

- Reliance Industries, TCS, and HDFC bank are among India's top 10 most valuable companies, according to the 2024 Burgundy Private Hurun India 500 list.
- The list, created by Axis Bank's banking unit Burgundy Private and Hurun India says that India's top 500 companies have a combined value of \$3.8 trillion, which is higher than India's own GDP and also the combined Gross Domestic Product (GDP) of the UAE, Indonesia, and Spain.

International Association Of Aids To Marine Navigation

• India has been elected to the Vice Presidency of the International Association of Aids to Marine Navigation (IALA) at the ongoing first General Assembly of IALA in Singapore.



- The Indian delegation is being led by the Ministry of Ports, Shipping, and Waterways Secretary, T.K. Ramachandran. The election reinforces the country's dedication to advancing maritime safety, enhancing navigational aids, and fostering international cooperation within the maritime sector.
- The Ministry of Ports, Shipping, and Waterways, in a statement, said the visit also underscores India's strong leadership and contributions to maritime affairs, reaffirming its commitment to sustainable and secure marine navigation.
- The country will host the IALA Council meeting in December this year and the IALA Conference and General Assembly in September 2027 in Mumbai.

Google unveils 'Ananta,'

- Google has made a significant leap in its commitment to India's digital landscape by unveiling Ananta, its largest campus in the country. Named after the Sanskrit word meaning "infinite" or "limitless", Ananta is not just a workplace but a hub of innovation, collaboration, and sustainability.
- Located in Mahadevapura, Bengaluru, this campus is among Google's largest in the world, reinforcing India's role as a key player in global technology and Al advancements. The newly inaugurated Ananta campus boasts a seating capacity of over 5,000 employees.



- Google has emphasized that this facility is more than just an office—it is a space designed to drive groundbreaking innovations and AI-powered solutions that will impact the world.
- The company envisions this campus as a testament to its AI-first approach, highlighting India's talent pool and its potential to solve global challenges at scale. bengaluru, often dubbed the "Silicon Valley of India," has long been a preferred destination for tech giants. Google's choice to expand here underscores the city's significance as a hub for technological advancements, AI research, and software development.
- With a workforce of over 10,000 employees across India, including locations in Mumbai, Hyderabad, and Gurugram, the new Bengaluru campus will further strengthen Google's presence and collaboration efforts in the country.

Grok-3 Chatbot

• Elon Musk's artificial intelligence **startup xAI has introduced Grok-3**, the latest iteration of its chatbot, as it looks to compete with Chinese AI firm DeepSeek, Microsoft-backed OpenAI, and Alphabet's Google.



- Grok-3 debut comes at a critical moment in the AI arms race, just days after DeepSeek unveiled its powerful open-source model and as Musk moves aggressively to expand xAI's influence.
- **"Grok-3 across the board is in a league of its own,"** Musk said during a livestream alongside three xAI engineers late on Monday, adding that the model significantly outperforms its predecessor, Grok-2.

Ajmer Hosts First-ever All India Transgender Conference

- Ajmer has become the venue for the **first-ever All India Kinnar Mahasammelan**, a historic 10-day transgender conference held at a private school in Vaishali Nagar. The event, which began on February 17, 2025, with the Khichdi Tulai ritual, is aimed at addressing issues faced by the transgender community across India.
- The conference is organized in **memory of Anita Bai, the mentor of Gaddipati Saloni Nayak**, a respected figure in Ajmer's transgender community. Attended by over **2,000 transgender members from** various states, the event is deeply rooted in religious and cultural traditions.



 Various rituals, including Kalash Puja and Chak Pujan, are being performed, emphasizing the community's spiritual beliefs. The conference also features stalls related to medical services, banking, perfumes, and travel. The event is being conducted under strict supervision, ensuring only invited members are allowed entry.

BBC Sportswoman Of The Year

 Indian shooter Manu Bhaker received the BBC Sportswoman of the Year after an impressive campaign at the Paris Olympics 2024, where she bagged two bronze medals.



- The stellar performances from the 22-year-old established her status as one of the elite sporting talents in the country. She became the first Indian shooter to win multiple medals at a single Olympics. Also, she became the first Indian woman to win an Olympic shooting medal.
- The other contenders for the honour were golfer Aditi Ashok, para-shooter Avani Lekhara, India women's cricket vice-captain Smriti Mandhana, and wrestler Vinesh Phogat.
- Her fellow shooter **Avani Lekhara was presented** with the BBC ISWOTY Parasportswoman of the Year award.



• Archer Sheetal Devi won the Emerging Athlete Award after becoming India's youngest Paralympic medallist.





• **Mithali Raj was given the Lifetime** Achievement Award for her record 18-year captaincy of the Indian women's cricket team.
