- The Complete Details Of The Phone Call Have Not Been Shared. However, Sources Have Revealed That The Phone Call Focused On The Hostage Deal Negotiations, Entry Of Aid Into Gaza And Israel's Ongoing Military Operations In The Strip.
- After The Phone Call, Netanyahu Took To Social Media Platform X And Stated
 That Israel Would Not Be Pressured Into Accepting And Creating A Palestinian
 State.
