## **India To Establishes Satellite Tracking Station**

- India and Mauritius have signed a landmark agreement to establish a satellite tracking and communication station near the US-UK military base Diego Garcia in the Chagos archipelago. This move enhances India's strategic presence in the Indian Ocean Region (IOR) amid rising Chinese maritime activities.
- The pact, signed during Mauritius PM Navinchandra Ramgoolam's visit to India, enables India to track and receive data from its satellites and launch vehicles using this facility.
- Location: Chagos Islands are strategically located between East Africa, the Middle East, and South Asia
- Military Importance: Diego Garcia hosts a major US-UK naval and air base, used in operations in Iraq, Afghanistan, and the Gulf
- India's Gain: Satellite monitoring capabilities + geopolitical leverage in the Indo-Pacific
- India reaffirmed support for Mauritius' sovereignty over Chagos Islands, while respecting the UK's continued military control over Diego Garcia. This "dual recognition" strengthens both strategic access and diplomatic alignment.
- PM Modi described the move as a "historic milestone," reaffirming India's commitment to decolonization and regional cooperation.
- Maritime and Space Cooperation Deepens
- Joint hydrographic surveys and navigational charting
- India to refit Mauritius Coast Guard vessels and train officers
- Expanded maritime security roles in Mauritius' Exclusive Economic Zone (EEZ)
- India's Foreign Secretary Vikram Misri emphasized India as Mauritius' preferred partner for capacity-building and regional development.



## **India's Largest Sports Complex in Ahmedabad**

- On 16 September 2025, Union Home Minister Amit Shah inaugurated India's largest and most technologically advanced sports complex at Naranpura in Ahmedabad.
- The inauguration marks a milestone in India's journey toward becoming a global sporting powerhouse, aligning with the government's vision of making India a top sports nation by 2047.
- Constructed at a cost of ₹825 crore, the Naranpura complex features,
- An international standard aquatic complex
- State-of-the-art facilities for both indoor and outdoor sports
- Dedicated training infrastructure and residential amenities for athletes
- India's Sporting Ambitions: Vision 2047
- Rising Sports Budget: From ₹1,643 Cr to ₹5,300 Cr
- Amit Shah highlighted the sharp rise in India's sports budget over the last decade,
- 2014: ₹1,643 crore
- 2025: ₹5,300 crore



## Dr. Sima Bahous Begins Second Term at UN Women

- On 11 September 2025, Dr. Sima Sami Bahous was reappointed by UN Secretary-General António Guterres for a second term as Executive Director of UN Women. Her reappointment comes at a crucial time as the organization prepares to implement its newly approved Strategic Plan for 2026–2029.
- Expressing gratitude, Dr. Bahous pledged her commitment to advancing women's rights and gender equality worldwide, stating she would give her "utmost efforts" to fulfill UN Women's critical mission.
- Strategic Plan 2026–2029: A Vision for Equality
- The UN Women Strategic Plan 2026–2029 outlines a bold vision where gender equality is central to achieving the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). Dr. Bahous reaffirmed this by saying,
- "Equality must not wait... when women and girls are not brought down by violence or conflict and instead play their fullest part in our human family."
- UN Women
- Established in 2010 as the United Nations Entity for Gender Equality and the Empowerment of Women.
- Merged four UN bodies:
- UNIFEM (United Nations Development Fund for Women)
- DAW (Division for the Advancement of Women)

- INSTRAW (International Research and Training Institute for the Advancement of Women)
- OSAGI (Office of the Special Adviser on Gender Issues)
- International Women's Day (8 March) Promoted by the UN since 1977.
- International Day for the Elimination of Violence against Women (25 November).



## **World Patient Safety Day 2025**

- Every year, September 17 is observed as World Patient Safety Day (WPSD), a global initiative by the World Health Organization (WHO). The day emphasizes the urgent need to reduce medical errors, ensure transparency in healthcare, and strengthen trust between patients and providers.
- In 2025, the **theme** "Safe Care for Every Newborn and Every Child" highlights the importance of protecting the most vulnerable: infants and young children, who often face avoidable risks during childbirth, diagnosis, and treatment.
- **Established:** 2019 by WHO after the World Health Assembly adopted the resolution on Global Action on Patient Safety.
- **Purpose:** To raise awareness, encourage systemic change, and promote patient-centered care.




## Samuel Umtiti Retires from Football at Age 31

- On 15 September 2025, Samuel Umtiti, the 2018 FIFA World Cup-winning French defender, officially announced his retirement from professional football at the age of 31.
- Once regarded as one of the finest centre-backs in Europe, Umtiti's career was tragically derailed by chronic knee injuries that restricted his playing time and eventually forced an early exit from the sport.
- While Umtiti enjoyed initial success at Barcelona, winning,
- 2 La Liga titles
- 3 Copa del Rey trophies



#### **Pakistan Pushes for Islamic Nato**

- When leaders from over 40 Arab and Islamic nations convened an emergency summit in Doha on Monday, the agenda was to deliver a united response to Israel, following its strike on Hamas leaders in the Qatari capital last week.
- Although the discussions produced little beyond condemnations and vague pledges, the idea of a Nato-style military alliance for member states got a loud cheer. The meeting was attended by both Pakistan and Turkey.
- With Pakistan, the only nuclear-armed Muslim country, and Turkey, a Nato member that backed Islamabad against India with arms and personnel during the four-day mini-war, in the fold, the likelihood of an Arab-Islamic Nato could bring some unease in New Delhi.
- Self-proclaimed ummah champion Pakistan spotlighted itself in an assertive role at the Doha summit, aggressively advocating for an "Arab-Islamic task force".
