World Day for Safety and Health at Work 2026

- The World Day for Safety and Health at Work 2026 is observed on the 28th of April every year. This day is observed to promote safe and healthy working in the different conditions across the world.
- The day is led by the International Labor Organization (ILO) and the day also focuses on preventing workplace accidents, occupational diseases and to improving the overall worker well-being.
- The theme for the World Day for Safety and Health at Work 2026 is the **‘Good psychosocial working environments’’: A pathway to thriving workers and strong organizations.’**
- This global observance of this day can trace its roots to workers movements in the 1970s and it was officially established by the ILO in 2003.



ISSF Junior World Cup 2026

- India has delivered the strong performance at the ISSF Junior World Cup 2026 in the Cairo, Egypt. India currently at the top of the medal tally with the total of 16 medals.
- One of the standout performer came from the Hemant Burman who have clinched the silver medal in the 50m Rifle 3 Positions event. The 18-year-old scored the 351.7 in the final and showcased the exceptional composure and skill.
- India have added another medal in the Trap Mixed Team event where the duo of the Zuhair Khan and Addya Katyal secured a bronze medal.
- In the 50m Rifle Prone Women event the Indian shooters including Tejal Nathawat, Yugeshwari Bais, Anushka Thokur and Khwaish Sharma could not secure the podium finishes.



Virat Becomes First Player to Reach 9000 IPL Runs

- India's cricketing legend Virat Kohli scripted his name into history books by becoming the first player ever to score the 9000 runs in the Indian Premier League (IPL). He achieved the milestone during the match between the Royal Challengers Bengaluru against Delhi Capitals.
- Kohli has reached the landmark milestone in his 275th IPL match and he just needed the 11 runs before the game at Arun Jaitley Stadium. He have

completed the feat with the single in the sixth over and he take the 6732 balls to reach this historic figure.
