Matsya-6000

- India is preparing to take a major leap in deep-sea exploration, with two scientists from the National Institute of Ocean Technology (NIOT) set to pilot the country's first manned submersible early next year.
- The 28-tonne indigenous craft, Matsya-6000, will initially descend 500 metres off the Chennai coast, a precursor to India's plan to send humans 6,000 metres below the surface and join a select global cohort capable of such missions.
- The aquanauts, Ramesh Raju and Jatinder Pal Singh, will form the core crew of Samudrayaan, the human-rated arm of India's Deep Ocean Mission under the Ministry of Earth Sciences.
- Only a handful of nations -- including the US, Russia, China, Japan and France -currently possess crewed deep-sea capabilities. With Samudrayaan, India aims
 to join this strategic club even as it moves to harness its 11,098-km coastline
 and accelerate blue-economy initiatives.
- Inside NIOT's Chennai campus, the Matsya-6000 is steadily taking shape. Its 2.25-metre boiler-steel personnel sphere is fitted into an external frame housing high-density Li-Po batteries, ballast systems, drop-weight escape mechanisms, propellers and emergency buoys integral to its drag-anchor rescue system.



ITBP's 27th Battalion Honoured As Best Anti-naxal Unit

- The Indo-Tibetan Border Police's (ITBP) 27th battalion clinched the best antinaxal battalion honour for delivering outstanding operational results and leading impactful community initiatives in Chhattisgarh.
- ITBP Director General Prayeen Kumar honoured the prestigious award to the battalion's Commandant Vivek Kumar Pandey and BP Badaya during the force's Raising Day Director General's Parade held today in Udhampur, Jammu and Kashmir.
- Shattering the red corridor deployed in the challenging Mohla-Manpur area near the borders of Maharashtra's Gadchiroli and Kanker, the Kerala-based 27th Battalion has been at the forefront of the campaign against Maoists.
- The unit's most significant victory came in August 2025, when it successfully
 eliminated two senior Naxal commanders--Vijay Reddy (State Zonal Committee
 member) and Lokesh Salame (Rajnandgaon Kanker Border, RKB, Division
 Secretary)--during a major encounter.
- The 27th Battalion established a Field Hospital and the area's first-ever Veterinary Field Hospital. These facilities provided essential medical care to over 6,000 villagers and thousands of livestock across nearly 35 surrounding LWEaffected tribal villages.



India-Russia Annual Summit

- The India-Russia annual summit scheduled here for December 5 could boost bilateral naval cooperation including additional joint exercises, military-technical cooperation and stability in the Indo-Pacific region, including the Indian Ocean region.
- Ahead of the summit, aide to the Russian president and chairman of the Maritime Board of Russia Nikolai Patrushev met defence secretary Rajesh Kumar Singh as well as top officers of the Indian Navy.
- The two sides discussed plans for joint exercises and matters related to strengthening military-technical cooperation, it has been learnt.
- "The foreign ministers reaffirmed Russia and India's commitment to building a
 just, multipolar world order and ensuring global security. They agreed to
 continue coordinating their approaches to cooperation between Russia and
 India in key multilateral formats— the UN, SCO, BRICS, and the G20," read a
 statement issued by the Russian Foreign Ministry.



Israel Plans To Seize Historical Site in the West Bank

- Israel plans to seize parts of a major West Bank historic site, according to a
 government document, and settlers put up a new outpost overnight, even as
 the country faces pressure to crack down on settler violence in the Palestinian
 territory.
- Israel's Civil Administration announced its intention to expropriate large swaths of Sebastia, a major archaeological site in the West Bank, in the document obtained by The Associated Press.
- Peace Now, an anti-settlement watchdog group, said the site is around 1,800 dunams (450 acres) Israel's largest seizure of archeologically important land.
- The move came as Israeli settlers celebrated the creation of a new, unauthorized settlement near Bethlehem, and a Palestinian lawyer said a West Bank activist has been detained and hospitalized.
- Meanwhile, Human Rights Watch said Israel may have committed war crimes when it forcibly expelled 32,000 Palestinians from three West Bank refugee camps this year.
- The Israeli order released Nov. 12 lists parcels of land it intends to seize in the Sebastia area. Peace Now, which provided the document to AP, said the popular archeological site, where thousands of olive trees grow, belongs to the Palestinians.
- The capital of the ancient Israelite kingdom Samaria is thought to be beneath the ruins of Sebastia, and Christians and Muslims believe it's where John the Baptist was buried.
- Israel announced plans to develop the site into a tourist attraction in 2023. Excavations have already begun and the government has allocated more than

30 million shekels (\$9.24 million) to develop the site, according to Peace Now and another rights group.



Indian, Tanzania Navy Officials Discuss

- The maiden edition of Indian Navy Tanzania People's Defence Force Navy Staff Talks was successfully concluded at Dar es Salaam, in Tanzania, an official said.
