New Fighter Jet Version By March, LCA Mk2 by 2027

- The latest version of the indigenous Light Combat Aircraft (LCA) is likely to be ready for delivery by next month and work on an even more capable version is underway, with production likely to commence by 2027.
- The LCA Mk1A, which was cleared for procurement by the Centre in 2021, will add the much-needed numbers to the fighter jet strength of the Air Force and is much more capable than the earlier version, as it is equipped with new age radars, electronic warfare systems and mid-air refuelling features.
- The HAL Tejas Mark 2 or Medium Weight Fighter (MWF), is an Indian singleengine, canard delta wing, multirole combat aircraft designed by the Aeronautical Development Agency (ADA) in collaboration with Aircraft Research and Design Centre of Hindustan Aeronautics Limited (HAL) for the Indian Air Force (IAF). It is a further development of the HAL Tejas, with an elongated airframe, close coupled canards, new sensors, and a more powerful engine.





IAF Team Inducts For The Singapore Air Show 2024

- A team of 71 personnel of IAF Sarang Helicopter Display Team landed at the Paya Lebar Air Base of Singapore to participate in the Singapore Air Show 2024. The world renowned Sarang Helicopter Display Team will be showcasing its spectacular aerobatics manoeuvres at this event with five ALH 'Dhruv'.
- The induction was carried out with the IAF's C-17 Globemaster III heavy lift transport aircraft.
- The biennial Singapore Air Show is scheduled to commence on 20 Feb 24 and shall conclude on 24 Feb 24. The show features various aerial displays from participants from all over the globe.



COAS Departs On An Official Tour To USA

- General Manoj Pande, the Chief of Army Staff (COAS), embarks on a significant official tour to the United States of America from 13th February to 16th February 2024.

- Reflecting on General Rawat's final moments, Rajnath Singh highlighted the concept of 'Die with your boots on,' emphasizing General Rawat's commitment to duty until the very end. He lamented General Rawat's passing as a profound loss to the nation, noting that even in his final moments, he remained devoted to serving the nation.
- General Bipin Rawat PVSM UYSM AVSM YSM SM VSM ADC (16 March 1958 8 December 2021) was an Indian military officer who was a four-star general of the Indian Army. He served as the first Chief of Defence Staff (CDS) of the Indian Armed Forces from January 2020 until his death in a helicopter crash in December 2021. Prior to taking over as the CDS, he served as the 57th Chairman of the Chiefs of Staff Committee (Chairman COSC) of the Indian Armed Forces as well as 26th Chief of the Army Staff (COAS) of the Indian Army.
