Army Plans To Acquire Indigenous Pinaka MBRLs

- Recent reports indicate that the Defence Ministry has approved a substantial deal worth approximately ₹10,200 crore, which will include the acquisition of 6,400 rockets specifically designed for the Pinaka system.
- The Pinaka MBRL is an advanced artillery system developed by the Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) of India.
- The system is capable of launching a salvo of 12 rockets within 44 seconds, effectively targeting enemy positions and troop concentrations over a range of up to 75 kilometers with precision-guided capabilities.
- In December 2023, the Defence Acquisition Council cleared a proposal for acquiring 6,400 rockets at a cost of ₹2,800 crore.

putting its full weight behind the indigenous Pinaka multi launch artillery rocket sys-tems, with orders worth Rs 10,200 crore for its ammuni-tion to be cleared soon, even as India is also exporting the

systems to other countries.

Army chief General Upendra Dwivedi said two Pinaka contracts — Rs 5,700 crore for high-explosive pre-frag-mented ammunition and Rs 4,500 crore for area denial munitions — are all set to be in-ked before the current fiscal

ends on March 31.

These orders will cater for the 10 Pinaka regiments already ordered by the over 11lakh strong Army, which also has three Russian-origin Smerch and five Grad rocket regiments.

While the force has inducted four Pinaka regiments, with some of the launchers al-so deployed in high-altitude areas along the northern borders with China, the other six are in the process of being inducted to add "more punch and lethality" to its arsenal. "The Pinaka is one of the best rocket systems in the world. Its regiments have been high-altitude enabled," a senior officer said

The high-explosive prefragmented ammunition has a strike range of 45 km, while the aerial denial munitions can be launched to a distance of 37 km. The latter have the capability to saturate a target area with multiple bomblets, including anti-tank and antipersonnel minelets.

DRDO has developed a va-riety of ammunition for the Pi-naka, including rockets with 45-km extended range and 75 km guided extended range With the plan underway to fur-ther enhance the range first to 120 km and then to 300 km, Gen Dwivedi said, "As soon as we get longer ranges, we might drop plans for other alternate long-range weapons we are looking at and concentrate on

it (Pinaka).'

The six new Pinaka regiments, under contracts in-ked with defence PSU Bharat Earth Movers Ltd and private sector companies Tata Advanced Systems and Larsen & Toubro, comprise 114 launchers with automated gun aiming and positioning systems and 45 command posts, along with 330 vehicles. "They are equipped with electronically and mechanically improved weapon systems capable of firing a variety of ammuni-tion over longer ranges," an-other officer said.

India is also stepping-up plans to export the Pinaka sys-tem, along with other prod-ucts like BrahMos supersonic cruise missiles and Akash air

India part of naval drill hosted by France

ndia and eight other countries are taking part in a naval exercise hosted by France around the Malacca, Sunda and Lombok straits between the Indian Ocean and Pacific Ocean, demonstrating their commitment to a rules-based international order in the maritime domain.

India has deployed guided-missile destroyer INS Mumbai for the 'La Perouse' exercise, which includes French carrier strike group (CSG) led by nuclear-powered aircraft carrier Charles De Gaulle. TNN

importing both Pinaka and Akash systems, as earlier re-ported by **TOI**. Some Asean, African and European countries have also shown interest in acquiring the Pinaka sys tems. Another major deal to be inked within this fiscal for the Army's Regiment of Artillery will be the Rs 8,500 crore one for 307 indigenous advanced towed artillery gun systems, which is touted to have a strike range of 48 km.

DRDO To Conduct Environmental Test of Anti Jamming Antenna

- DRDO is set to conduct environmental tests for an Anti-Jamming Antenna, which is likely intended for use in Unmanned Aerial Vehicles (UAVs).
- This initiative is part of a broader effort to enhance the resilience of UAVs against jamming, which can disrupt Global Navigation Satellite System (GNSS) signals crucial for navigation and positioning.
- Anti-jamming technologies are essential for UAVs, as they are vulnerable to GNSS signal disruption.

 Donald Trump said that he will take action to "keep all men out of women's sports". He's also pledged to restrict gender-affirming care.
- In his first term as US President, Donald Trump declared a ban on transgender troops serving in the military and halted the recruitment of transgender personnel. However, the policy was reversed by Joe Biden after he took office in 2021.



Maritime Drill In Indian Ocean On As Quad Foreign Ministers Set To Meet

- While the maritime forces of the Quad nations are together exercising in the Indian Ocean as part of a multinational exercise, the foreign ministers of India, Australia and Japan are expected to meet a day after Donald Trump takes oath as the 47th US President on January 20.
- The Indian Navy's indigenously designed and built guided missile destroyer, INS Mumbai, is participating in the fourth edition of the multinational exercise, La Perouse. It is a France-led biennial multinational maritime exercise.
- The informal grouping of India, the US, Japan and Australia is called QUAD. The
 exercise aims to develop common maritime situational awareness by enhancing
 coopera-tion in surveillance, maritime interdiction operations and air operations
 among these nations.
