"Mission for Aatmanirbharta in Pulses"

- In a major push towards agricultural self-reliance, the Union Cabinet on October 1, 2025, approved a six-year programme titled the Mission for Aatmanirbharta in Pulses.
- panning from 2025-26 to 2030-31, the initiative comes with a significant financial outlay of ₹11,440 crore, aiming to boost domestic pulses production to 350 lakh tonnes, reduce import dependency, and secure income for nearly 2 crore farmers.
- Despite being the world's largest producer and consumer of pulses, India still relies on imports to meet about 15–20% of its demand.
- Mission Objectives and Targets
- Expand area under pulses to 310 lakh hectares
- Increase yield to 1,130 kg/ha
- Achieve production of 350 lakh tonnes
- Reach around 2 crore farmers through targeted interventions
- India is the largest producer, consumer, and importer of pulses in the world.
- Major pulse crops: Tur (Arhar), Urad (Black Gram), Masoor (Lentil), Moong (Green Gram), Chana (Gram).
- ICAR (Indian Council of Agricultural Research) was established in 1929, headquartered in New Delhi.
- NAFED (National Agricultural Cooperative Marketing Federation) was founded in 1958.
- CACP (Commission for Agricultural Costs and Prices) recommends MSPs for 22 crops including pulses.



Gaj Rakshak App

- Authorities at the Bandhavgarh Tiger Reserve in Madhya Pradesh are turning to technology to address the growing challenge of human-elephant conflict.
- Developed in collaboration with the Madhya Pradesh Forest Department, the Wildlife Conservation Trust, and Kalpvag Company, the app is expected to transform elephant conservation and protection measures in the region.
- The Gaj Rakshak App provides real-time location data on elephants, including their movement and behaviour.
- It sends timely alerts via SMS, push notifications, voice calls, and sirens if elephants approach villages, helping prevent human-elephant conflict.
- Equipped with offline functionality, the app ensures connectivity even in remote areas.
- Elephant monitors can upload photos, update locations, and specify whether elephants are roaming solo or in herds.
- Information is instantly shared with app users within a 10 km radius of the elephant's location.



100 Years of RSS

- Prime Minister Narendra Modi released a special commemorative postage stamp and coin to mark the centenary celebrations of the Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh (RSS). The event honoured the 100-year journey of the organisation, founded in 1925 in Nagpur by Keshav Baliram Hedgewar.
- Founded: 1925, Nagpur, by Keshav Baliram Hedgewar.
- Nature: Volunteer-based organisation focusing on discipline, cultural awareness, and national service.
- **Vision:** Rooted in Dharma, with an aim of achieving Sarvangeena Unnati (allround development) of India.
- Contributions of RSS
- Education: Setting up schools and cultural centres.
- Health & Welfare: Running social service and medical initiatives.
- **Disaster Relief**: Providing rehabilitation during floods, earthquakes, and cyclones.
- Youth, Women, and Farmers: Empowerment programmes and grassroots mobilisation.
- **Community Strengthening**: Promoting local participation and national unity.




Major General G. Srinivas Takes Charge as Commandant of CDM
