- The improved version of the aircraft, Tejas MK1A features advanced mission computer, high performance Digital Flight Control Computer (DFCC Mk1A), Smart Multi-Function Displays, Advanced Electronically Scanned Array (AESA) Radar, Advanced Self-protection Jammer, Electronic Warfare Suit etc.





'You Speak Of 'Nari Shakti', Now Show It Here': SC

- The Supreme Court has reprimanded the Centre for its patriarchal approach towards women officers in the ICG, highlighting the denial of permanent commission to women officers in the ICG.
- The court questioned why women officers in the ICG are not treated equally to their male counterparts like in the Army, Navy, and Air Force.
- "You speak of 'nari shakti' (woman power). Now show it here. You are in the
 deep end of the sea in this matter. You must come up with a policy which treats
 women fairly," the bench comprising Chief Justice D Y Chandrachud and
 justices J B Pardiwala and Manoj Misra said.

Priyanka Tyagi, a woman officer with a 14-year stint as a pilot in the ICG, was
denied permanent entry despite her outstanding service record, which includes
saving more than 300 lives at sea. Tyagi was part of the first-ever all-women
crew on a Dornier aircraft for maritime patrolling in the eastern region in 2016.
