
TIME's 2025 CEO of the Year

Her journey reflects not just athletic prowess, but resilience, influence, and the evolution of the WNBA at a moment of rising global visibility.



UNEP Champions of the Earth 2025 Award

• Supriya Sahu, Additional Chief Secretary to the Government of Tamil Nadu, has been honoured with the 2025 Champions of the Earth Award, the United Nations' highest environmental recognition.

- The award, announced by the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP) during the UN Environment Assembly (UNEA-7) in Nairobi, celebrates her pioneering contributions to sustainable cooling, ecosystem restoration, and climate adaptation.
- Established in 2005, the Champions of the Earth Award is UNEP's most prestigious honour. Now in its 20th year, it celebrates individuals and organisations driving transformative environmental change



The 33rd Southeast Asian Games Begin in Thailand

- The 33rd Southeast Asian Games (SEA Games 2025) officially begin 9th
 December in Thailand, marking the start of one of the region's most celebrated
 multi-sport events. Hosted across Bangkok and Chonburi province, this edition
 brings together thousands of athletes and spectators to celebrate athletic
 excellence, regional unity, and cultural pride.
- The Opening Ceremony is being held at the iconic Rajamangala National Stadium, signaling the commencement of an event that showcases Southeast Asia's growing sports ecosystem.
- Thailand, known for its rich sporting heritage and experience in conducting large-scale events, is hosting over 13,000 athletes for the 2025 edition. This scale reflects the SEA Games' evolution into a major international sporting platform, with strong participation from all member nations of the Southeast Asian region.



Jasprit Bumrah Scripts History

- Indian pace spearhead Jasprit Bumrah etched his name in cricketing history on 9 December 2025, becoming the first Indian bowler ever to take 100 wickets in all three international formats—Tests, ODIs, and T20Is.
- The milestone was reached during the 1st T20I against South Africa at the Barabati Stadium in Cuttack, marking yet another peak in Bumrah's remarkable career.
- This achievement places him among the top five bowlers in world cricket, joining legends like Tim Southee, Lasith Malinga, Shakib Al Hasan, and Shaheen Shah Afridi.
- Career Tally After the Match
- Tests: 234 wickets in 52 matches
 ODIs: 149 wickets in 89 matches
 T20Is: 101 wickets in 81 matches



Rameshbabu Praggnanandhaa Wins FIDE Circuit

- Indian chess continues to rise globally, and Grandmaster Rameshbabu
 Praggnanandhaa added another remarkable achievement to India's sporting
 history in December 2025. The 20-year-old Indian prodigy won the International
 Chess Federation (FIDE) Circuit 2025 with 115.17 points, topping a year-long
 leaderboard featuring the world's strongest players.
- With this victory, he becomes the only male player to qualify through the FIDE Circuit and officially books his place in the Candidates Tournament 2026, the final stage to determine the challenger for the World Chess Championship 2026.
- The FIDE Circuit 2025 was a year-long qualification path comprising top-level tournaments held from January to December 2025. Players scored points based on performance and tournament strength, with final standings based on the sum of their seven best results.
