AMSL Bags New Defence Orders Worth Over Rs 100 cr

- Apollo Micro Systems Ltd (AMSL) on Friday said it has secured new defence orders worth over Rs 100 crore to supply unmanned aerial systems.
- The orders are to be executed within a period of four months, AMSL said in an exchange filing.
- "Apollo Micro Systems Ltd has received orders amounting to Rs 1,002.47 million from a private company, deliverable to the Ministry of Defence, for the supply of unmanned aerial systems," the filing said.
- AMSL offers technology-based solutions in sectors like infrastructure, transportation, aerospace, defence among others.



Defence Ministry May Clear Major Indigenous Defence Projects

 Defence Ministry's apex procurement body, Defence Acquisition Council, is expected to meet today to clear major indigenous projects for the Indian defence forces, including a homegrown integrated air defence weapon system for the protection of the Delhi NCR region from aerial threats.

- As part of augmenting the drone capabilities of the Indian Army, the Defence Ministry is likely to decide on buying around 850 loitering munitions for the Indian Army.
- An Indian Navy proposal to procure a large number of Medium-Range Surfaceto-Air Missile systems from indigenous sources to counter threats to its warships is also expected to come up for discussion.
- India is also set to take a call on leasing of two Sea Guardian MQ-9B HALE drones from the US for around three years at the meeting. India has already signed a deal for 31 of these drones, which are expected to begin arriving in India from 2028 onward.
- The Defence Ministry is also likely to clear the development and procurement of a very large number of Astra Mark 2 air-to-air missiles with a strike range of over 200 km for the Indian Air Force, along with a specific number of Meteor air-toair missiles.
- The Indian Army is also proposing to indigenously overhaul 200 T-90 tanks through a Defence public sector unit.





BEL Signs MoU With Astra Microwave

- Bharat Electronics Limited (BEL), a Navratna public sector undertaking under the Ministry of Defence, has forged a strategic partnership with Astra Microwave Products Limited (AMPL) through a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU).
- This collaboration, signed on 24 December 2025, targets the design, development, and manufacturing of advanced electronic systems for defence and aerospace sectors.

- The partnership emphasises critical domains including electronic warfare, radar systems, and satellite technologies, aiming to bolster India's indigenous capabilities in defence electronics production.
- BEL brings extensive expertise in defence and strategic electronics, encompassing radars, weapon systems, communication networks, and electronic warfare solutions.
- These milestones—BEL's technological pact with AMPL and HAL's reaffirmation
 of global ambitions—signal robust momentum in India's pursuit of defence selfreliance and international competitiveness.





Vajra C-UAS at Kartavya Path For Capital Defence.

- Chennai-based Big Bang Boom Solutions Private Limited (BBBS) has deployed its advanced Vajra Sentinel Anti-Drone System at Kartavya Path in New Delhi, enhancing capital defence against unmanned aerial threats.
- Big Bang Boom Solutions, a defence start-up headquartered in Chennai, Tamil Nadu, specialises in counter-unmanned aerial systems (C-UAS). The company secured a contract worth over ₹200 crore from the Indian Air Force and Army in 2024 for its Vajra Sentinel technology.
- The Vajra Sentinel System represents a next-generation C-UAS solution designed to detect, track, and neutralise hostile drones, including commercially available off-the-shelf (COTS) models like DJI Mavic and Phantom.
- Upgrades such as AESA radar and kamikaze drone integration are available on demand, ensuring adaptability to evolving threats. The system's DGAQA clearance and field trial successes position BBBS as a key player in India's defence ecosystem.



Nigeria Averts Unilateral US Action By Cooperating On Airstrike

- By publicly cooperating with the United States on a Christmas Day airstrike,
 Nigeria's government may have averted humiliating unilateral military action
 threatened a month ago by President Donald Trump.
- But security experts say it is unclear whether such strikes can do much to hinder Islamist militants who have long menaced communities in the area.
- Trump announced on Truth Social on Thursday that U.S. forces had launched a strike against Islamic State militants in northwest Nigeria at the request of Nigeria's government. He said the group had been targeting Christians in the region.
- Trump said on Friday that a U.S. military strike targeting Islamic state militants in Nigeria was originally supposed to take place on Wednesday, but he ordered it delayed by a day.
- SYMBOLIC OR LONG-TERM IMPACT?
- After the strike, U.S. Defense Secretary Pete Hegseth said on X that there was "more to come."
- The U.S. official said another strike did not appear imminent, but did not rule out future operations.
- This specific strike was carried out by the United States, the official said, in part because the location was too remote for Nigerian forces to reach.
- "It's partially symbolic," the official said, adding that the aim was also deterrence and to send a message that the Trump administration was prepared to use the military.
