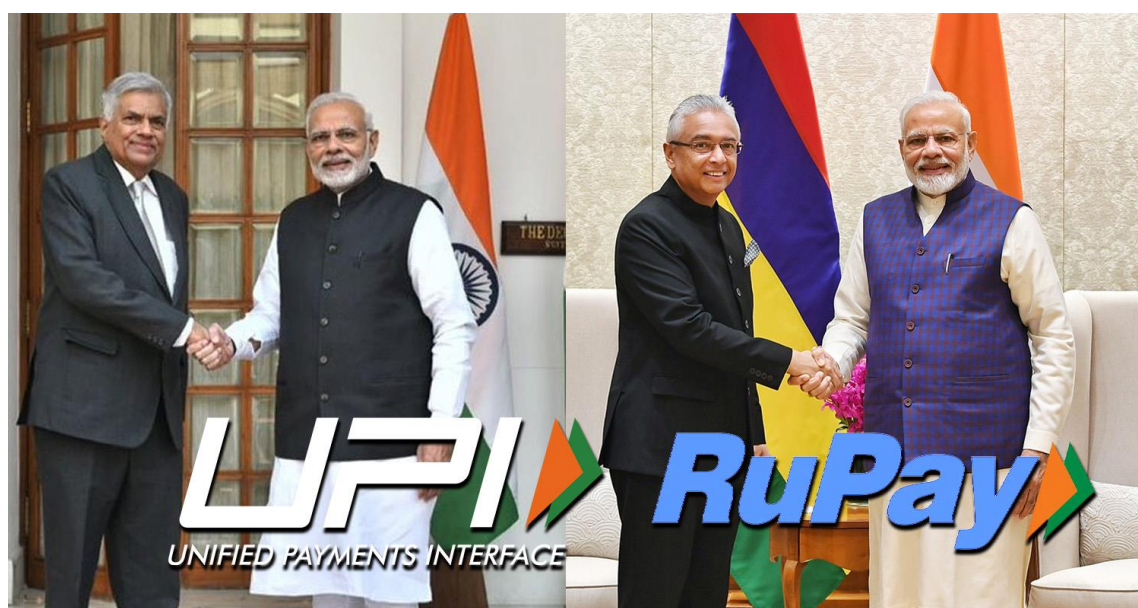

UPI & RuPay in Sri Lanka & Mauritius

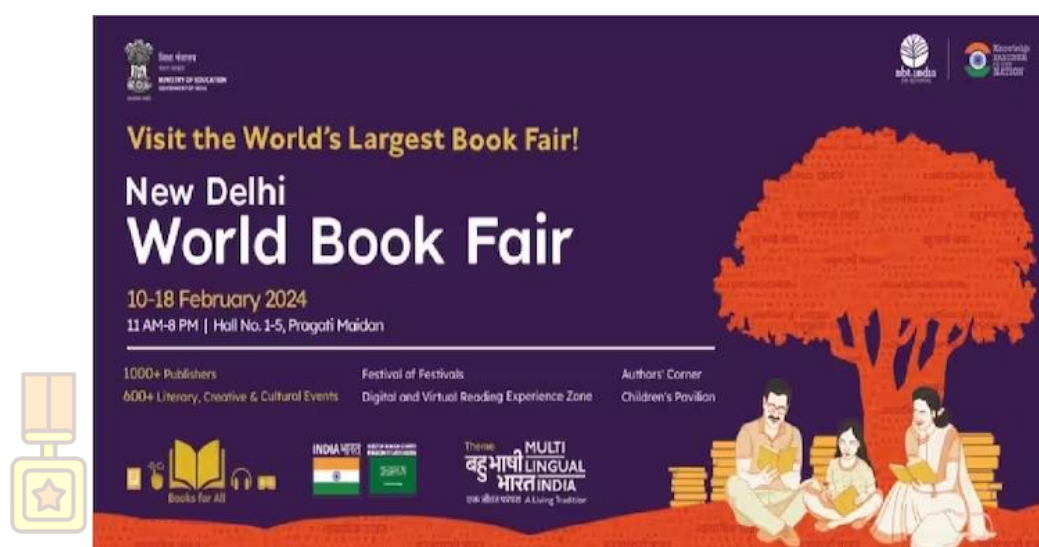
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi along President of Sri Lanka, **Ranil Wickremesinghe**, and Prime Minister of Mauritius, Pravind Jugnauth will witness the launch of **Unified Payment Interface (UPI)** services in Sri Lanka and Mauritius and **RuPay card services** in Mauritius on Monday through video conferencing.



- The launch will enable the availability of **UPI settlement services** for Indian nationals travelling to Sri Lanka and Mauritius as well as for Mauritian nationals travelling to India.
- The **extension of RuPay card services** in Mauritius will enable Mauritian banks to issue cards based on the RuPay mechanism in Mauritius and facilitate usage of RuPay Card for settlements both in India and Mauritius.
- Given India's robust cultural and people-to-people linkages with Sri Lanka and Mauritius, the launch will benefit a wide **cross-section** of people through a faster and seamless digital **transaction experience** and enhance digital connectivity between the countries.

Neeraj Chopra

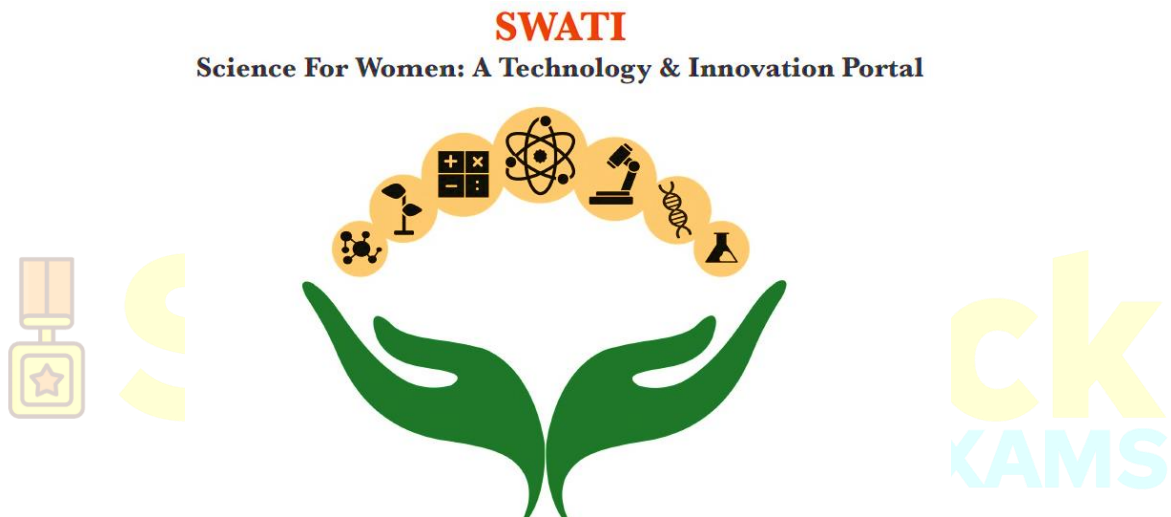

SWATI Portal

- Principal Scientific Advisor Professor **Ajay Kumar Sood** on 11 February 2024, Sunday launched '**Science for Women-A Technology and Innovation (SWATI)** Portal in New Delhi's **Indian National Science Academy (INSA)**.
- Addressing the launch event on the occasion of **International Day of Women and Girls in Science**, Professor Sood said that the **database of the SWATI Portal** will serve in policy-making to address the challenges of Gender-gap.
- The Portal is a complete interactive database and the first of its kind in India which is developed, hosted, and maintained by the **National Institute of Plant Genome Research (NIPGR)**, New Delhi.



- The portal aims at creating a **single online portal** representing Indian Women and Girls in Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics, and Medicine (STEMM).
- SWATI Portal looks to scale up the effort to include each and every **Indian woman in science**, across all career stages and subjects, spanning both Academia and the Industry enabling reliable and statistically significant long-term research.

Nationwide MDA Campaign

- Union Minister of State for Health and Family Welfare Prof. S.P. Singh Baghel today launched the **first phase of the Bi-annual Nationwide Mass Drug Administration (MDA)** campaign for **Lymphatic Filariasis elimination**.
- The campaign aims to check **disease transmission** by providing free preventive medications to the residents in areas affected by the disease.



- The campaign will cover 92 districts across 11 States and will run for the next two weeks.
- Prof S P Singh Baghel reiterated India's commitment to **ending Lymphatic Filariasis by 2027**, three years before the global target.
- He said that India has shown immense resilience against some of the deadliest diseases in the world.



- Prof Baghel said that under the leadership of Prime Minister Narendra Modi and the guidance of Union Health Minister, Dr. Mansukh Mandaviya, the department has seen significant success in the TB Elimination programme and is now on the verge of eliminating Kala- Azar.
