Narendra Modi Becomes India's Longest PM

- PM Narendra Modi achieved the yet another historic milestone in his political journey on the 10th of June, 2026. As on 10th of June, he completed 4,399 consecutive days in office and he surpassed the record of India's first PM, Jawaharlal Nehru and became the country's longest continuously serving elected PM.
- This achievement showcases his popularity, electoral dominance and strong leadership over more than a decade.
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi first assumed the office on May 26, 2014 after leading the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) to the decisive victory in the Lok Sabha elections.
- Nehru held the office continuously from May 13, 1952 until his death on May 27, 1964 which make his tenure one of the longest in democratic history. Indira Gandhi had served continuously from January 24, 1966 to March 24, 1977.



India Tops World Yogasana Championship 2026 Medal Table

- India emerged as the champion at the inaugural World Yogasana Championship 2026. As India finished at the first position of the medal tally with the extraordinary efforts and grabs the 114 medals which includes the 102 gold medals.
- It was held at the EKA Arena in Ahmedabad from June 4 to June 8 and this championship brought together the 522 athletes from 79 countries.
- While competing across the multiple age groups and disciplines, the Indian contingent secured the,

 - 3 Bronze Medals

El Niño Returns in 2026

- The world's monitoring agencies have reported that the emergence of the new El Niño event in the equatorial Pacific Ocean and it raising the concerns about the widespread weather disruptions across the world.
- According to the Japan Meteorological Agency (JMA), this phenomenon is expected to strengthen significantly in the upcoming months and could evolve into the very strong or even "Super El Niño" by the end of the year 2026.
- The Japan Meteorological Agency has officially declared the onset of the El Niño event will marking the first occurrence since the year 2023.
- Scientists expect the phenomenon to intensify during the second half of the 2026 and it will continue through at least December.
- El Niño is the naturally occurring the climate phenomenon which is characterized by the unusual warming of the sea surface temperatures in the central and eastern tropical Pacific Ocean.
- This warming changes the atmospheric circulation patterns and it influences the weather conditions all around the world.
- **Key Features of El Niño**
- Pacific Ocean waters are warmer than normal temperature
- Changes the global rainfall patterns

- Increased the risk of droughts and floods
- Disruption of the traditional monsoon systems
- Changes in the hurricane activity
- Higher global temperatures
- **Super El Niño**
- The strength of El Niño measured by the how much warmer is the Pacific Ocean temperature as compared to the normal levels.
- An anomaly of more than 2°C is generally classified as the very strong event and it is often referred to as a “Super El Niño.”



Amit Shah Launches LPMS ‘VINIMAY’

- Union Home Minister Amit Shah has launched the **Land Port Management System (LPMS) ‘VINIMAY’** in New Delhi on 9th June, 2026. This digital platform aim to transform the management of the cargo, passengers and vehicles at the India’s lands ports through real time coordination and technology driven operations.
- The Land Port Management System is the digital platform which integrates the cargo management, vehicle processing, passenger movement and inter-agency coordination on a single interface.
- This system connects the various government agencies and stakeholders who are involved in border operations and allowing seamless information exchange and real-time monitoring.

- Around 90% of the reduction in paperwork
- Single Electronic Window for the processing
- Automatic Number Plate Recognition (ANPR) based gate operations
- Real-time data sharing among the agencies
- Integrated management of cargo, vehicles, and passengers

- Established Year: 2010 under the Land Ports Authority of India Act, 2010
- Ministry: Ministry of Home Affairs
- Headquarters: New Delhi
- Objective: To develop, manage and regulate the integrated check posts and land ports along with the India's international borders.



Zojila Tunnel Breakthrough Achieved

- Bharat had achieved the successful breakthrough of the main tunnel of the Zojila Tunnel Project at Minamarg in **Ladakh's Kargil district**. This breakthrough brings the country one step close to establishing the year around connectivity between the Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh.
- This project is expected to improve the transform transportation, tourism, trade, regional development and strategic military mobility at the India's one of the challenging mountainous regions.
- The Zojila Tunnel is being constructed between the Baltal and Minamarg on National Highway-1.
- It is stretching nearly 14 kilometer and it is among the longest and most strategically important road tunnels in India.

- It is built at the elevations ranging from 2,900 meters to 3,310 meters above sea level and this project is being developed at the estimated cost of around ₹6,800 crore.
- Engineers have overcome the extreme weather conditions, heavy snowfall, and difficult geological formations to achieve this milestone.



G7 Summit

- PM Narendra Modi is set to embark a six-day visit to **France and Slovakia** from 13th June 2026. In this high level meet he will hold the bilateral meetings with French President Emmanuel Macron and Slovak PM Robert Fico, alongside participate in the G7 Summit and will also attend the Europe's largest technology event Viva Tech.
- The visit reflects the India's commitment to strengthening the partnerships with European nations while expanding cooperation in areas such as technology, innovation, trade, investment, defense and global governance.
- On June 18th Prime Minister Modi will visit to the Paris to attend the Viva Tech Summit which is Europe's largest technology and startup event.
- This summit serves as the major platform for technology companies, innovators, investors, entrepreneurs and policymakers from around the world.
