Why In The News?

- Israeli PM Benjamin Netanyahu Has Continued To **Reject The Creation Of A Palestinian State**. As Per The Latest Update, Despite A 40-Minute Phone Call With US President Joe Biden, Netanyahu Released An Official Statement Saying That **Israel Would Not Be "Pressured" Into Accepting A Palestinian State**.

What Do We Know?

- Biden And Netanyahu's Call Occurred After The Israeli PM Met With **CIA Chief William Burns**, The War Cabinet And The National Security Cabinet On Thursday.
- The Complete Details Of The Phone Call Have Not Been Shared. However, Sources Have Revealed That The Phone Call Focused On The **Hostage Deal Negotiations, Entry Of Aid Into Gaza And Israel's Ongoing Military Operations In The Strip**.
- After The Phone Call, Netanyahu Took To Social Media Platform X And Stated That **Israel Would Not Be Pressured** Into Accepting And **Creating A Palestinian State**.
