# **UN Membership For Palestine**

- United States has blocked a United Nations Security Council resolution that would have paved the way for full United Nations membership for Palestine.
- In the **15-member Security Council**, twelve members voted in favor of the resolution while two countries the UK and Switzerland abstained.
- The **US vetoed it.** US allies France, Japan and South Korea supported the resolution.



 US Deputy Ambassador Robert Wood told the Security Council that the veto does not reflect opposition to Palestinian statehood but instead is an acknowledgement that it will only come from direct negotiations between the parties.



- Palestinian Authority President, Mahmoud Abbas, criticized the US veto, saying
  in a statement that it was unfair, immoral, and unjustified, and defies the will of
  the international community.
- The resolution would have recommended that the **193-member UN General Assembly,** where there are no vetoes, approve Palestine becoming the 194th member of the United Nations.
- **Some 140 countries** have already recognized Palestine, so its admission would have been approved, likely by a much higher number of countries.

- The human judges, Andrew Bloch, an entrepreneur and PR adviser, and Sally-Ann Fawcett, a renowned beauty pageant historian and author, will provide their expertise and insights to this groundbreaking event.
- The first prize of \$5,000 cash, along with Fanvue promotion and PR support, await the crowned Miss AI winner (or the creator behind the AI influencer). The runner-up and third-place winners will also receive cash prizes, further incentivizing the creation of these virtual influencers.

### **GI Tag**

- GI Registry Office based in Chennai announced that the Tiranga Barfi of Varanasi and the Dhalua Murti Metal Casting Craft have been included in the prestigious GI category.
- Total number of GI products from the state has reached an impressive 75, comprising 58 handicrafts and 17 agricultural and food products.
- This remarkable achievement sets a new record for the **highest number of GI** tags associated with a particular state in India.
- Steeped in the rich history of India's independence movement, the **Tiranga Barfi holds a special place** in the hearts of Varanasi's residents. During the struggle for freedom, this tricolored sweetmeat was ingeniously crafted to facilitate secret meetings and information exchange among revolutionaries.



- The saffron hue is derived from saffron, the green color comes from pistachio, and the white shade is created using khoya and cashew nuts.
- The Dhalua Murti Metal Casting Craft, originating from the Kashipura locality of Varanasi, has gained national recognition for its intricate and exquisite metal idols.
- The craftsmen in this region have mastered the art of casting idols of deities such as Maa Annapurna, Lakshmi-Ganesh, Durgaji, and Hanumanji, along with various instruments, bells, thrones, and seals for minting coins.

## **UNFPA Report**

- United Nations Population Fund's (UNFPA) latest report, titled "Interwoven Lives, Threads of Hope: Ending Inequalities in Sexual and Reproductive Health and Rights," sheds light on India's population dynamics and the persistent disparities in sexual and reproductive health.
- India leads globally with an estimated population of 144.17 crore, surpassing China. The report reveals that India's population is expected to double in 77 years.



- Notably, **24% of India's population** falls in the **0-14 age bracket**, indicating a significant youth demographic.
- While **maternal deaths have decreased**, accounting for 8% of global fatalities, India still faces stark inequities in maternal health. Despite improved access to maternal health services, disparities persist, with certain districts experiencing alarmingly **high maternal mortality ratios**.
- The report highlights ongoing gender-based disparities in healthcare access and outcomes. Vulnerable groups such as women with disabilities, migrants, ethnic minorities, LGBTQIA+ individuals, and disadvantaged castes face heightened risks and barriers to sexual and reproductive health services.

### **World Future Energy Summit**

- **16th World Future Energy Summit** has commenced in Abu Dhabi, drawing together global leaders, policymakers, and experts in sustainable energy and climate initiatives.
- The summit aims to foster dialogue on key issues like global climate action, renewable energy, energy security, and sustainable development.



- Sheikha Shamma bint Sultan bin Khalifa Al Nahyan, President and CEO of the UAE Independent Climate Change Accelerators, emphasized the critical need for substantial financial investments to limit global warming to 1.5 degrees Celsius.
- She highlighted the role of blended finance and stressed the importance of
  international cooperation in addressing climate change. Francesco La Camera,
  Director-General of the International Renewable Energy Agency, emphasized
  the urgency of increasing renewable energy capacity to at least 11 terawatts by
  2030.
- **Organized by Masdar**, the state-owned Abu Dhabi Future Energy Company, the summit serves as a platform for global leaders in sustainable energy and climate initiatives to exchange knowledge, ideas, and solutions.

- Leen Alsebai, the head of the summit, highlighted the event's role in fostering actionable climate strategies through **collaboration**, **innovation**, **and investment**.

# Takshvi Vaghani

- India's young skating sensation, **Takshvi Vaghani**, has etched her name in the record books by setting a new world record for the **lowest limbo skating over 25 metres**.
- On April 18, 2024, the 6-year-old prodigy from Ahmedabad, Gujarat, defied the boundaries of human agility, gliding across the 25-meter distance at a mere 16 cm (6.29 in) above the ground.



- With her lithe movements and impeccable balance, she surpassed the previous world record held by Manasvi Vishal from Pune, who had skated the same distance at a height of 16.5 centimeters.
- At the tender age of 6, Takshvi Vaghani has already etched her name in the annals of sporting history, inspiring countless aspiring athletes around the globe.
- Her accomplishment serves as a powerful reminder that age is no barrier to greatness, and with dedication and passion, even the most seemingly insurmountable challenges can be conquered.

# **India's Indigenous Bullet Train**

- Country is gearing up to launch an **indigenous bullet train capable** of reaching speeds exceeding 250 kilometres per hour (km/h).
- This groundbreaking initiative is set to revolutionize high-speed rail travel in India, showcasing the nation's engineering prowess and commitment to cuttingedge technology.



- The Vande Bharat trains, manufactured by the Indian Railways' Integral Coach Factory (ICF) in Chennai, are at the forefront of this ambitious project.
- These state-of-the-art trains are designed to operate on the recently announced north, south, and east corridors, reaching a top speed of 220 kmph faster than any existing train on the Indian Railways network.
- National High-Speed Rail Corporation Ltd (NHSRCL), responsible for executing India's first bullet train project, has made remarkable progress.
- It has already completed **300 kilometres of pier work**, laying the foundation for the country's journey into high-speed rail excellence.
- Additionally, the extensive land acquisition process for the entire 508-kilometre route was successfully completed in January, paving the way for seamless implementation.
- The **Vande Bharat trains** are a testament to India's indigenous engineering capabilities, seamlessly fusing Indian technology with domestic manufacturing.
- The upcoming bullet train under development is based on the Vande Bharat platform, boasting an impressive acceleration from zero to 100 kmph in just 52 seconds outpacing existing bullet trains, which typically achieve this feat in 54 seconds.



While India is currently leveraging Japanese technology for the bullet trains that
will operate on the Ahmedabad to Mumbai line, the Vande Bharat trains will
incorporate more Indian technology and domestic manufacturing. This strategic
approach not only fosters self-reliance but also paves the way for the
development of a new corridor complementing the existing western corridor,
created with Japanese assistance.



- The Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) is providing a soft loan of approximately Rs. 40,000 crore for the Mumbai-Ahmedabad High Speed Rail project, which has a total project cost of more than Rs. 1.08 lakh crore.
- This collaboration underscores **India's commitment** to achieving high-speed rail excellence through strategic partnerships and knowledge sharing.
