Kochi: Maritime Partnership Exercise

- INS Mormugao, along with aircraft from the Indian Air Force, recently participated in a Maritime Partnership Exercise with the French Carrier Strike Group (CSG) off India's Western Seaboard, an official statement reported.
- The exercise involved complex maritime drills, including joint air operations, showcasing the high degree of interoperability and professionalism between the Indian and French naval forces.
- India and France have maintained a robust defence partnership since 1998, marked by numerous joint exercises such as Shakti (land), Varuna (sea), and Garuda (air). This partnership continues to thrive through operational stopovers, with 16 port calls by French Navy vessels since 2022.



Conference on "Drug Trafficking and National Security"

 Amit Shah, will chair a regional conference on "Drug Trafficking and National Security" in New Delhi on Saturday, January 11.

- The conference, organized by the Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB), aims to address the growing concern of drug trafficking and its impact on national security, with a special focus on eight states and Union Territories of northern India.
- Amit Shah will launch the **Drug Disposal Fortnight**, inaugurate the new office complex of the NCB's Bhopal zonal unit and extension of the MANAS-2 helpline to all 36 states and Union Territories.
- The Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) is implementing a three-pronged strategy to achieve a drug-free India by 2047.






Assam Govt Negotiating with MoD for Defence Corridor

- The Assam government is actively negotiating with the Defence Ministry for the declaration of areas adjoining Guwahati towards Nagaon as a defence corridor, CM Himanta Biswa Sarma said.
- Assam Chief Minister Hemanta Biswa Sarma said at a function a day before that he was in talks with government of India to have third defence industrial corridor. He also expressed hope that the talks may materialise too.
- The CM also stated that having defence industrial corridor was part of thinking to bring investment into the state which did not exist earlier.
- The Union government has set up two Defence Industrial Corridors (DICs) in order to attract total investment worth ₹20,000 crore by the year 2024-25 for defence industries, develop domestic supply chain and strengthen defence manufacturing ecosystem in the country.
- Both the States have promulgated their respective aerospace and defence policy to attract investments in their respective DICs.

Lanka President Dissanayake's Next Week Visit to Beijing

- China on Friday termed the upcoming three-day visit of Anura Kumara Dissanayake as significant as the Sri Lankan president seeks to balance ties with Beijing weeks after his India visit.
- Dissanayake will pay a state visit to China from January 14 to 17 at the invitation of Chinese President Xi Jinping, Chinese Foreign Ministry spokesperson Hua Chunying announced here on Friday.
- Dissanayake, once a bitter critic of India while appreciating India's assistance during Sri Lanka's economic crisis, chose India for his first visit abroad. During the visit, Dissanayake will hold talks with President Xi and also meet Premier Li Qiang.
- China stands ready to work with Sri Lanka through the upcoming visit to deepen political mutual trust and expand high-quality **Belt and Road cooperation** and practical cooperation in various fields for continuous new progress in advancing the China-Sri Lanka strategic cooperative partnership, he said.
- After protracted negotiations, China has recently reached a deal with Sri Lanka to restructure its USD 4.2 billion debt.

Another Chinese Foreign Ministry spokesperson Guo Jiakun told a media briefing: "The upcoming visit will be Dissanayake's first visit to China after taking office, and is of great importance to the development of China-Sri Lanka relations." A host of issues, including permitting Chinese "research vessels" regarded as spy ships by India; Sri Lanka's debt commitments to China, stated to be Colombo's largest creditor, and expansion of the Belt and Road Initiative (BRI) investments are expected to figure in Dissanayake's talks with Xi.

Earlier, after talks with Modi on December 16, Dissanayake had said in a statement in New Delhi, "I assured the Indian leader that Sri Lanka will not permit its territory to be used in any manner inimical to the security of India as well as towards regional stability." He said Sri Lanka "attaches great importance to the continuous development and deepening of cooperation with India." This assurance was seen in the backdrop of India's concerns over recurring visits by Chinese research vessels visiting Hambantota port, which New Delhi said aimed at monitoring its missile and space programmes.
