the benefit of the larger global community as a follow-up to the activities of the Engagement Group and initiatives under the G20 framework, inter alia, the Business 20, Women 20 and G20 EMPOWER.
- Union Ministers Smriti Irani and Hardeep Singh Puri and WEF Chairman Klaus Schwab were present in the meeting.
- Ms Irani said that the idea of this alliance emerged from the G20 Leaders'
 Declaration, and India's abiding commitment to the cause of women-led
 development as propounded by Prime Minister Narendra Modi.



- She also congratulated WEF for being a very strong support to India.
- **Klaus Schwab,** the WEF's founder and chairman, offered his full support for the endeavor. He said that WEF will not only support the alliance but will be a strong partner.
- He also thanked India for sending such a strong delegation in an election year.
 This year's unique initiative at WEF, led by Union Minister of Women & Child Development, was a first ever women leadership lounge, hosted by Confederation of Indian Industry and Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation.

First Pilot Project To Make Jet Fuel From Alcohol

- The first pilot technology project to make jet fuel from alcohol was inaugurated by Union Petroleum and Natural Gas Minister Hardeep Singh Puri in Pune.
- This project will produce **sustainable biological aviation fuel or SAF.** This pilot project has been set up in the research and development department of **Praj Udyog Group in Pirangut Industrial Estate** near Pune.





- The Minister said, there is a huge **demand for this bio aviation fuel** in the global market, and it is a big challenge to provide the necessary raw materials for it.
- He added, that most of the **countries around the world** have great expectations from India for biofuel.
- He congratulated the engineers of Praj Udyog Group for setting up this project in India before Brazil and expressed confidence that this project will truly be a pioneer for the world.

- The flight from **Pune to Delhi** was completed last year using bioaviation fuel made from alcohol. At that time, Puri welcomed the flight at the Delhi airport.
- This biofuel production industry will have a huge scope in the future as even if at least one percent of the total aviation fuel used in India is blended with this sustainable bio aviation fuel, at least 14 crore litres of biofuel will be needed every year.

New Guidelines Bar Coaching Centres

- Ministry of Education has issued 'Regulation of Coaching Centers 2024'
 Guidelines, saying that no coaching center shall enroll students below 16 years of age.
- The Guidelines stressed that student enrolment should be done only after secondary school examination. Coaching Centres have been directed not to make misleading promises or guarantee of rank or good marks to parents and students.







- Education Ministry said, these guidelines prioritize mental well-being, fair
 practices, and inclusivity. The guidelines stress the need for State and UT
 governments to regulate these centers and refer to legal actions, such as the
 PIL in the Supreme Court and letters sent to states and UTs. Fair and reasonable
 fee, a proper grievance redressal system and infrastructure requirements are
 some of the rules coaching centres must follow.
- The Guidelines also proposes a **model framework for coaching centers** and outlines the procedures for registration, renewal, and cancellation of coaching center certificates, along with an appeal process.

- Coaching centres can not engage tutors who do not have qualifications less than the graduation level.
- The **Guidelines stated that the number of unregulated private coaching centers** in the country continues to grow in the absence of any laid down policy or regulation.
- There are instances of such centers charging exorbitant fees from students, causing undue stress on students resulting in students committing suicides.

India Cuba Sign MoU On Digital Public Infrastructure

• The Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology signed an MoU with the Ministry of Communications of the Republic of Cuba on Cooperation in the field of Sharing Successful Digital Solutions Implemented at Population Scale for Digital Transformation in New Delhi.



- The MoU intends to promote digital transformation through capacity-building programs, exchange of best practices, and other collaborative activities to mutually benefit the digital ecosystems of both countries.
- The Ministry of Electronics and IT said that India will collaborate with Cuba by building upon **development partnership on digital transformation** leading to a smooth adoption of Digital Public Infrastructure in Cuba.

Silicon Valley Introducing Hindi As World Language

- In California, two government schools in Silicon Valley will be introducing **Hindi** as a world language in their school curriculum for the first time.
- The decision to introduce Hindi as an optional subject was welcomed by the large Indian American community at Fremont who have been seeking to have their children learn Hindi in schools.



- Fremont has one of the highest concentrations of Indian Americans in California. The Fremont Unified School District (FUSD) Board voted 4-1 vote on 17th January to launch a pilot programme that will see Hindi in the curriculum of Horner Middle School and Irvington High School for the 2024-2025 school year that starts in August.
- During the meeting, FUSD board members showed strong support for the proposal, citing the welfare of students as a major factor in their decision, a media release said.

19th NAM Summit in Uganda

- External Affairs Minister **Dr S Jaishankar** reached **Uganda's Kampala** to represent India at the **19th Non-Aligned Movement** (NAM) Summit.
- The Summit will be preceded by deliberations at the Ministerial and Senior
 Officials levels. Minister of State for External Affairs Dr. Rajkumar Ranjan Singh
 is representing India at the NAM Foreign Ministers' meeting which will precede
 the NAM Summit.



- Minister of State for External Affairs V. Muraleedharan will represent India at the G-77 Third South Summit which will be held in Kampala on 21st and 22nd January.
- On the sidelines of the Summit, Dr Jaishankar is expected to meet the Ugandan leadership and counterparts from NAM Member states.



- The 19th NAM Summit, under the leadership of Uganda, is being held under the
 theme 'Deepening Cooperation for Shared Global Affluence' and brings
 together more than 120 developing countries on a platform of crucial historic
 significance.
- External Affairs Ministry said in a release that India wholeheartedly supports
 Uganda's theme for NAM and looks forward to engaging with NAM under
 Uganda's leadership. It said, as one of the leading and founding members of
 NAM, India remains committed to the principles and values of the movement.
